RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 ITM WILL SEE YOU RIGHT MAIDEN 1550m

The start of Race 1 was delayed approximately 2 minutes due to PERFECT TEST being reluctant to proceed to the barrier gates. Connections were advised that a warning has been placed on the filly's barrier manners.

SOIREE (C Carmine) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

ZAC FLASH (J Parkes) - Slow to begin.

CLASSY LADY (M Hudson) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

PERFECT TEST (L Sutherland) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Bumped and briefly unbalance early in the home straight when DASH OF RED shifted in.

ENRICO (M Singh) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

PIN POINTING (K Hercock) - Placed in restricted room having to steady when PERFECT TEST shifted inwards when not fully clear passing the 1200 metres. Commenced to over-race for the remainder of the event and shifted out to avoid heels near the 1000 metres, hampering GIN TRAP.

GIN TRAP (N Parmar) - Hampered near the 1000 metres.

RANGI NUI (C Butler) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

L Sutherland (PERFECT TEST) - Issued with a warning for allowing her mount to shift inwards when not fully clear of PIN POINTING, which had to be steadied near the 1200 metres.

J Chung (DASH OF RED) - Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift inwards near the 300 metres bumping PERFECT TEST.

Race 2 CROWLEY FORGE MASTER FARRIERS LTD 1200m

MERMAID (K Hercock) - Slow to begin. Restrained at the start and settled back.

PAPA SURF (J Parkes) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout. When questioned regarding performance rider advised the gelding would benefit from more rain-affected footing with today's track conditions being described as holding. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

LIBRARSI (J Chung) - Bumped on the point of the home turn becoming briefly unbalanced after being held up for a short distance.

THATZ DAISY (M Singh) - Rider dropped his whip on entering the home straight.

Race 3 CARTOWN 1100m

BUTLER (J Chung) - Slow to begin. Raced four-wide without cover throughout and had little left at the finish. J Chung advised that his instructions from connections were to settle back after drawing the outside barrier but after the gelding commenced to over-race elected to go forward.

MY ZOI (M Hudson) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

QUEEN OF SPADES (L Sutherland) - Lay outwards rounding the bend near the 600 metres.

OLD TOWN ROAD (J Riddell) - Angled outwards over the final stages to obtain clear running. After viewing video footage J Riddell agreed with Stewards, he may have erred in his judgment by not taking a run to the inside of GEE STRING when the opportunity to do so was a more viable option.

Race 4 MANAWATU ITM 2100m

OXYGEN (L Douglas) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

IF YOU DANCE (N Parmar) - Began awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance is required prior to its next start.

RUN JAKKO RUN (Mahipal Singh) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced wide without cover from the 1000 metres.

SAILOR JACK (M Singh) - Slow to begin.

RED 'N' SURF (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin.

SUPER SPIRIT (B Grylls) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

MISTEREX (T Davies) - Returned to the enclosure showing signs of lameness. A post-race veterinary examination which revealed mild soreness to the right foreleg.

Race 5 MANAWATU FRAME & TRUSS 2100m

FINEST WINE (C Butler) - Connections were granted permission for the mare to be presented without the notified ear covers pre-race due to the mare's fractious behaviour in the tie-up stalls. Began awkwardly losing ground.

BERRY THE CASH (L Douglas) - Slow to begin.

PRINCESS ANI (J Chung) - Slow to begin. Had to be steadied going into the back straight.

Race 6 MANAWATU ITM DOOR DEPARTMENT 1300m

PRIORESS (M Singh) - Began awkwardly. Briefly held up early in the final straight.

MAOLLA MISS (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin.

AMOSIA (T Davies) - Began awkwardly shifting inwards crowding GUCCI BELT.

SHELBYROCK'N (K Hercock) - Began awkwardly shifting outwards crowding GUCCI BELT. Lay outwards near the 600 metres and throughout the final straight.

GUCCI BELT (M Hudson) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground when runners to either side shifted ground.

BRADMAN (J Chung) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

SEMPER MAGICO (B Grylls) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

WINKLE BAY (C Butler) - Had to be continuously straightened due to its tendency to hang inwards in the final straight.

Race 7 INTOWIN.CO.NZ SYNDICATION 1550m

DON'T ASK (B Grylls) - Slow to begin. Hampered 1400 metres.

BARZETTI (J Parkes) - Slow to begin. Held up in the home straight and unable to obtain clear running until inside the 200 metres.

TWEEDLEDEE (C Carmine) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Dictated inwards 1400 metres.

HUNGRY (J Chung) - Dictated inwards 1400 metres.

BENEFACTOR (L Sutherland) -Crowded and checked 1400 metres, losing ground.

HOOTER (K Hercock) - Hampered 1400 metres. Raced in restricted room for the majority of the home straight.

OHIWA SUNSET (N Parmar) - Had to steady and change ground near the 100 metres.

G Lahoud (SHE'S SO RELIABLE) - Advised to exercise care after allowing his mount to shift inwards under hard riding into the line of OHIWA SUNSET, which had to steady and change ground near the 100 metres. Stewards also inquired into the manner in which G Lahoud used his whip in the home straight but could not be conclusively satisfied he had breached the rule. G Lahoud was referred to the Apprentice Mentor regarding the manner in which he used his whip in the home straight.

C Butler (TOBKAY) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted TOBKAY to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of HUNGRY, which was dictated inwards onto TWEEDLEDEE, with this runner also being dictated inwards onto BENEFACTOR, which was then crowded and checked near the 1400 meters. Also hampered were DON'T ASK and HOOTER, which lost ground. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of her licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 17 June until the conclusion of racing on Sunday, 25 June, 5 national riding days.
