GENERAL

S Khetoo advised Stewards he was unable to attend today's meeting due to having injured his leg in a trackwork accident. Mr Khetoo was replaced on his three riding engagements as per the Summary above and advised he would be required to provide a medical clearance prior to riding next.

J Lowry - Admitted a breach of Rule 330(3)(c) in that he failed to make the contract weight for his rides on MR GEE in Race 2 and GINTYS GIRL in Race 7 and was replaced as per the Summary above. After hearing submissions on penalty the Adjudicative Committee suspended Mr Lowry's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing today, up to and including Sunday 2 April, 7 national days.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 HELENSBROOK PROPERTIES 2200m

DIRECT FLIGHT (K Chowdhoory) - Began awkwardly. Over-raced through the early stages when being restrained to obtain cover.

CHOUX IN (K Kalychurun) - Began awkwardly. K Kalychurun was reminded of his obligations to ride his mounts out to the end of the race when circumstances permit.

VULTURE STREET (C Barnes) - Began awkwardly losing ground and was then ridden forward to obtain a position outside the leader. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. When asked to comment on the performance of the favoured runner rider could offer no tangible excuse.

PRINCE ALBY (J Fawcett) - Slow to begin and was then taken back behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

ZAMBEZI ZIPPER (G Saejorhor) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

VAGUE (K Mudhoo) - Briefly held up entering the final straight.

Race 2 M & L NIGHT'N DAY / PETER LYON SHEARING MAIDEN 1200m

SALAAM NAMASTEY (D Bothamley) - Slow to begin.

PULL THE PIN (G Jogoo) - Slow to begin.

LUGGATE LAD (C Campbell) - Slow to begin. Made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly.

INTERMINGLE (D Montes de Oca) - Slow to begin. Held up briefly early in the final straight.

MR GEE (K Chowdhoory) - Raced three wide without cover until near the 700 metres.

THE RED RHINO (K Mudhoo) - Became awkwardly placed on the heels of SACRED DAME passing the 150 metres having to be restrained to avoid heels. After viewing replays and interviewing riders it was established that THE RED RHINO had lay out and away from INTERMINGLE (D Montes de Oca) which had shifted out simultaneous to SACRED DAME (T Moseley) laying in under pressure. D Montes De Oca and T Moseley were both advised to exercise care.

Following the running of this race K Mudhoo, the rider of THE RED RHINO weighed in 0.5kg under his weigh out weight. After examining his lead bag it was found that two small pieces of lead were missing. Stewards were satisfied that the lead bag had been secured properly and was in good order and took the matter no further.

NAZARE (L Callaway) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after not having raced or trialled for three years and was cleared to start. Under pressure passing the 500 metres and gave ground over the concluding stages finishing in a distant last placing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormality. Connections advised they would be giving consideration to the racing future of the gelding.

ANTICIPATE (K Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly and was then restrained behind runners shortly after the start to obtain cover.

DORIS DAY (J Fawcett) - Began awkwardly and was then restrained behind runners shortly after the start to obtain cover.

ROSY CLARK (C Campbell) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start. Held up early in the run home.

GABBY DIAZ (D Montes de Oca) - Raced keenly when being restrained to obtain cover through the early stages.

COSY NOOK (B May) - Over-raced in the early stages.

DARCI'S BELLE (J Kamaruddin) - Over-raced in the early stages and near the 1050 metres had to be restrained away from heels. Held up rounding the final bend.

HEY SOUL SISTER (B Murray) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

SELFIE (K Chowdhoory) - Raced wide without cover throughout. Treated post-race for a laceration to the left hind leg consistent with having been galloped on during the running.

Race 4LYNDSAY MOYLE MEMORIAL CUP 1200mDORIS DIOR (C Campbell) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

ZAC BLACK (G Saejorhor) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

KAPINOS (J Kamaruddin) - Began awkwardly shifting out and hampering PAMPAS. Rider reported he had received a nice run in front throughout however when placed under pressure the gelding had failed to respond and had been disappointing. Connections advised KAPINOS has now been retired as a racing proposition.

PAMPAS (T Moseley) - Hampered at the start. Over-raced through the early and middle stages. Steadied racing into the first bend when placed in restricted room.

SYMPATHIQUE (K Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

GIVEHERAGO (D Montes de Oca) - Raced keenly for a distance passing the 850 metres. Had to shift ground inwards passing the 175 metres to find clear racing room.

RUSSIAN FABLE (C Barnes) - Raced below market expectation. Rider reported the mare had received a good run in the trail however when placed under pressure had been disappointing.

D Montes de Oca (GIVEHERAGO) - Issued with a warning when allowing his mount GIVEHERAGO to shift ground inwards placing PAMPAS in restricted room which had to steady near the 850 metres.

Race 5 EDINBURGH REALTY / WALTER PARKER MEMORIAL MAIDEN 1600m

GIVEALITTLE (B Murray) - Dislodged rider B Murray on the way to the start and escaped riderless for a considerable distance before being caught by the Clerk of the Course. B Murray was uninjured in this incident. GIVEALITTLE was declared a late scratching at 3.39pm by order of the Stewards.

SEVEN ELEVEN (K Chowdhoory) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

QUAVERED (C Campbell) - Blundered on jumping losing ground.

THE PIRANHA (L Callaway) - Slow to begin.

SUSPECT OR VICTIM (T Moseley) - Slow to begin. Rider reported the filly had raced greenly throughout.

REDDINGTON (D Bothamley) - Over-raced on a slow tempo in the early stages. Rider reported the gelding had held its breath during the running.

CLAUDIUS MAXIMUSS (K Kalychurun) - Got its head up on a number of occasions when over-racing through the early stages.

Race 6RMG PUBLICAN'S CUP 1500mPONIARD (J Fawcett) - Began awkwardly contacting EXCHANGE.

EXCHANGE (J Lowry) - Contacted at the start.

CLASSIC DIVA (G Saejorhor) - Lay out rounding the final bend, becoming awkwardly placed on heels and having to steady near the 375 metres.

SEA SHEPHERD (C Campbell) - Lay outwards in the run home and near the 75 metres becoming briefly unbalanced when making made firm contact with FAME SHINES which shifted in under pressure.

FAME SHINES (B May) – Shifted inwards under pressure and made firm contact with SEA SHEPERD.

Following this race the connections of 2nd placed SEA SHEPHERD viewed the replays of the incident near the 75 metres before electing not to proceed with a Protest.

Stewards filed a request for a Ruling under Rule 647 (1) against FAME SHINES being placed first due to rider B May failing to weigh in as required following the race. After hearing evidence from the Stewards and Mr May the Adjudicative Committee disqualified FAME SHINES.

Rider B May admitted a subsequent breach of Rule 647(1)(a) and following submissions on penalty the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of Mr May's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 25 March up to and including Wednesday 3 May, 5½ weeks as well as the forfeiture of Mr May's riding fee for the race.

Race 7 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1600m

PLEASURENPAIN (K Kwo) - Trainer A Hoffman advised the mare has had its joints treated since last racing.

SESTINA (B Murray) - Slow into stride.

PICKENS (K Mudhoo) - Raced keenly through the early stages.

PHYLLITE (T Moseley) - When asked to comment on the performance rider could offer no tangible explanation.

ATOMIC (J Kamaruddin) - When asked to comment on the performance rider advised that the mare had raced too keenly during the running and this had taken its toll.
