| Race 1 | RICCARTON PARK FUNCTION CENTRE MAIDEN 1200m | |

NOVELLA (C Barnes) - Slow to begin and then tailed the field throughout and was not persevered with over the final 400 metres. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised the filly had felt flat throughout the running and when placed under pressure had failed to respond. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

AROWOFDIAMONDS (K Hercock) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. When laying out over the concluding stages improved onto heels having to be steadied.

PEACEMAKER (T Moseley) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

Race 2 CUP WEEK HOSPITALITY ON SALE 20 JUNE 1200m

L Robinson (DELPHILLIUS) - Issued with a warning after presenting DELPHILLIUS with unnotified gear (shadow roll).

MR HASS (D Montes de Oca) - Fractious prior to the start and as a result began awkwardly losing ground. Placed in restricted room having to be steadied passing the 100 metres.

KINDRED SPIRIT (K Chowdhoory) - Restrained from its wide barrier draw to obtain cover shortly after the start.

SELFIE (C Barnes) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

DELPHILLIUS (K Mudhoo) - Lay outwards from the 900 metres. Came together bumping with HE'S READY near the 350 metres and again near the 200 metres.

ELLE AYE LADY (B Murray) - When over racing lay outwards near the 600 metres.

HE'S READY (J Kamaruddin) - Came together bumping with DELPHILLIUS near the 350 metres and again near the 200 metres.

CORRECTION (T Moseley) - Lay inwards throughout the final straight. Held up for the majority of the final straight.

Race 3 GRAND NATIONAL TICKETS ON SALE NOW 1200m

FAH SAI (C Barnes) - Became very fractious and was removed from its barrier to undergo a veterinary examination with the mare being declared a late scratching at 1.39pm. Connections were advised that FAH SAI will now be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stipendiary Stewards prior to racing next.

OH NO NO NO (B May) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up in the final straight having to shift outwards across heels to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres.

ALLASERA (T Moseley) - Slow to begin.

MORE THAN WORDS (K Hercock) - Over raced in the middle stages on a moderate tempo. Held up early in the run home, only gaining clear racing room inside the final 275 metres.

COCKAHOOP (J Kamaruddin) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

SHARPIE (K Chowdhoory) – Checked and clipped a heel shortly after the start. Lay out throughout the race placing the rider at a disadvantage.

GALILEO EXPRESS (K Asano) – Hung outwards throughout the running.

J Kamaruddin (COCKAHOOP) - Admitted a charge in that he permitted his mount COCKAHOOP to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of SHARPIE which was checked and clipping a heel shortly after the start. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of J Kamaruddin's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 24 June until the conclusion of racing on Sunday 2 July, 4 national riding days.

Race 4

SPEIGHT'S SUMMIT ULTRA ON TAP MAIDEN 1400m

THE ARCTIC BLAST (K Chowdhoory) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Made the final bend awkwardly. Denied a run passing the 100 metres when PROPER TWELVE lay outwards, having to shift inwards to obtain clear running.

MONO MISS (R Beeharry) - Slow to begin and then tailed the field throughout and was not persevered with over the final 200 metres. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that in his opinion the filly may not have been suited to the synthetic track conditions.

TRUE HOPE IS SWIFT (K Hercock) - Over raced through the early stages.

PROPER TWELVE (B May) - Lay outwards passing the 100 metres.

PEUT RESPIRER (K Asano) - Briefly held up for a run approaching the 100 metres when LADY INCANTO lay inwards, having to shift outwards across heels to obtain clear running.

Race 5 BOOK A SUITE MID-WINTER XMAS RACES 24 JUNE 1600m

SEGA NA LEQA (K Hercock) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

TAIMATE ROSE (K Chowdhoory) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start. Over raced through the early stages.

TAVANASIA (J Kamaruddin) - Raced three wide without cover through the early stages before being allowed to improve forward to sit outside the leader near the 1100 metres.

RELENTLESS KAYDEN (D Tait) - Raced wide without cover throughout. Over raced for a distance passing the 1200 metres. Rider reported the saddle had shifted backwards shortly after the start.

RICHARD STOMPER (B May) - Held up until inside the final 250 metres.

Race 6 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES 1600m

PINSK (B May) - Declared a late scratching at 3.28pm after refusing to load. Connections were advised that PINSK must barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stipendiary Stewards prior to racing next.

ROYAL KHAN (C Barnes) – From its wide barrier draw was restrained to obtain cover shortly after the start.

BELLA ROSE (K Asano) – Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

HEY SOUL SISTER (K Hannan) - Raced three wide without cover through the early stages before being allowed to improve forward to sit outside the leader from the 1000 metres.

POWER 'N' PASSION (K Chowdhoory) – Held up through the early stages of the run home.

FLOAT (K Hercock) - When questioned regarding performance, rider advised the mare had to work hard through the early stages which had been detrimental to the mare's performance.

Race 7 RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE 1600m

STRIKE FORCE (D Bothamley) - Proved difficult to load delaying the start. Connections were advised a warning would be placed on the gelding's barrier manners. Briefly held up near the 400 metres. Lay inwards through the early stages of the final straight. When questioned regarding performance, the rider could offer no excuse and further advised the gelding had been disappointing. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

CAITLYN JAY (B May) – Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start. Improved onto heels having to be firmly restrained approaching the 1200 metres.

COLOSSAL (G Jogoo) – When racing keenly made the bend near the 1200 metres awkwardly.

FIREGLOW (J Kamaruddin) – Raced wide through the early stages, before being restrained to obtain cover near the 1200 metres.

FINAL SAVINGS (K Hercock) - Over raced through the early and middle stages. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

BAD FLAMINGO (C Barnes) - Held up through the early stages of the run home and was unable to obtain clear running until near the 250 metres.

B May (CAITLYN JAY) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount CAITLYN JAY 6 times (1 more than permitted) prior to the 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of B May's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Thursday 15 June until the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 28 June, 7 national riding days.
