SUPPLEMENTARY

Wellington Racing Club @ Trentham - Saturday 18 March 2023

Race 3 - BRAMCO GRANITE AND MARBLE PREMIER 1600m

RUACHE (W Pinn) – Trainer Mr B Foote advised Stewards that RUACHE underwent a veterinary examination on both Monday 20 March and Tuesday 21 March which revealed no abnormalities. B Foote further advised that the gelding has now been sent for a spell.

Race 9 - PETE'S JOINERY PREMIER 2200m

AVONDALAY (O Bosson) - Te Akau Racing Manager Mr R Trumper reported to Stewards that the mare underwent a veterinary examination on Monday 20 March which revealed no abnormalities. R Trumper further advised it is the stable's intention to carry on with AVONDALAY'S current preparation.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 DAVES PATCH MAIDEN 1800m

TIZ LOUIE (R Elliot) - Came together at the start bumping with LOVE NESST and DIAMOND DIVA and becoming unbalanced.

LOVE NESST (S Weatherley) - Came together at the start bumping with DIAMOND DIVA and TIZ LOUIE. Held up rounding the home turn gaining a run near the 250 metres.

DIAMOND DIVA (J Doyle) - Came together at the start bumping with TIZ LOUIE and LOVE NESST.

TAVI ANN (J Kamaruddin) - Tightened shortly after the start when BOOMTOWN BOY lay out. Raced three wide throughout.

LEGALLY BLONDE (C Barnes) - Raced wide throughout.

BE FLEXI (T Newman) - Lay out rounding the first turn momentarily hampering ROULADE.

BOOMTOWN BOY (L Sutherland) - Rider reported the gelding had to work hard to obtain a forward position and had little left at the end.

Race 2 NEW PLYMOUTH ITM MAIDEN 1200m

SEAMSEW (J Doyle) - Began awkwardly and was slow away.

APOLLYON (M Hudson) - Raced keenly in the early stages and made contact with the hindquarters of GRAEME JOHN near the 1000 metres then continued to over race.

NOBLE BOY (A Goindasamy) - Over raced early and had to be steadied for some distance. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that after over racing the gelding had little left at the finish.

RUN BABY RUN (R Elliot) - Held up in the early stages of the home straight and was denied a run near the 200 metres having to be angled outwards to improve near the 150 metres.

OUR TURN (W Pinn) - Shifted in under pressure inside the final 100 metres having to be straightened.

Race 3 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES MAIDEN 1300m

ZAKAYA (J Kamaruddin) - Shifted out abruptly at the start dictating DAWN ESTELLE outwards into the line of PHOEBE FOX which settled back.

DAWN ESTELLE (K Hercock) - Over raced in the back straight.

POMALO (M Hudson) - Was obliged to improve its position four wide rounding the home turn.

Race 4 MICO 1300m

THE HOTTIE (C Butler) - Began awkwardly and settled some distance back then having to be angled very wide to improve in the home straight. Rider was questioned into her ride and in particular over the early stages after letting her mount settle some distance last. C Butler advised that her riding instructions were to settle back and when being restrained early, THE HOTTIE which was over racing, shifted in across the heels of GRACIE LEE and clipped that runner's heels and blundered getting further back than she intended. C Butler was shown footage of her ride and agreed that she had erred in her judgement in settling some distance back off the body of the field in the middle stages when there was an opportunity to improve.

MAOLLA MISS (J Doyle) - Raced wide throughout.

THOMAS AQUINAS (L Sutherland) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

GRACIE LEE (K Hercock) - Momentarily held up near the 250 metres before being angled outwards to improve.

DONTTELLTIMMY (W Pinn) - Was unable to be ridden out fully over the concluding stages when there was insufficient room to improve.

Race 5 PENINSULAR BEACHFRONT RESORT MOOLOOLABA MAIDEN 1400m

DEE JAY DEE (C Barnes) - Began very awkwardly, rearing and bumping heavily with HI YO SASS BOMB unbalancing the rider and settling some distance last. C Barnes reported that the gelding raced greenly throughout. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a cut lip.

AGERA (V Colgan) - Commenced to over race in the back straight when wide without cover.

STANIMA MAN (J Riddell) - Held up briefly entering the home straight.

Race 6 STELLA ARTOIS 1800m

ABACUS (M Hudson) - Tightened at the start when there was movement from either side.

CASTLE BAY (L Sutherland) - Tightened at the start when there was movement from either side.

GOBUYIT (K Hercock) - Tightened at the start when there was movement from either side. Over raced in the early and middle stages.

INVINCIBEEL (J Kamaruddin) - Tightened at the start when there was movement from either side.

OUTRIVAL (B Grylls) - Tightened at the start when there was movement from either side. Angled inwards for a run which did not eventuate near the 250 metres.

CALVARIA (J Doyle) - Held up over the final stages when there was insufficient room to improve.

K Hercock (GOBUYIT) - Admitted a charge in that she struck her mount GOBUYIT 6 times (1 more than permitted) prior to the 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of K Hercock's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 1 April until the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 5 April, 2 national riding days, and in addition imposed a fine of \$500.

Race 7 BEV ANDREOLI MEMORIAL 1800m

UKHANT TOUCH THIS (C Butler) - Reared at the start resulting in C Butler losing her inside iron for some distance prior to regaining it leaving the home straight on the first round. Failed to run on to any extent in the home straight after settling some distance off the pace throughout. Trainer R Patterson was advised that his apprentice C Butler would be referred to the riding mentor with regard to her lack of judgement in the middle stages of the race where she let her mount lose contact with the body of the field.

JACK THE LASS (C Barnes) - Shifted out under pressure passing the 200 metres simultaneously as MORUS (J Boyle) was improving to its outside which was in turn dictated out hampering I'M RONALDO near the 150 metres. C Barnes and J Doyle were shown footage of their respective rides and advised to exercise greater care when in similar circumstances.

I'M RONALDO (W Pinn) - Rider was questioned into his lack of vigour over the concluding stages. In explanation W Pinn advised that after being dictated outwards and hampered near the 150 metres he considered his mount had run its race. W Pinn was advised that in future he is expected to ride his mount out fully to the finish when able to do so.

Race 8 TRADIES RACEDAY SATURDAY 13TH MAY 3YO MAIDEN 1600m

IN VOGUE (J Kamaruddin) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination at the start after being fractious in the barriers and was cleared to race.

ARMINO (R Elliot) - Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race. Shifted inwards under pressure in the final stages of the home straight when racing greenly.

SALVIN (J Riddell) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

THE IMMIGRANT (V Colgan) - When questioned regarding the disappointing performance, rider could offer no tangible excuse but advised in his opinion the gelding would be better suited to a longer distance.

J Doyle (BELLADONNA LILY) – Issued with a warning after permitting his mount BELLADONNA LILY to shift inwards under hard riding when not sufficiently clear of FIRRIATO (S Weatherley) which was hampered having to steady and change ground near the 150 metres. S Weatherley, the rider of 4th placed FIRRIATO, viewed video footage of the home straight but elected not to proceed with an objection against 2nd placed BELLADONNA LILY.
