RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 SVS STARTING GATES MAIDEN HURDLE 2800

HERE'S JOHNNY (H McNeill) - Slow to begin.

BLACK EYED SUE (E Farr) - Began awkwardly losing ground after being fractious in its barrier stall.

JAN'S GIANT (B Lammas) - Slow to begin. Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Hit the third to last fence, losing ground. Retired from the race prior to jumping the final two fences. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

FABULOUS NANCY (P Matthews) - Slow to begin.

THE MIGHTY SPAR (A Kuru) – Raced wide in the early stages. Misjudged the last fence.

LOCHWINNOCH (D Parker) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Hit the fence near the 900 metres losing ground.

RENEGADE FIGHTER (K Wiles) – Misjudged the fourth fence, losing ground. Hit the fence near the 900 metres dislodging its rider. K Wiles was attended to by the oncourse Doctor and stood down from his remaining rides. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the gelding to be lame in the right hind leg. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to the gelding racing next.

PASSWORD (S Karnicnik) – Misjudged the second to last fence.

Race 2 FAIRVIEW MOTORS WAIKATO HURDLE 3200

ABU DHABI (H McNeill) - Misjudged the first fence.

TWEEDLEDEE (P Matthews) - Hit the third fence. Over-raced in the early stages. Misjudged the second to last fence, unbalancing its rider. Misjudged the last fence, losing ground.

LEITRIM LAD (E Farr) - Over-raced in the early stages. Misjudged the fence near the 2000 metres, losing ground and unbalancing its rider. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding made abnormal breathing noises during the running and in her opinion, may have choked down. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

VERRY FLASH (S Fannin) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

ENGLISH GAMBLER (D Parker) – Inclined to run down its fences throughout. Hit the fence near the 1200 metres, losing ground. Retired from the race prior to jumping the last fence. Lost the near front plate during the running.

Race 3 MIKE STENT DECORATORS SPRINT 1200

MR UNIVERSE (B Rogerson) – Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages after jumping from the outside barrier.

FOLLOW YOUR DREAMS (T Newman) - Over-raced in the early stages.

Following the running of this race, the track was downgraded to a Heavy 8.

Race 4 GREENE BROTHERS 2100

ONEZEDBEE (C Grylls) - Slow to begin.

LOT OF ZEES (T Abel) - Slow to begin.

TOBIAS (E Nicholas) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

MY MAEBELLINE GIRL (A Goindasamy) – Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

BEAU ARCHERS ROSE (A Lawson-Carroll) - Rider dropped his whip near the 300 metres.

N Parmar (PRISMATIC) – Reminded of his obligations in that he must ride his mounts out fully to the end of the race when circumstances permit him to do so.

Following the running of this race, the track was downgraded to a Heavy 9.

Race 5 TAUMARUNUI RACING CLUB @ TE RAPA 29/7 MAIDEN STEEPLECHASE 3900

TORQUE TIME (B Lammas) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

FANTASY FLIGHT (D Parker) - Fell at the fourth fence dislodging its rider. D Parker was attended to by the oncourse Doctor and stood down from his remaining ride. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

AQUILO (M Roustoby) – Severely hampered by the fallen runner at the fourth fence, losing ground. Jumped indifferently throughout.

MONITOR (S Karnicnik) - Severely hampered by the fallen runner at the fourth fence, losing ground.

BEAUDACEA (N Downs) – Put in a poor jump at the sixth fence. Jumped the fence near the 1600 metres awkwardly, losing ground.

Race 6 SIGNATURE HOMES WAIKATO STEEPLECHASE 3900

IZYMYDAAD (S Karnicnik) - Stumbled on landing then fell, dislodging its rider, after jumping the sixth fence. S Karnicnik was attended to by the oncourse Doctor and found to be uninjured. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

DAL KILCHOAN (P Matthews) - Jumped indifferently in the early stages. Retired from the race after jumping the stand double. When questioned, the rider advised that the gelding felt indifferent in its action entering the middle and had not improved after jumping the stand double, so she elected to pull her mount up. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found a superficial cut to the right front cannon area.

Following the running of this race, the track was downgraded to a Heavy 10.

Race 7 RACE A HORSE WITH TE AKAU MILE 1600

WORDSWORTH (M Hashizume) - Slow to begin.

THUNDER (K Hannan) - Slow to begin.

SEAJETZ (N Parmar) – Shifted out just prior to the winning post making contact with AOTEA LAD.

AOTEA LAD (N Hailey) - Contacted just prior to the winning post.

N Parmar (SEAJETZ) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount SEAJETZ eight times prior to the 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of N Parmar's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 21 June up to and including racing on Wednesday 5 July, 8 national riding days.

T Moodley (CRYSTALLIZE) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount CRYSTALLIZE ten times prior to the 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of T Moodley's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 21 June up to and including racing on Thursday 29 June, 5 national riding days.

T Moodley (CRYSTALLIZE) - Issued with a warning after using his whip in two consecutive strides on his mount CRYSTALLIZE near the 225 metres with Stewards taking into account his clear recent record with regards to a breach of this whip rule.

T Moodley (CRYSTALLIZE) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount CRYSTALLIZE in two consecutive strides near the 75 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a fine of \$150.

Race 8 BILL GOSS – 101 ON 29TH JUNE MAIDEN 1400

NANCHO GIRL (T Newman) - Over-raced in the early stages. Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

THE FINNSTER (D Cooper) - Reared as the start was effected then knuckled shortly after, unbalancing its rider and losing ground.

TAVIARMA (N Parmar) – Contacted leaving the barriers. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the filly failed to handle today's heavy track conditions. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

CIMARRON (H McNeill) – Began awkwardly then contacted leaving the barriers, losing ground.

DRACHMA (A Lawson-Carroll) – Rider dropped his whip near the 200 metres.

Race 9 HAYDEN ROE @ RICHARDSONS REAL ESTATE PAUANUI 1500

SULABELLA (E Nicholas) – Bounded as the start was effected, losing ground.

CANNY MAN (M Hashizume) - Slow to begin.

IDEAL (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly.

LOVE AFFIRMATIONS (A Lawson-Carroll) – Over-raced in the early stages.

HOT PINX (A Goindasamy) - Raced keenly in the early stages having to be steadied off heels when placed in restricted room near the 1300 metres.

HACKSAW RIDGE (T Thornton) - Raced keenly when being steadied passing the 1300 metres, shifting outwards placing HOT PINX in restricted room.

Race 10 FAREWELL & THANKS CLAIRE HORNSEY 1300

INDEEM (A Lawson-Carroll) - Slow to begin.

OUR TURN (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly.

RUSSIAN SATIRE (K Hannan) - Held up early in the final straight.

CHANTARI BAY (T Newman) - Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 350 metres to the inside of RUSSIAN SATIRE which shifted inwards when not sufficiently clear. K Hannan was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

H McNeill (RAGAMUFFIN) - Stewards inquired into the manner in which H McNeill used his whip in the home straight and could not be conclusively satisfied that he had contravened the whip rule.
