**RACE COMMENTS**

**Race 1** | **STAPHANOS AT NOVARA PARK MAIDEN 1200**

**ROC ANTHEM** (H McNeill) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly in the middle stages.

**SUCH IS LIFE** (K Hannan) - Began awkwardly.

**WITHALLMYLOVE** (D Cooper) - Contacted at the start. Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

**MONSANNA** (T Newman) – Crowded at the start. Over-raced in the early stages clipping a heel near the 1100 metres then continued to over-race for a distance.

**MISSYWOOD** (W Kennedy) - Over-raced in the early stages when being restrained.

**RIDGEVIEW MANDY** (C Barnes) - Raced wide throughout.

**CARTER RUSSELL** (T Mitchell) - Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight. When questioned regarding the performance, rider reported that the gelding failed to handle today's holding track conditions.

**HIGHLY GIFTED** (A Goindasamy) - When questioned regarding the performance rider reported that the gelding raced greenly and would benefit from today's experience.

**Race 2** | **BARFOOT & THOMPSON 1200**

**SALTNESSE** (H McNeill) - Began awkwardly, losing ground.

**CHARMER** (C Barnes) - Contacted at the start, losing ground. Over-raced in the early stages.

**WHISKEY N' RYE** (A Goindasamy) - Raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages. Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

**QUIRKY HABITS** (M Hashizume) - Lay out over the concluding stages.

**MEDATSU** (S Spratt) - Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight. Steadied over the concluding stages to avoid the heels of QUIRKY HABITS which lay out.

| <p><b>BRECKON POWER</b> (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>HIT THE SWITCH</b> (E Nicholas) – Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>WHOSHE’S GIRL</b> (V Jalalkuncha) - Slow to begin. Steadied to avoid the heels of LEX’S ONE approaching the 800 metres. H McNeill was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground in similar circumstances. Finished a distant last. Connections were advised that the mare is required to barrier trial to Stewards satisfaction prior to racing next.</p> <p><b>LEX’S ONE</b> (H McNeill) - Improved onto the heels of SAGAN having to be steadied near the 800 metres.</p> <p><b>APERITIF</b> (T Mitchell) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages when leading.</p> <p><b>C’EST MOI</b> (A Goindasamy) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running room early in the final straight.</p> <p><b>SAGAN</b> (W Kennedy) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no explanation.</p> <p><b>N Parmar</b> (MALBOROUGH BAY) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount MALBOROUGH BAY six times prior to the 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension N Parmar’s licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 5 July up to and including racing on Saturday 15 July, 7 national riding days.</p>  |                                   |
| <b>Race 4</b>   | <b>NZB AIRFREIGHT MAIDEN 1400</b> |
| <p><b>NOTABADBAR</b> (K Hannan) - Crowded at the start losing ground.</p> <p><b>ETIENNE</b> (S Spratt) - Jumped outwards at the start making contact with SON OF SUN.</p> <p><b>SON OF SUN</b> (A Lawson-Carroll) - Crowded at the start when ETIENNE jumped outwards.</p> <p><b>MY EXPLOSIVE</b> (B Rogerson) - Began awkwardly making contact with STASH. Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p><b>LA CREME</b> (W Kennedy) - Began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>FINAL PURCHASE</b> (N Parmar) - Hampered approaching the 200 metres when MY EXPLOSIVE lay outwards.</p> <p><b>STASH</b> (R Elliot) - When questioned regarding the performance rider reported that the gelding was unsuited to the holding track conditions and would derive benefit from today’s race.</p> <p><b>N Parmar</b> (FINAL PURCHASE) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount FINAL PURCHASE six times prior to the 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension N Parmar’s licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 15 July up to and including racing on Wednesday 2 August, 9 national riding days. Stewards directed N Parmar to continue consulting with an NZTR appointed Rider Skills Review Panel for remedial training under the provisions of [Rule 343] given his poor record in regards to this section of the whip rules.</p> |                                   |
| <b>Race 5</b>   | <b>NZB INSURANCE MAIDEN 1600</b>  |
| <p><b>ZIPPIILY</b> (A Lawson-Carroll) - Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>GEE VEE CRYSTAL</b> (C Barnes) – Began awkwardly. Raced wide without cover in the early stages.</p>  |                                   |

**N Hailey** (TIMELESS) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount TIMELESS eight times prior to the 100 metre mark with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a fine of \$500.

**Race 6** | **BETAVET MAIDEN 1600**

**POSITIVE POWER** (W Kennedy) - Slow to begin.

**MYTURN** (B Grylls) - Slow to begin.

**MISTER PUCCI** (M Hashizume) - Jumped inwards at the start making contact with FOODIE BROTHERS.

**FOODIE BROTHERS** (D Cooper) - Inconvenienced at the start when MISTER PUCCI jumped inwards.

**UHTRED** (T Mitchell) - Over-raced in the early stages when leading.

**MIDDLE KHAN** (M Sanson) - Raced ungenerously in the early stages.

**TYNESIDER** (C Barnes) - Hampered near the 1200 metres.

**SHE WROTE MORE** (S Spratt) - Raced keenly in the middle stages.

**AFTERMATH** (H McNeill) – Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

**Race 7** | **TRELAWNEY STUD 1600**

**MANDALO** (B Rogerson) - Slow to begin.

**MEANDEEL** (K Asano) - Began awkwardly.

**DROP OF SOMETHING** (R Elliot) - Raced in restricted room passing the 150 metres to the outside of SONOFABUTCHER which was shifting out.

**FARRENC** (T Moodley) - Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

**EL COOLIO** (A Goindasamy) - Rider reported that the gelding felt indifferent in its action following the race. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the gelding to be 4/5 lame in the right front tendon. Connections were advised that the gelding would require a veterinary clearance prior racing next.

**Race 8** | **ELLERSLIE EVENTS 1600**

**PICK OF THE LITTER** (E Nicholas) - Slow to begin.

**C'EST UNE STAR** (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin.

**VISTOWN** (W Kennedy) - Slow to begin. Over-raced in the early stages.

**THEODEN** (S McKay) - Over-raced in the early stages.

**PUDDIN 'N' PIE** (H McNeill) – Over-raced in the early stages when being restrained.

**GREASE LIGHTNING** (S Spratt) - Raced keenly in the middle stages.

**E Nicholas** (PICK OF THE LITTER) - Issued with a warning after she struck her mount PICK OF THE LITTER six times prior to the 100 metre mark with Stewards taking into account her clear recent record with regards to a breach of this whip rule.

**Race 9**

**STELLA ARTOIS 2100**

**PARADING** (C Barnes) - Began awkwardly, losing ground (4L). Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed against the mare's racing manners.

**THE BAMBINO** (T Moodley) - Crowded at the start, clipping a heel.

**HUSK** (K Hannan) - Restrained at the start from its wide barrier.

**QUEEN SARABI** (K Asano) - Lay out abruptly near the 150 metres when placed under pressure.
