Race 2 – CARPET MAINTENANCE & CLEANING MAIDEN 1200m

NEXT BROKEN HEART – Trainer R Patterson became aware on race morning a runner from his stable, VOODOO CHILD, was inadvertently loaded and transported to the Wanganui race meeting in place of the nominated and accepted NEXT BROKEN HEART. Stewards established the runner presented was VOODOO CHILD and scratched NEXT BROKEN HEART at 10.38am. Trainer R Patterson admitted a breach of Rule 404(2) and was fined \$500.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 | **WANGANUI-TARANAKI RACEHORSE OWNERS ASSOCIATION MAIDEN 2YO 800m**

SHERICKA (M Hudson) - Slow to begin.

REVOLT (J Parkes) - Reared at the start losing ground. Briefly steadied over the concluding stages to avoid the heels of LOVE TANIA, which was laying outwards.

LIMA (T Davies) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

HIGH HEAVEN (T Newman) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

LOVE TANIA (M Singh) - Made contact with the running rail becoming briefly unbalanced near the 500 metres. Lay outwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.

BODACIOUS KATE (T Bau) - Lay outwards entering the home straight.

Race 2 | **CARPET MAINTENANCE & CLEANING MAIDEN 1200m**

PROISSTAR (M Hudson) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

TAMBERI (C Lindsay) - Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover throughout.

RITA BONITA (K Hannan) - Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained. Held up for clear running until near the 100 metres.

PRADASPHERE (L Sutherland) - Steadied near the 800 metres when improving onto the heels of RITA BONITA.

HEADLINE NEWS (K Hercock) - Improved on to heels approaching the 800 metres having to be steadied. Again steadied away from the heels of ALPINO approaching the 600 metres.

MY MAN'S BACK (J Kamaruddin) - Steadied 800 metres.

PERFECT POSY (T Allan) - Steadied when racing in restricted room approaching the 1000 metres. Steadied 800 metres.

PASHAMALA (M Singh) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

Race 3 | **JOLT COFFEE HOUSE 1200m**

LEON ROUGE (M Hudson) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

REINE D'AMOUR (T Newman) - Restrained at the start from a wide barrier.

JUS WING IT (T Davies) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

VIOLETSRBLUE (T Mitchell) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

SPIRIT OF BEXLEY (C Barnes) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

ICONIC LASS (K Hannan) - Held up entering the final straight until passing the 250 metres.

Race 4 | **MANAWATU SOUND SERVICE HANDICAP 1340m**

HARDTIMES (J Parkes) - Restrained at the start from its wide barrier.

SMARTARC (M Hudson) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

KELLYS INSPIRATION (J Riddell) - Steadied approaching the 1100 metres when NOTSOMODEST shifted in. Hampered near the 500 metres when INSIDE STORY shifted inwards.

GALLIVANTER (T Newman) - Raced keenly through the early stages.

LUCKY PARK (K Hercock) - Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained. Inconvenienced near the 500 metres when INSIDE STORY shifted inwards.

BARRI HYDE (T Taiaroa) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

BELLE ADAIRE (B Grylls) - Hampered passing the 1000 metres when INSIDE STORY shifted outwards away from heels.

INSIDE STORY (K Bakker) - Improved onto the heels of PRECIOUS NIAMH, having to shift outwards passing the 1000 metres.

TAP DANCER (L Douglas) - Finished last. Connections advised the filly's future would be reconsidered.

Race 5 | **MARK BUCKLEY MEMORIAL MAIDEN 3YO 1340m**

VALLEY KING (T Taiaroa) - Slow to begin. Shifted inwards under pressure passing the 200 metres when only marginally clear of PRINCESS ELLY, which had to change ground outwards to improve. Connections of the 2nd-placed PRINCESS ELLY viewed footage but elected not to proceed with an objection.

LADY OF THE NIGHT (A Bohorun) - Knuckled at the start losing ground.

SCHUSKI (T Mitchell) - Raced keenly in the early stages. Commenced to give ground rounding the final turn finishing a distant last. Rider reported the gelding felt indifferent in its action. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

KNOCK OFF (K Hercock) - Over-raced in the early stages.

GUESSING GAME (J Parkes) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout. Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages to the inside of KNOCK OFF and outside SNIPERS DREAM.

ZEDDIANI (M Hudson) - Steadied away from the heels of STEAL MY THUNDER (L Sutherland) which shifted inwards near the 1100 metres when not fully clear. L Sutherland was shown footage of her ride in the presence of the Apprentice Mentor and issued with a warning.

L Sutherland (STEAL MY THUNDER) - Issued with a warning after allowing her mount to shift inwards near the 1100 metres when not the required distance clear of ZEDDIANI.

Race 6 | **O'LEARY CLAN MAIDEN 1600m**

PANIC AND RUN - C Carmine was unable to make the weight for PANIC AND RUN and was fined \$200. C Carmine was replaced by M Hudson.

CALL ME SASSY (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin.

REGGIE RULER (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin. Brushed the rail near the 1200 metres.

SCOOBYWILLDO (C Lindsay) - Slow to begin.

PERFECT TEST (T Mitchell) - Commenced to race ungenerously passing the 1400 metres, making the first bend awkwardly.

PANIC AND RUN (M Hudson) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

MOMENTS LIKE THESE (K Hercock) - Angled inwards on entering the home straight in order to improve.

EL TAJIN (K Hannan) - Finished some distance last. When questioned K Hannan had no excuse. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality. Trainer W Thurlow undertook to monitor the gelding over coming days and report any anomaly to Stewards adding that consideration would be given to spelling the gelding.

Race 7 | **GUTHRIE BOWRON MAIDEN 1600m**

FLANEUR (L Sutherland) - Began awkwardly.

WHO'S COMPLAININ (A Bohorun) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

C Lindsay (THE WITCH) - Shown footage of her ride in the presence of the Apprentice Mentor after improving her mount rapidly in the early stages when in the Steward's opinion the preferred option would be, after drawing wide, to obtain cover.

Race 8 | **G BRISTOL & SONS MAIDEN 2040m**

CLASSY LADY (M Hudson) - Reared at the start losing ground.

OUR BLUEY (T Davies) - Slow to begin.

SKY CRUZA (Mahipal Singh) - Crowded at the start.

JACK SHOW (C Barnes) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Struggled to maintain contact with the body of the field throughout. C Barnes had no excuse.

SOMETHING UNUSUAL (K Hercock) - Steadied passing the winning post on the first occasion when KARA ZOR EL (B Grylls) shifted inwards when not fully clear. B Grylls was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

TELLEMALIE (K Hannan) - Over-raced rounding the turn into the back straight having to be steadied for some distance.

Race 9 | **WANGANUI GREYHOUND RACING CLUB RACING TONIGHT 2040m**

JUSTASKPERCEY (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin.

ALL IN BLACKBERRY (M Hudson) - Slow to begin.

GRAND PROSPECT (J Kamaruddin) - Briefly steadied passing the winning post on the first occasion when the pace eased.

FREE RANGE (M Singh) - Rider dropped his whip near the 300 metres.
