### RACE COMMENTS

#### Race 1 TAGGART EARTHMOVING RATING 75 1400m

**ARCTIC GLOW** (C Campbell) - Reluctant to load delaying the start. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed on ARCTIC GLOW's barrier manners and it would continue to be loaded first until its barrier manners improve. Held up for a short distance passing the 400 metres. Lay in over the concluding stages and near the 50 metres brushed with WILD ROVER.

**WILD ROVER** (K Chowdhury) - Crowded on jumping shifting inwards abruptly crowding inside runners. Lay inwards in the run home and had to be straightened passing the 225 metres. Brushed by ARCTIC GLOW over the concluding stages.

**ENOUGH SAID** (J Kamaruddin) - Crowded on jumping losing ground.

**ZADANE** (G Jogoo) - Slow in the early stages.

**BARI** (K Hannan) - Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. Following a veterinary inspection BARI was confirmed to have bled. BARI shall not be ridden in exercise for a period of two months or start in any race or trial for a period of three months, and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a Veterinarian.

**K Hannan** (BARI) - Stewards enquired into the manner in which rider K Hannan used her whip in the home straight and could not be conclusively satisfied that she had contravened the rules.

**C Campbell** (ARCTIC GLOW) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount ARCTIC GLOW 6 times (1 more than permitted) prior to the 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a fine of \$500.

<b>Race 2</b>	<b>DRUG ALCOHOL TESTING SPECIALISTS 2YO 1000m</b>
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**LIGAR LASS** (B Murray) - Slow to begin.

**MAIRE AN LASA** (K Hannan) - Shifted out at the start crowding outside runners.

**PICK UP THE BLAZE** (T Moseley) - Shifted in at the start crowding inside runner.

**AMIINIT** (K HercocK) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

**ASCEND** (C Campbell) - Crowded at the start losing some ground. Hampered near the 900 metres.

**CLIODHNA MAEVE** (K Williams) - Crowded shortly after the start. Brushed with inside runner passing the 50 metres.

**IDEAL SURVIVOR** (J Kamaruddin) - Shifted inwards shortly after the start crowding inside runner. Lay inwards throughout the run home.

**EMPRESS SUIKO** (L Douglas) - Lay outwards near the 900 metres and shifted out abruptly hampering outside runner.

**MOVE ON** (C Barnes) - Lay out over the concluding stages and brushed with CLIODHNA MAEVE passing the 50 metres.

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>BAIN MCCALL MEMORIAL RATING 1000m</b>
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**BRACERO** (T Moseley) - Fractious prior to despatch then began awkwardly losing ground.

**MISS NICO BELLE** (K Hannan) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start.

**MAKABAR** (K Chowdhooey) - When asked to comment on the apparent improved performance, co-trainer M Pitman advised that the gelding had a good winter track record and was suited by today's conditions aided by a patient ride from a senior rider.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>DAPHNE BANNAN MEMORIAL OPEN HANDICAP 1200m</b>
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**GOLDEN HARVEST** (K Chowdhooey) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**OKAY PAL** (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin (3L).

**EMANON** (L Sutherland) - Lay in and bumped with LOUIE LOUISE passing the 450 metres. Rider advised she had not been disappointed with today's effort, believing the mare would take natural benefit from its first run in around seven weeks.

**BENAUD** (D Montes de Oca) - Lay inwards throughout the run home.

**DIVINE DIVE** (K Hannan) - Raced in restricted room near the 250 metres when taken inwards by LOUIE LOUIE onto THE GOOD SHEPHERD which had shifted out to find clear racing room.

**SERIOUSLY** (K Williams) - Eased down over the concluding stages. Rider advised that the gelding had been disappointing and could offer no tangible excuse.

**ADANNAYA** (C Barnes) - Rider reported the mare was not comfortable in today's track conditions.

**Race 5** | **SAM KEENAN – TENNIS COACH RATING 65 1400m**

**GOODANYA** (Y Atchamah) - Restrained on jumping to take cover from a wide draw.

**WEE TADHG** (K Kwo) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**AREYOUOKAY** (L Sutherland) - Over raced in the early stages. Lost the inside side-winker passing the 575 metres.

**MR RAFIKI** (R Jaun) - Over raced on a slow tempo through the early stages. Shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 700 metres and in doing so made firm contact with MIDNIGHT JANE which was dictated wider on the track. Apprentice R Jaun was shown replays of his ride for educational purposes in the presence of the Riding Mentor.

**RABADA** (K Chowdhoo) - Over raced in the early to middle stages. When asked to comment on today's performance, the rider was of the opinion the gelding had not handled today's testing track conditions.

**MIDNIGHT JANE** (K Hannan) - Raced wide throughout. Bumped by inside runner and pushed wider on the track passing the 700 metres.

**MACRAES** (L Douglas) - Finished a distant last, with the rider advising that the gelding had been less than genuine in its efforts today. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

**Race 6** | **GREENWOOD AMBERLEY CUP 1600m**

**JILDI JILDI** (A Balloo) - Slow to begin.

**SO MUCH MOUR** (L Sutherland) - Over raced through the early stages on a slow tempo. Raced wide throughout.

**SEA SHEPHERD** (C Campbell) - Over raced in the early stages on a slow tempo. Held up in the initial stages of the run home. When asked to comment on today's performance, the rider could offer no tangible excuse other than the gelding may not have appreciated the slow tempo of the race.

**Race 7** | **OPTIMISE FERTILISERS & EQUI-LISE RATING 75 2000m**

**TARAMEA LAD** (K Williams) - Slow to begin.

**HEY MICKEY** (L Sutherland) - Crowded at the start. Raced wide from the 1000 metres.

**FIVE PRINCES** (Y Atchamah) - Crowded at the start. Raced keenly on a slow tempo through the early stages having to be restrained off heels on a number of occasions.

**DEELS DONE** (L Douglas) - Shifted outwards abruptly at the start crowding outside runners.

**ESTABLISHMENT** (K Mudhoo) - Crowded at the start. Over raced on a slow tempo through the early stages.

**PROSERVE** (J Kamaruddin) - Lay outwards at the start crowding outside runners. Rider reported the gelding had not been entirely comfortable in today's track.

**THE TUI TOILER** (G Jogoo) - Crowded shortly after the start when an inside runner lay outwards. Over raced near the 1500 metres having to be steadied off heels.

**EAVESDROP** (C Campbell) - Raced wide and over raced on a slow tempo through the early stages.

**TAKE THE DEEL** (T Moseley) - Improved wide from the 1500 metres.

**JAKKALNUTS** (C Barnes) - Improved wide from the 1500 metres to lead near the 1300 metres.

**STAR BALLOT** (K Chowdhoo) - Rider reported the gelding had not been entirely comfortable in today's track.

<b>Race 8</b>	<b>JON SNOW &amp; ECHOES OF HEAVEN @ CLEARVIEW PARK 2000m</b>
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**DIVOVSKI** (L Douglas) - Restrained on jumping from a wide draw to take cover.

**ANTICIPATE** (G Jogoo) - Restrained on jumping from a wide draw to take cover. Rider reported the mare had battled in the conditions and had disappointed.

**KLEAR THE DECK** (C Barnes) - Shifted outwards hampering outside runner at the start.

**BAILADOR** (D Montes de Oca) - Hampered at the start. Crowded passing the 1800 metres. Lay inwards passing the 900 metres when under pressure.

**CAPTAIN OUMUAMUA** (K Hannan) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**TANTALEE** (T Moseley) - Lay inwards approaching the 1800 metres crowding inside runner.

**ASTRADEEL** (T Comignaghi) - Lay inwards throughout the home straight.
