RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 SADDLERY WAREHOUSE MAIDEN 1550

LADY ROSETTI (K Hannan) - Slow to begin.

SENTRY (W Kennedy) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained. Laid inwards in the home straight proving difficult for its rider.

NIGHT FIRE (J Fawcett) - Began awkwardly.

ELUSIVE CAPITAL (T Mitchell) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

CONNIE (B Grylls) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

MERSEY BEAT (C Barnes) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Had to be steadied near the 1200 metres when RIKKI RICARDO was forced inwards by NIGHT FIRE.

RIKKI RICARDO (A Lawson-Carroll) – Had to be steadied off heels when NIGHT FIRE shifted inwards when not sufficiently clear near the 1200 metres.

NEREUS (M McNab) – Over-raced in the middle stages. Laid out entering the home straight.

J Fawcett (NIGHT FIRE) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift in when not sufficiently clear of RIKKI RICARDO which had to be steadied near the 1200 metres, with Stewards taking into account the easing the pace approaching the 1200 metres.

Race 2 WAIPA EARTHWORKS 1550

UP 'N' GONE (C Grylls) - Crowded at the start. Changed legs on numerous occasions in the home straight, proving difficult for its rider.

RUA ROCKS (N Hailey) - Began awkwardly. Over-raced in the early stages when racing three wide.

NIGELLA LANE (M McNab) - Slow to begin. Over-raced in the early stages.

ELUSIVE NATION (T Mitchell) - Contacted the running rail becoming briefly unbalanced passing the 1300 metres.

YOU KNOW (D Cooper) - Shifted in abruptly passing the 1300 metres briefly unbalancing its rider.

JIMMY DEAN (K Asano) – Over-raced in the middle stages. Raced wide without cover from near the 800 metres. Stewards inquired into the riding tactics from the 800 metres to the winning post. Jockey K Asano reported the gelding began to over-race when the tempo slowed in the middle stages and elected to race wider from the 800 metres to give his mount every opportunity to improve in the race.

OUR TRISTABELLE (W Kennedy) - Steadied entering the home straight.

MONZA (J Fawcett) – Shied at the winning post.

Race 3 PRYDE'S EASIFEED MAIDEN 1300

MISTA STITCH (B Grylls) – Slow to begin. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

MISS SOLITAIRE (J Allen) - Began awkwardly.

STYLISH RED (M Sanson) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

THE ARCHITECT (T Newman) - Crowded at the start losing ground. Over-raced in the early stages.

MS CANDEE LANE (T Thornton) – Had to be steadied off heels approaching the 1100 metres when over-racing. Laid in approaching the 400 metres.

NYSTROM (A Goindasamy) – Raced keenly in the middle stages.

BOUNTY OF THE SEA (W Kennedy) - Made the turn leaving the back straight awkwardly. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

STYLISH RED (M Sanson) - Shifted out approaching the 100 metres to obtain clear running.

Race 4 ITM/GIB WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP MAIDEN 3YO 1300

SMILESPARKLESHINE (T Mitchell) - Slow to begin. Apprentice T Mitchell reported that the gelding never travelled comfortably throughout today's race. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality. Connections were advised that the gelding would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

OUR MILLY BEE (J Allen) – Crowded at the start.

TIMING (M McNab) - Began awkwardly.

ROC ON HOME (T Abel) – Began awkwardly contacting the runner to its outside. Over-raced in the middle stages.

RADRADRA (K Hannan) - Began awkwardly. Improved onto heels approaching the 1000 metres having to be steadied.

DELOREAN (J Fawcett) - Raced keenly in the early stages. Briefly steadied approaching the 1000 metres when racing in restricted room.

TRU PLANET (B Grylls) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages when leading.

GOOD BROTHERS (E Nicholas) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

THE YAMOTO (C Grylls) – Laid in approaching the 700 metres. When questioned regarding the performance Jockey C Grylls advised that he was disappointed with the gelding's effort and could offer no explanation. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the gelding to have mucus present in the trachea.

Race 5 ITM/GIB WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP MAIDEN 2YO 1300

SAKURA SEASON (C Grylls) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Commenced to race wide without cover from near the 1000 metres. Jockey C Grylls reported that the filly over-racing throughout, contributed to its below average performance today.

SPRING QUEEN (K Asano) – Steadied shortly after the start when BEVANDA shifted in. Jockey B Grylls was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground when not sufficiently clear.

BEVANDA (B Grylls) - Shifted in shortly after the start resulting in SPRING QUEEN having to be steadied.

Race 6 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES 1300

SHAMPAGNE DANCER (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly. Raced four wide before working forward to sit outside the leader near the 800 metres.

NO TIME TO JAZZ (E Nicholas) – Contacted at the start by SHAMPAGNE DANCER which began awkwardly.

AFTER PARTY (B Grylls) - Restrained at the start from its wide barrier.

ANGELS WINGS (J Allen) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

AVAYA (K Asano) – Momentarily held up entering the home straight.

HASSTOBEFAST (M McNab) – Saddle shifted back during the race.

Race 7 CAMBRIDGE EQUINE HOSPITAL MAIDEN 970

KENOBI (W Kennedy) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

POKURU SHOW (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Over-raced throughout.

STAR TRAIL (A Goindasamy) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight, going to the line untested.

MONSANNA (T Newman) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

MEDINA (M McNab) – Hung out throughout the race. Raced in restricted room approaching the 500 metres having to be steadied.

Race 8 MARCUS GRAYLING BUILDERS 2000

ORSOME DUDE (N Hailey) - Began awkwardly briefly unbalancing its rider. Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

HARMONIA (M McNab) - Crowded at the start. Briefly held up entering the final straight.

FELIX FAURE (B Grylls) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages when leading.

OUTRIVAL (S Spratt) - Steadied to avoid the heels of BURCHA near the 400 metres.

BURCHA (A Goindasamy) - Had to be steadied when improving onto heels leaving the straight on the first occasion then again when TURNMEON shifted out when not sufficiently clear near the 400 metres.

J Allen (TURNMEON) – Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift out when not sufficiently clear of BURCHA which was steadied near the 400 metres.

Race 9 MAGNUM INDUSTRIES MAIDEN 2000

EVIDENTLY (S Spratt) - Began awkwardly.

BLUSHING RUDOLF (T Newman) - Began awkwardly contacting CADA CAMINO.

CADA CAMINO (T Mitchell) - Contacted by BLUSHING RUDOLF shortly after the start.

SMUG (J Allen) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

QUICK STORY (K Hannan) – Dislodge Apprentice K Hannan in the preliminary and galloped a considerable distance, underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was declared a late scratching @ 4.05pm on veterinary advice. Connections were advised the filly would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.
