RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 | AON INSURANCE BROKERS 2400

THE MIGHTY SPAR (T Moodley) – Reared as the start was effected losing ground. Held up rounding the bend then had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

HIT THE ROAD JACK (C Butler) - Slow to begin. Improved forward through the middle stages to lead near the 900 metres.

ROCCIA (M Hashizume) – Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

LOFTYS GIFT (S Weatherley) – Briefly held up rounding the final bend.

Race 2

CAMBRIDGE RACEWAY 3YO 1600

PRINCESS ADDA (D Prastiyou) - Slow to begin. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the filly had been outpaced in the early stages and had been reluctant to improve. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the filly to be 2/5 lame in the left hind leg. Connections were advised a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.

COLLATERAL DAMAGE (V Colgan) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

PIPER'S SON (C Butler) - Slow to begin.

IN HER PRESENCE (J Kamaruddin) – When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that in his opinion the filly had felt lethargic during the running and failed to respond when placed under pressure.

FELLINI (J Allen) - Inconvenienced shortly after the start. Held up early in the final straight before shifting outwards to obtain clear running near the 200 metres.

DESERT ISLAND (K Asano) – Inconvenienced shortly after the start. Held up until near the 250 metres.

RUDYARD (W Pinn) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

ARMINO (M Hashizume) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

ACCIDENTAL TOURIST (O Bosson) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

NORTHERN RAIDER (T Thornton) - Lay out rounding the final bend.

BOURBON CHIQUE (S Weatherley) - Held up until near the 200 metres.

HE'S BESET (M McNab) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that in his opinion the gelding was feeling the effects of recent racing.

Race 3

DECISE ELECTRICAL AND CONTROL 2YO 1200

PRINCESS TERESA (A Goindasamy) – Crowded leaving the barriers.

LORD WEYBURN (K Asano) – Knuckled leaving the barriers.

TOA TUAHINE (T Thornton) - Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover after jumping from the outside barrier. Had to be firmly restrained after improving onto heels approaching the 100 metres.

SOLIDIFY (R Elliot) - Over-raced passing the 800 metres having to be steadied off heels.

FARRAVALLO (S Weatherley) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

OVERDRAWN (V Colgan) - Held up until near the 200 metres.

Race 4

HUTTON CONTRACTING 1300

DREAM MACHINE (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up early in the final straight. Improved onto heels just prior to the winning post.

WAIRAU COVE (O Bosson) - Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover after jumping from an outside barrier. Steadied off heels near the 700 metres.

LINGJUN HERO (C Lammas) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

KIVA HAN (M Hashizume) - Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 200 metres when UNLEASHED shifted in slightly and ORANGE PEARL shifted outwards. Both C Butler and M Sanson were advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.

MACUSHLA (S Spratt) - When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the mare would be better suited to more rain affected footing.

Race 5 | **INGLIS SALES CAMBRIDGE BREEDERS' STAKES 1200 (G3)**

I CHOOSE YOU (J Kamaruddin) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced keenly in the early stages having to be steadied off heels near the 800 metres.

DENBY ROAD (R Elliot) - Began awkwardly.

PETRUCCI (M McNab) – Began awkwardly. Held up for a distance passing the 350 metres. Lay out when placed under pressure over the concluding stages.

DIVICI BELLE (C Lammas) - Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover after jumping from an outside barrier.

WESTWOOD (W Pinn) - Raced wide without cover throughout. Contacted near the 300 metres.

FLAMEBIRD (C Grylls) - Came together with WESTWOOD near the 300 metres becoming momentarily unbalanced. When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no tangible excuse however had been disappointed in the run. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

BOURBON ROAD (M Hashizume) – Held up for clear running until passing the 100 metres.

Race 6 | **CAMBRIDGE EQUINE HOSPITAL 1400**

JUSTASKME (T Moodley) - Slow to begin.

MARIA FARINA (S Weatherley) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

MAHRAJAAN (A Goindasamy) – Over-raced in the early stages.

MONZA (M Sanson) – Lay out rounding the final bend.

TEVERE (M McNab) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the mare to be 2/5 lame in the right foreleg. Connections were advised a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.

THE FEARLESS ONE (C Butler) - Was presented to race with a tongue tie that was not notified. An investigation was opened and adjourned into this matter.

Race 7 | **TRAVIS STAKES 2000 (G2)**

IRIDESSA (J Kamaruddin) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

THE PERFECT PINK (K Asano) - Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover after jumping from an outside barrier.

LE SABLIER (M Hashizume) - Raced wide in the early stages.

TOWN CRYER (C Grylls) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

LOVE FOR ALL (R Elliot) - Crowded approaching the 350 metres when placed in restricted room to the inside of TOWN CRYER which shifted in slightly, and outside of BLUE MOON which shifted out and away from CIAMBELLA.

KARMAN LINE (C Lammas) - Held up until near the 300 metres.

Race 8

MANELINE CAMBRIDGE 1600

SHE'S OUTRAGEOUS (O Bosson) - Contacted leaving the barriers losing ground.

ROESELARE (S Weatherley) - Contacted leaving the barriers.

DEEP BEAUTY (T Moodley) - Jumped inwards leaving the barriers contacting inside runners.

TAVIDORA (M Hashizume) - Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover after jumping from an outside barrier. Held up for a distance approaching the 200 metres.

THEODEN (K Asano) - Over-raced in the early stages. Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 1200 metres. Raced three wide without cover.

ORLEANS BELLE (M Sanson) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

FLY MY WEY (T Thornton) – Steadied to avoid heels near the 800 metres when DEEP BEAUTY shifted inwards when not full clear. T Moodley was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.

TESTIFY ME (S Spratt) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

EXTRAORDINAIRE (M McNab) - Held up until near the 300 metres.

RANGER (A Goindasamy) - Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

T Moodley (DEEP BEAUTY) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of THEODEN which had to be steadied when placed in restricted room near the 1200 metres.
