Race 8 - NEW ZEALAND BLOODSTOCK WARSTEP STAKES 2000m

INFLAMED (C Campbell) – Co-Trainer Mr S Anderton advised Stewards the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of the filly however it has now been sent for a spell.

Race 10 - RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE 1800m

SASSY CHOUXS (G Jogoo) – Co-trainer Mrs K Parsons reported to Stewards the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of the filly and it is their intention to continue with SASSY CHOUXS' current preparation.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 LIQUORLAND MOSGIEL 2200m

ABRUZZI (D Bothamley) - Contacted then hampered at the start when runners either side shifted ground.

ZAMBEZI ZIPPER (C Barnes) - Slow to begin. Raced three wide without cover passing the 1000 metres before being ridden forward to lead passing the 800 metres.

PAR TEE (C Campbell) - Slow to begin. Held up rounding the final bend.

THE LAST THYME (K Williams) - Raced keenly through the early stages.

Race 2 | **BE MY GUEST DESIGN MAIDEN 1200m**

LIT'L ROCK (C Campbell) - Began awkwardly. Briefly held up passing the 200 metres having to shift ground inwards to find clear racing room.

JIBBITY (B Murray) - Began awkwardly.

ROMEOSJULIET (K Williams) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

DRAMATIC SOPRANO (Y Atchamah) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Over raced in the early stages and wide for the majority of the race.

SACRED DAME (T Comignaghi) - Began awkwardly having to be corrected by its rider losing some ground.

RUTHLESS ROYAL (G Jogoo) - Began awkwardly.

ATAAHUA PIPEDREAM (D Montes de Oca) - Lay outwards throughout the run home. When asked to comment on the apparent improved performance, trainer G Eade advised Stewards the gelding had taken natural benefit from its first up run at Riverton for over 12 months and had continued to work well with a forward showing not unexpected today.

C Campbell (LIT'L ROCK) and **K Mudhoo** (FOREVER BABE) were both reminded of their obligations to ride their mounts fully to the line when circumstances permit.

Race 3 | **GREEN ISLAND GRIZZLIES 1200m**

SILENT BATTLER (Y Atchamah) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination at the barriers after revealing blood in its mouth consistent with hitting the gates and was cleared to race.

DIVINE REGULUS (T Comignaghi) - Became fractious in its barrier and as a result began awkwardly losing ground. Raced keenly through the early stages. Held up over the concluding stages and went to the line not fully tested by its rider.

ZAC BLACK (K Mudhoo) - Slow to begin. Shortly after the start on a slow tempo commenced to race ungenerously getting its head up on a number of occasions before being ridden forward to lead passing the 800 metres.

Race 4 | **NELLIES BAR & RESTAURANT MAIDEN 1400m**

BUDAI (S Khetoo) - Began awkwardly shifting out crowding outside runners and as a result lost ground.

CLAIRE'S PAL (D Bothamley) - Contacted and crowded at the start losing ground.

LET'S GO (S Weatherley) - Contacted and crowded at the start losing ground.

MOLLY SHAW (G Saejorhor) - Began awkwardly and was then crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Raced wide throughout.

MR GEE (K Williams) - Began awkwardly shifting inwards crowding inside runners. Lay inwards in the run home and near the 50 metres made contact with LUSCIOUS LOVER which also shifted ground at this point.

BRICKIE'S MOJO (C Barnes) - Raced keenly in the early stages before being ridden forward to lead near the 700 metres.

Race 5 | **PROPERTY BROKERS DUNEDIN 1600m**

ZENDORA (B Murray) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

TARAMEA LAD (K Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

JAKKALNUTS (S Weatherley) - From its wide barrier was restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

DIRECT FLIGHT (K Williams) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start. Had to shift inwards across heels passing the 100 metres to find clear racing room.

FIERY RED (C Campbell) - Rider lost the use of the whip passing the 250 metres.

AERIAL BLUE (T Comignaghi) - When asked to comment on performance, the rider advised that the mare had not handled today's Heavy track conditions.

Race 6 | **DUNEDIN CITY MOTORS MAIDEN 1600m**

DYNAMO JACK (K Mudhoo) - Raced ungenerously getting its head up on a number of occasions through the early and middle stages.

RACONTEUSE (C Barnes) - Lay out rounding the bend near the 900 metres, with the rider reporting the mare had hung during the running.

SAVANNAH ROCS (T Moseley) - Under pressure passing the 500 metres and gave ground quickly finishing well back, with the rider reporting the mare had not handled today's Heavy track conditions.

FAH LUN (K Williams) - Placed in restricted room and briefly had to steady passing the 450 metres when SAVANNAH ROCS gave ground quickly.

IFFIDIDIT (S Weatherley) - Raced greenly throughout the final straight and shifted ground on a number of occasions.

Race 7 | **POSITIUV E SIGNS + PRINT 1600m**

T Kennedy (ANTICIPATE) - The explanation for late declaration of rider for ANTICIPATE was accepted on this occasion.

DIORADELLE (T Comignaghi) - Slow to begin.

THISTLE (B Murray) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

ANTICIPATE (G Jogoo) - Began awkwardly and was then restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start. Had to change ground passing the 150 metres to find clear racing room. Lay inwards near the 75 metres making contact with LEICA STAR and becoming briefly unbalanced when both runners shifted ground.

SCARLETT'S PROMISE (D Montes de Oca) - Got its head up when over racing in the early stages.

ALBATROSS (K Mudhoo) - Lay inwards in the run home and had to be straightened near the 125 metres.

LEICA STAR (K Williams) - Contacted near the 75 metres becoming briefly unbalanced when tiring.

BLACK CHEETAH (C Barnes) - When asked to comment on performance, the rider could offer no tangible excuse. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

C Campbell (KID ROC) - Issued with a warning after using the whip in 2 consecutive strides on KID ROC just prior to the 100 metres, with Stewards taking into account C Campbell's clear recent record with regard to this whip rule.

Race 8

GRAND CASINO 1400m

N White (STOP YELLING) - Issued with a warning for late declaration of rider.

DARCI'S BELLE (S Weatherley) - Began awkwardly shifting out shortly after the start crowding outside runners.

PURE ZAMBEZI (K Williams) - Contacted then crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home.

DECEPTIO VISUS (D Bothamley) - Jumped away awkwardly then contacted losing ground shortly after the start.

ADIKTIV PASSION (T Moseley) - Rider advised that after beginning awkwardly he got further back than intended during the running however when placed under pressure to improve, his mount had failed to respond and had disappointed.

ANGE DE REVE (T Comignaghi) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

STOP YELLING (G Jogoo) - When asked to comment on the apparent improved performance, trainer N White advised that the gelding had been suited by today's distance and has always raced well at Wingatui.
