RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 TUI BACKING A WINNER SINCE 1889 MAIDEN 1400m

SANPERION (J Chung) - Shifted out abruptly on jumping away, dictating SAINT BERNARD outwards into the line of AL MALIK, which was slow away.

AL MALIK (M McNab) - Slow away. When questioned regarding performance rider reported the gelding was slow to begin which was detrimental to its chances.

SAINT BERNARD (V Jalalkuncha) - Began awkwardly.

VOODOO CHILD (C Lindsay) - Made the turn awkwardly near the 800 metres.

MISS BELLE (T Taiaroa) -- Held up from near the 600 metres and for the majority of the home straight, gaining clear running inside the final 100 metres.

SPLIT (J Parkes) - When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no explanation. Trainer P Didham advised the gelding's racing future will be reassessed.

Race 2 MARTIN COLLINS NZ 1400m

STONYBRECK (M McNab) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination behind the barrier and was cleared to start. Hampered 1250 metres. Lay inwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.

PENNY ROYAL (J Chung) - Shied at a shadow near the 1250 metres and in doing so hampered STONYBRECK.

ZOEY SATIN (T Taiaroa) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

Race 3 MANAWATU AUTO GLASS MAIDEN 1200m

BEE ENCHANTED (J Riddell) - Shifted in abruptly at the start simultaneously as HOT DIP shifted out, resulting in both TAVIARMA and MY MAN'S BACK being tightened and slow away.

TAVIARMA (M McNab) - Tightened at the start. Lay outwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.

MY MAN'S BACK (T Mitchell) - Tightened at the start. Raced wide without cover throughout.

HOT DIP (M Hudson) - Shifted out at the start. Commenced to race ungenerously approaching the 800 metres when being restrained.

PRINCESSA GOLD (T Davies) - Briefly steadied approaching the 800 metres when BEE ENCHANTED (J Riddell) shifted inwards. J Riddell was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

NADHEEMA (T Taiaroa) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

Race 4 ASHHURST DEER AND DUCK INN/HOTEL RAUMAI 1200m

WRITTEN UP (C Butler) - Dislodged rider on way to the start. C Butler was examined by ambulance personnel and cleared to ride.

KELLYS INSPIRATION (M Singh) - Crowded at the start, losing ground.

RAGAMUFFIN (J Riddell) - Slow to begin.

FIZZY MOON (J Chung) - Began awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Had difficulty obtaining clear racing room early in the final straight.

SUSIE JANE (T Davies) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

JUDGE KELLIE (K Hercock) - Lay outwards when placed under pressure in the final straight. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 5 CARTERS "CARTERS TRADE YOUR FIRST STEP" MAIDEN 1000m

TAMBERI (C Lindsay) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

FRENCH ROSE (M McNab) - Slow to begin. Lay inwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.

POKURU SHOW (J Parkes) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

SWAZI (J Riddell) - Bridle became displaced approaching the 800 metres. Trainer J Bary was spoken to and confirmed the ear covers would be removed from SWAZI at its next start.

PERFECT POSY (T Davies) - Lay outwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.

Race 6

e 6 CARTERS "YOUR BUILDING PARTNER" MAIDEN 2140m

NEVER LOOK BACK (C Carmine) - Slow away, then commenced to over-race in the early and middle stages.

LINCOLN THE FOX (M Singh) - Briefly steadied passing the 1400 metres when the pace eased slightly. Improved on to heels having to be steadied near the 800 metres.

MYSTERY BAR (M Hudson) - Over-raced in the early stages so was allowed to stride forward to lead near the 1000 metres. Shifted out under pressure throughout the home straight.

ZOEZ LEGACY (T Mitchell) - Commenced to give ground near the 800 metres and was not persevered with. When questioned regarding performance rider advised the mare felt indifferent in its action. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Connections were advised to monitor the mare over coming days and report any anomaly to the Stewards.

PRIMO VINO (J Riddell). When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no explanation. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

B Grylls (SIR GODFREY) - Issued with a warning under Rule 638(3)(f)(iii) in that she used her whip on a runner out of contention.

Race 7 CARTERS "VAN ON THE GO" 2140m

FREE SPIRIT (T Davies) - Began awkwardly and slow away. Raced three-wide without cover for the majority.

ZAPPA JAK (J Chung) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

CANBITEABIT (J Parkes) - When questioned regarding the disappointing run, J Parkes reported the gelding over-raced due to the slow early pace and was unable to quicken when the pace increased from near the 700 metres.

Race 8

CARTERS "TRADE LEADERS NOW ONLINE" 1700m

DU'BLUES (T Davies) - Came together and bumped with BELLE ADAIRE at the start with both runners becoming briefly unbalanced.

BELLE ADAIRE (L Sutherland) - Bumped at start becoming briefly unbalanced.

SEA MONARCH (M Hudson) - Lay inwards under pressure in the home straight and had to be continuously straightened.

ALBUFEIRA (J Chung) - Held up for a short distance approaching the home turn.

NOTSOMODEST (T Mitchell) - Made brief contact with the running rail near the 200 metres.
