D Bothamley advised Stewards on race morning that he would not be attending today's meeting due to illness, with rider changes made as per above summary. D Bothamley was advised he is now required to produce a medical certificate prior to riding next.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 WELCOME BACK POLYTRACK RACING MAIDEN 2200m

LILITH (R Beeharry) - Very slow to begin losing several lengths. Connections were advised a warning would be placed on the mare's barrier manners.

TRES CHIC (K Williams) - Slow to begin.

HIGH PINS (T Comignaghi) - Lay out rounding the final turn and in the straight.

Race 2 GRANDSTAND EATERY IN THE PHAR LAP MAIDEN 1200m

RELENTLESS KAYDEN (D Tait) - Slow to begin.

RUBICON REIGNS (T Moseley) - Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover throughout.

VINDERSTERN (K Asano) - Raced ungenerously when being steadied shortly after the start, then being checked when placed in restricted room to the inside of MISS FIREHAWK which received pressure from THE CHROME NUN which had SPARTAN improving to its outside near the 1100 metres. After questioning riders, evidence was provided that SPARTAN (D Montes de Oca) had been shifting inwards when not fully clear. With no head-on back straight footage available for this race due to a camera malfunction, D Montes de Oca was on this occasion given the benefit of the doubt and issued with a warning, with Stewards also taking into account there may have been some outward movement from IN AWE which was being steadied at that point of the race.

JOYBELLS (K Mudhoo) - Over raced in the middle stages.

IN AWE (Z Bholah) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

NIGHT MIST (T Comignaghi) - Commenced to give ground early in the home straight and was not persevered with. When questioned regarding performance, rider could offer no tangible excuse. Trainer A Carston advised the filly would no longer be considered as a racing proposition for his stable.

D Montes de Oca (SPARTAN) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount SPARTAN to shift inwards when not fully clear near the 1100 metres.

Race 3 SUMMIT ULTRA ON TAP MAIDEN 1600m

ECCELLENZA (K Chowdhoory) - Steadied when crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

TELLME YOU LOVEME (T Comignaghi) - Steadied when crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

GIVEALITTLE (B Murray) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

O'DUA (K Williams) - Held up rounding the final turn and early in the straight before obtaining clear running near the 250 metres.

PERIA'S LEGACY (C Campbell) - Held up passing the 600 metres until near the 350 metres.

Race 4 GRAND NATIONAL TICKETS ON SALE MAY 10 1600m

FINAL SAVINGS (M McNab) - Slow to begin.

TIFFEN (T Comignaghi) - Slow begin. When questioned regarding performance, rider advised the mare had travelled well throughout, however, when placed under pressure failed to respond. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

KUDOS DE SOTHYS (K Chowdhoory) - Lost the right front plate during the running.

Race 5 RACING AGAIN ON SATURDAY MAIDEN 1400m

A Carston (PEUT RESPIRER) - Stewards accepted the trainer's explanation for late declaration of rider on this occasion.

TAIMATE ROSE (L Callaway) - Jumped away awkwardly hampering SATELLITE.

SATELLITE (K Mudhoo) - Hampered leaving the barriers losing ground.

DAME COUNTY (K Williams) - Slow to begin.

SEGA NA LEQA (B Murray) - Slow to begin.

MATTRIC (G Jogoo) - Over raced when being restrained near the 1200 metres. Placed in restricted room having to steady when TRUMBY lay out near the 800 metres.

TRUMBY (K Kwo) - Blundered when racing in restricted room to the inside of MATTRIC near the 1200 metres. Lay outwards 800 metres.

TAIL LIGHTS (D Montes de Oca) - Lay out under pressure from the 200 metres.

Race 6 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES 1400m

KIKIMORA (K Mudhoo) - Reared in the barriers prior to the start dislodging its rider. KIKIMORA was removed from the barriers and underwent a veterinary examination being cleared to race.

DA VINCI GIRL (D Montes de Oca) - Slow to begin.

SEARCHLIGHT (M McNab) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. When questioned regarding performance, the rider advised the mare would benefit from a step up in distance. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

POWER 'N' PASSION (K Chowdhoory) - Held up entering the final straight angling outwards across heels to obtain clear running.

ELLE AYE LADY (B Murray) - Steadied when crowded to the inside of CAITLYN JAY (K Asano) which lay in passing the 300 metres. K Asano was advised to exercise greater care.

CAITLYN JAY (K Asano) - Lay inwards under pressure throughout the final straight.

HOW UNUSUAL (C Campbell) - Briefly steadied near the 250 metres.

Race 7 RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE HANDICAP 1200m

KINDRED SPIRIT (K Chowdhoory) - Jumped away awkwardly getting its head up and shifted inwards crowding MOREIRA.

MR HASS (D Montes de Oca) - Slow to begin.

SENTIENT (R Beeharry) - Slow to begin.

MOREIRA (K Mudhoo) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

AUNT CINDY (K Asano) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

SELFIE (T Comignaghi) - Held up over the final 300 metres.

FIONNUALA (K Kwo) - Improved onto the heels of HELLO MARY LOU which lay outwards near the 250 metres, with FIONNUALA having to shift inwards to obtain clear running.

HELLO MARY LOU (G Jogoo) - Lay outwards near the 250 metres.

YEAH RIGHT (C Campbell) - Crowded then struck a heel and blundered approaching the 100 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

MISS BRITTANY (M McNab) - When questioned regarding performance, the rider advised that in his opinion the filly may have come to the end of its preparation. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slow recovery rate.

L Callaway (EL ROSEAY) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount EL ROSEAY to shift inwards crowding YEAH RIGHT which struck a heel and blundered approaching the 100 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of L Callaway's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 6 May until the conclusion of racing on Saturday 13 May, 5 national riding days.
