Race 7 ITM/GIB 3YO WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP FINAL 1600

MIGHTY BRIGHT (M McNab) – Trainer S Cole advised Stewards that the gelding had pulled up fine since the race and they will be continuing with his preparation.

Race 7 ITM/GIB 3YO WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP FINAL 1600

An Appeal was heard today prior to Race 1 in relation to a charge alleging Apprentice Rider T Mitchell (DELOREAN), who was assisted by Trainer G Rogerson, struck her mount seven times prior to the 100 metres. After viewing the replays and hearing all the evidence, the Appeals Tribunal dismissed the Appeal.

RACE COMMENTS**Race 1 | GARTSHORE CONSTRUCTION MAIDEN 3YO 1200**

GIBRALTAR RISING (B Rogerson) – Over-raced in the early to middle stages when sitting outside the leader.

DAY IN LIEU (A Goindasamy) – Slow to begin then crowded shortly afterwards.

VILLON (S Spratt) - Over-raced in the early stages.

MOOD PAINTER (J Allen) – Had to be steadied when improving onto heels leaving the 1000 metres then shifted outwards.

LOVEAROADIE (M Kareem) - Steadied off heels near the 1000 metres.

B Rogerson (GIBRALTAR RISING) - B Rogerson, assisted by M Northcott, was issued with a warning for allowing her mount to shift outwards approaching the 300 metres when not fully clear of LOVEAROADIE which was hampered having to be steadied off heels. When assessing this matter Stewards took into account that VILLON contributed to the incident when shifting in simultaneously.

B Rogerson (GIBRALTAR RISING) - B Rogerson, assisted by M Northcott, was issued with a warning for allowing her mount to shift outwards near the 200 metres when not fully clear of LOVEAROADIE which was forced outwards into the line of VILLON.

S Spratt (VILLON) - Issued with a warning for allowing her mount to shift in approaching the 300 metres when not fully clear of LOVEAROADIE which was hampered having to be steadied off heels. When assessing this matter Stewards took into account that GIBRALTAR RISING contributed to the incident when shifting out simultaneously.

M Kareem (LOVEAROADIE) - M Kareem, assisted by G Richardson, was issued with a warning for the manner in which he shifted ground outwards into the line of VILLON when not fully clear near the 200 metres. When assessing this matter Stewards took into account that GIBRALTAR RISING contributed to the incident when shifting outwards.

Connections of the 2nd placed runner VILLON viewed Stewards films before electing not to proceed with a protest against LOVEAROADIE.

Race 2 | NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES 2YO 1200

TEAK (T Moodley) – Slow to begin. Lay outwards entering the final straight and continued to do so for some distance.

SKYLIT (S Spratt) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Race 3 | MILLS REEF WINERY OPEN HANDICAP 1200

MILLEFIORI (J Allen) - Slow to begin then contacted shortly after the start by DAWN PARADE, losing ground. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that in her opinion the mare failed to back up from last week's race at Ruakaka.

DAWN PARADE (V Colgan) – Began awkwardly making contact with MILLEFIORI.

DIGGER (A Lawson-Carroll) – Over-raced in the early stages. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

NEW YORK JAZZ (N Hailey) - Had to be steadied for a distance when racing keenly passing the 900 metres. Shifted across the heels of **DIGGER** to obtain clear running approaching the 100 metres.

FONTEYN (T Mitchell) – Lost the right fore plate during the running.

Connections of the 2nd placed runner **NEW YORK JAZZ** viewed Stewards films before electing not to proceed with a protest against **DIGGER**.

Race 4	FOOD 101 CATERERS TO RACING TAURANGA MAIDEN 1600
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BANKSFIELD (T Thornton) - Slow to begin. Commenced to give ground passing the 600 metres and finished a distant last. When questioned regarding the performance rider could offer no explanation.

MIDNIGHT (J Fawcett) - Slow to begin. Lay outwards early in the final straight.

FOOTLOOSE (S Spratt) – Reared as the start was effected, losing ground.

TIMBA (V Colgan) – Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after the start.

LIQUID FIRE (B Rogerson) – Jumped inwards shortly after the start crowding **TIMBA**. Over-raced in the early stages.

KEEPZ OCCURRING (K Hannan) – Began awkwardly. Raced wide in the early stages before improving forward to settle outside the leader near the 1100 metres.

FOODIE BROTHERS (T Moodley) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Briefly contacted approaching the 250 metres.

UNCLE BRUCE (L Satherley) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages when being restrained.

TEMPEST KHAN (D Cooper) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages when being restrained.

TIMELESS (N Hailey) – Raced four wide without cover from near the 900 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the filly failed to respond when placed under pressure in the final straight.

NYAH (T Mitchell) – Briefly lay out entering the final straight. Rider dropped her whip approaching the 200 metres.

NORTHERN RAIDER (K Bakker) - Shifted outwards approaching the 250 metres making brief contact with **FOODIE BROTHERS**. Rider K Bakker was shown the replay and advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

STRATHTAY (A Lawson-Carroll) - Briefly inconvenienced approaching the 250 metres.

Race 5	PUNTER OF THE YEAR NOW NOVEMBER 4TH 1400
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ANNA GRACE (S Spratt) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Over-raced in the early stages.

CORK (J Allen) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Lay outwards entering the final straight.

APACHE BOY (T Thornton) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

TANNER (K Hannan) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

TURN THE ACE (D Cooper) – Raced four wide without cover throughout. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the gelding failed to respond when placed under pressure in the final straight.

MANRICO (J Fawcett) – Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

MISTER ROQUETTE (Y Kumagai) - Lay out when placed under pressure near the 200 metres briefly inconveniencing STAND TALL.

STAND TALL (T Mitchell) – Briefly inconvenienced near the 200 metres.

Race 6

BACK TO BLACK 2100

SILK 'N' DALE (T Moodley) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

ORSOME DUDE (N Hailey) – Began awkwardly contacting TURNMEON. Shifted outwards abruptly shortly after the start having to be corrected by its rider.

TURNMEON (A Goindasamy) – Contacted by ORSOME DUDE shortly after the start shifting outwards crowding SILK 'N' DALE. Rider reported that the gelding may have choked during the running, and he would be recommending to connections the addition of a tongue tie. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities.

TE ATATU MEMPHIS (Y Kumagai) - Began awkwardly forcing DIAMOND JAK outwards onto MISTER PUCCI shortly after the start.

DIAMOND JAK (A Lawson-Carroll) - Forced outwards leaving the barriers.

MISTER PUCCI (V Colgan) - Forced outwards shortly after the start by DIAMOND JAK. Hampered approaching the 1000 metres.

SHOCKING PENNY (B Rogerson) – Raced three wide without cover until near the 1600 metres.

MILLENNIUM DAWN (T Thornton) – Raced wide from near the 1000 metres. When questioned regarding the improved performance trainer G Lord advised that the gelding had benefitted from being schooled and appreciated the puggy track conditions.

TAKEITEASY (T Mitchell) - When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the gelding failed to respond when placed under pressure.

AMARILLO SLIM (K Hannan) - Commenced to give ground passing the 700 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the gelding was unsuited to leading, and in her opinion would appreciate deeper track conditions. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a slow recovery.

T Thornton (MILLENNIUM DAWN) – Issued with a warning for permitting her mount to shift outwards when not fully clear of MISTER PUCCI which was hampered approaching the 1000 metres.

Race 7

CONTRIBUTER STANDING AT MAPPERLEY STUD 1600

MAGDALA (A Lawson-Carroll) - Slow to begin.

OUR TRISTABELLE (D Cooper) – Began awkwardly.

HOT SALSA (J Allen) – Began awkwardly contacting ABOVE THE CLOUDS shortly after the start. Raced three wide without cover until near the 900 metres.

ABOVE THE CLOUDS (S Spratt) – Contacted by HOT SALSA shortly after the start then restrained towards the rear of the field to obtain cover. Over-raced in the middle stages.

NASHA RIVA (K Hannan) – Over-raced in the early to middle stages. Eased down over the final 150 metres when out of contention. When questioned regarding the performance rider could offer no explanation.

ON THE PROWL (T Mitchell) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 8

ULTIMATE MAZDA 1600

BEAU ARCHERS ROSE (K Hannan) - Slow to begin then crowded shortly after.

IN THE LOOP (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly crowding BEAU ARCHERS ROSE shortly after the start.

YELLOW JERSEY (T Mitchell) – Commenced to buck shortly after the start and was retired from the race. Connections were advised that the gelding would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities.

MR ROC (N Hailey) - Raced wide without cover throughout. Inconvenienced over the final 100 metres.

FLY MY WEY (T Moodley) - Checked off the heels of MR ROC near the 350 metres. Inconvenienced over the final 100 metres.

KORO'S PRINCESS (J Fawcett) – Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

TIDAL RUSH (D Cooper) - Lay out when placed under pressure over the final 100 metres inconveniencing MR ROC and FLY MY WEY.

N Hailey (MR ROC) - Reminded of his obligations, in the presence of D Sweeney, to ride his mounts out fully to the end of the race when circumstances permit with Stewards being satisfied on this occasion that it had not compromised his finishing position (4th).

D Cooper (TIDAL RUSH) - D Cooper, assisted by D Sweeney, issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift out passing the 100 metres when not fully clear of MR ROC which was inconvenienced along with FLY MY WEY.

N Hailey (MR ROC) – N Hailey, assisted by D Sweeney, admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards near the 350 metres when insufficiently clear of FLY MY WEY which had to be checked off heels. An information was filed with the Adjudicative Committee and the matter was opened and adjourned until racing on Wednesday 26 July at Cambridge JC.
