SUPPLEMENTARY**Canterbury Jockey Club @ Riccarton Park – Wednesday 12 July 2023****Race 6 - DAVE FERRIMAN 50 YEARS HUNTSMAN CHCH HCP 1400m****SHARPIE** (D Montes de Oca) - Co-trainer M Pitman advised Stewards that the gelding had come through the run fine, having had blood tests taken from him which were found to be clear. They plan to continue with his current preparation.**RACE COMMENTS****Race 1****DRUMMOND & ETHERIDGE 1200m****EYE SPY** (C Campbell) – Slow to begin. When asked to comment on the performance rider advised that the filly failed to handle today's testing heavy track conditions.**ROYAL VALOUR** (K Williams) – Steadied to avoid the heels of MAHNA MAHNA passing the 1100 metres and then eventually having to shift ground outwards to avoid those heels.**RHONDA WOOD** (Y Atchamah) – Became awkwardly placed on the heels of EXPRESS COUP passing the 125 metres when both runners shifted ground.**MAHNA MAHNA** (K Kwo) – Rider reported the filly had not handled today's heavy track conditions.**MISS NICO BELLE** (K Hannan) - Lost the left hind plate during the running.**K Kwo** (MAHNA MAHNA) – Issued with a warning after allowing his mount MAHNA MAHNA to shift inwards passing the 1100 metres when not fully clear of ROYAL VALOUR which had to steady and shift ground outwards to avoid heels.**Race 2****STEPHEN HEFFERNAN PROPERTY BROKERS MAIDEN 1200m****SNORKEL** (C Campbell) – Proved difficult to load delaying the start.

BOOKMARK (K Kwo) – Fractious in the barriers.

BALTIMORE (T Jonker) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

ANAFTERNOONDELIGHT (G Jogoo) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

GOLLYMOLLY (B May) – Held up by tiring runners for a distance passing the 600 metres.

SHEJENGAR (D Montes de Oca) – Shifted ground outwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

STEVIE NIX (K Hercock) - When asked to comment on the performance rider advised that the mare had improved rounding the final bend however when placed under pressure in the home straight had failed to respond to her urgings and proved disappointing.

ZIRCON (K Hannan) – Rider was of the opinion the filly had not handled today's testing track conditions.

Race 3

EASYMADE MARMALADE LTD HANDICAP 1200m

EARS BACK (K Hercock) – Jumped away awkwardly making contact with ALBY PARK, losing ground. When asked to comment on the performance rider was of the opinion the mare was looking for more ground.

ALBY PARK (R Mudhoo) – Hampered when contacted leaving the barriers losing ground.

IHU (K Williams) – Raced three wide without cover on the pace through the early to middle stages.

Race 4

BILLY JOHN GUYTON MEMORIAL MAIDEN 1400m

CORNETTO (B May) – Jumped away awkwardly, then being restrained to obtain cover. Had to be severely restrained to avoid the heels of LOMBARDI which shifted out near the 1200 metres.

LOMBARDI (T Jonker) – Rider dropped her whip near the 300 metres.

WEE TADHG (K Kwo) – Hampered when crowded near the 250 metres, then having to shift ground outwards across the heels of LOMBARDI.

INTERMINGLE (C Campbell) – Hampered near the 250 metres.

NOVELLA (K Hannan) – When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no tangible excuse.

T Jonker (LOMBARDI) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount LOMBARDI to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of CORNETTO which had to be severely restrained to avoid that runners heels near the 1200 metres. After viewing replays and considering penalty submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of her licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing today 26 July until the conclusion of racing on Saturday 5 August, 5 national riding days.

D Montes de Oca (REINEDELARIVIERE) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he angled his mount REINEDELARIVIERE outwards when not sufficiently clear of INTERMINGLE which was hampered and forced outwards on to WEE TADHG near the 250 metres. After viewing replays and considering penalty submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing today 26 July until the conclusion of racing on Sunday 6 August, 6 national riding days.

Race 5 | **DAVE ALLAN MEMORIAL 2200m**

THISTLE (T Jonker) – Slow to begin.

CAPTAIN OUMUAMUA (K Chowdhoo) – Hampered leaving the barriers, then being restrained to obtain cover. Raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 1300 metres.

ASTRADEEL (L Douglas) – Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of CAPTAIN OUMUAMUA near the 1300 metres.

RAARDY RAAR (K Mudhoo) – Blundered passing the 800 metres losing momentum. Rider reported the gelding was not comfortable at any point in today's testing track conditions.

PICKENS (R Mudhoo) – Rider reported the mare had not been entirely comfortable with the inconsistent nature of today's track conditions.

Race 6 | **BROSNAN TRANSPORT LIMITED 2200m**

BOB MARLIE (R Jaun) – Began awkwardly.

PINHEAD (B May) – Shifted out abruptly at the start losing ground as a result. Reported by the rider to have hung badly throughout.

TAKE THE DEEL (G Jogoo) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

EAVESDROP (C Campbell) – Raced wide without cover through the early to middle stages.

DIAMOND RIVIERE (A Balloo) – Trailed the field throughout and was not persevered in the final straight, finishing in a distant last placing. When asked to comment on the performance rider advised the mare was not comfortable in today's track conditions. Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities.

VAGUE (Y Atchamah) – Rider was shown replays of his ride over the concluding stages and reminded of his obligation to ride his mounts fully to the line when circumstances permit.

HEY MICKEY (K Williams) – When asked to comment on the performance rider reported the gelding had failed to handle today's heavy track conditions.

Race 7 | **THANK YOU OAMARU AND KUROW HARNESS CLUBS 1200m**

CHOUX MACHER (B Murray) – Slow to begin and was then taken back to obtain cover from a wide draw.

ARDOUR (K Williams) – When asked to comment on the performance rider was of the opinion the mare had not been entirely comfortable in today's heavy track conditions and may be looking for more ground.

LIPA MALA (B May) – When asked to comment rider could offer no tangible explanation for the disappointing performance.

TELEKINETIC (D Montes de Oca) – Raced in restricted room racing into the first bend, being briefly steadied.

B Murray (CHOUX MACHER) – Issued with a warning after using his whip in two consecutive strides over the concluding stages.

B Murray (CHOUX MACHER) – Admitted a charge in that he used his whip 6 times prior to the 100 metres, 1 more than permitted. After viewing replays and considering penalty submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a fine of \$250.

Race 8	GLENMOA FARMS LIMITED RIVER PLATE TROPHY 1200m
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GLOBAL BEAUTY (Y Atchamah) – Began awkwardly making contact with BUSH MILLS BILLY and lost ground as a result.

BUSH MILLS BILLY (G Jogoo) – Contacted on jumping.

VICTOR ROUGE (K Williams) – Slow to begin.

ATOMIC (S Muniandy) – Slow to begin.

THE ROARING TIGER (K Hannan) – When asked to comment on the performance rider advised the gelding had not been entirely comfortable in today's track conditions.

IN DISGUISE (R Jaun) – When asked to comment on the performance of favoured runner rider could offer no tangible excuse.

Race 9	CROMBIE & PRICE OAMARU CUP (1600m)
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LOUIE LOUIE (L Douglas) – Jumped away awkwardly.

THE TUI TOILER (G Jogoo) - Reared at the start and was slow away as a result.

TARAMEA LAD (K Williams) – Slow to begin.

CHOKITO (R Jaun) – Placed in restricted room near the 1300 metres having to steady briefly.

STOP YELLING (D Montes de Oca) – Blundered passing the 1300 metres. Made contact with BURNVUE on a number of occasions rounding the bend near the 900 metres.

CHOUX IN (K Hercock) – Inconvenienced near the 1000 metres when STOP YELLING shifted outwards.

ZADANE (Y Atchamah) – Awkwardly placed on heels rounding the final turn near the 300 metres.

SEA SHEPHERD (C Campbell) – When questioned regarding the performance rider advised the gelding had travelled well and was in a challenging position on the final turn however when placed under pressure failed to respond and had been disappointing. Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities.

B May (FAME SHINES) – Admitted a charge that he weighed in 0.8kg over his weigh out weight with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a fine of \$200 under the Minor Infringement Schedule.

B May (FAME SHINES) – Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount FAME SHINES 8 times prior to the 100 metres, 3 more than permitted. After viewing replays and considering penalty submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Friday 28 July until the conclusion of racing on Friday 11 August, 6 national riding days.

Race 10

OAMARU JOCKEY CLUB SUPPORTERS 1400m

GABBY DIAZ (D Montes de Oca) – Slow to begin.

CAMPING (R Jaun) – Slow to begin.

MAKABAR (K Chowdhoo) – Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start.

ZACAT (K Williams) – Contacted and briefly unbalanced when ROSY CLARK shifted out passing the 350 metres.

B May (WHERE'S WALLY) – Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount WHERE'S WALLY 8 times prior to the 100 metres, 3 more than permitted. After viewing replays and considering penalty submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Friday 11 August until the conclusion of racing on Friday 25 August, 8 national riding days.

B May was again referred under Rule 343 to the Rider Skills Review Panel.
