N Hailey (MR ROC) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards when insufficiently clear of FLY MY WEY which was checked near the 350 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicator suspended N Hailey's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 29 July up to and including racing on Saturday 12 August, 6 national riding days.

Race 1 | **PRYDE'S EASIFEED 1550**

MISTA STITCH (L Satherley) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

RUM AND RUMOUR (J Doyle) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

<p>NYSTROM (A Goindasamy) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>CHATTAHOOCHEE (E Nicholas) – Over-raced in the early stages. Raced wide without cover throughout.</p>	
Race 3	CAMBRIDGE EQUINE HOSPITAL 1550
<p>PIZZAZZ (M McNab) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Over-raced in the early stages. Rider reported that the mare had made abnormal breathing noises during the running. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a slower than normal recovery.</p> <p>BRECKON POWER (B Grylls) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Improved onto heels approaching the 400 metres having to be steadied. Held up in the early stages of the home straight.</p> <p>LA PALMA (L Satherley) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages when working forward to lead.</p> <p>ALPHA CHARLIE (E Nicholas) – Raced in restricted room approaching the 500 metres having to be steadied. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running entering the final straight.</p> <p>AFTER PARTY (S Spratt) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p>	
Race 4	MARTIN COLLINS NEW ZEALAND MAAT 1300
<p>ELUSIVE NATION (J Allen) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>TIMING (V Colgan) – Hampered shortly after the start losing ground.</p> <p>BRAVE SPIRIT (S Weatherley) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>MS CANDEE LANE (T Thornton) – Over-raced in the middle stages.</p> <p>AVAYA (J Doyle) - Eased down in the final straight. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.</p>	
Race 5	MARTIN COLLINS NEW ZEALAND MAAT 970
<p>STAR TRAIL (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin then crowded shortly after, losing ground.</p> <p>TRU PLANET (B Grylls) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Shifted outwards approaching the 100 metres making slight contact with KA YING LUCKY.</p> <p>JOHNNIE KASTLE (S Spratt) - Improved onto heels passing the 300 metres having to be steadied then raced in restricted room passing the 150 metres.</p> <p>JUST AS SHARP (B Rogerson) – Raced greenly in the home straight.</p> <p>KA YING LUCKY (M McNab) - Contacted and unbalanced approaching the 100 metres.</p> <p>SUZIE QATTUS (E Nicholas) - Rider reported that the filly had made abnormal breathing noises throughout the run. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.</p>	
Race 6	SADDLERY WAREHOUSE 970
<p>LUXURIANT (M McNab) - Slow to begin.</p>	

MAGIC TOUCH (A Lawson-Carroll) – Raced wide throughout. When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no excuse.

MONIQUE TONNERRE (T Newman) – When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the filly had been outpaced in the early stages and had hit the line well.

Race 7 | **MARTIN COLLINS NEW ZEALAND MAAT 2000**

SO THE FOX (J Doyle) – Began awkwardly then crowded shortly afterwards, losing ground. Inclined to lay in throughout the home straight.

HAMMER TIME (J Allen) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced four wide until near the 1500 metres before working forward to sit outside the leader. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that after beginning slowly the gelding had to do more work than expected to obtain a position near the lead and had failed to respond when placed under pressure. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

YOU KNOW (V Colgan) – Over-raced in the early stages.

STANIMA MAN (S Spratt) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

BIEDERMEIER (L Satherley) – Held up rounding the final bend.

KAWATIRI (M McNab) - Unable to obtain clear running early in the home straight. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that he had been disappointed in the filly's performance, however, could offer no excuse.

MYLETT (T Thornton) - Rider reported that the gelding had felt indifferent in its action over the concluding stages. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 8 | **WAIKATO THOROUGHBRED RACING MERGER 1 AUGUST 2000**

WAIHI WARRIOR (S Spratt) - Became fractious in its barrier dislodging the rider and escaping riderless, before being recaptured. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was cleared fit to start. Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 400 metres to the inside of JIMMY DEAN. M McNab was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances. When assessing the incident video footage proved inconclusive.

EVE'S SONG (E Nicholas) – Began awkwardly.

MOTUMAN (V Jalalkuncha) – Crowded shortly after the start. Steadied when placed in restricted room to the outside of WAIHI WARRIOR which shifted outwards passing the 500 metres.

JIMMY DEAN (M McNab) – Over-raced in the middle stages.

CANNY MAN (A Lawson-Carroll) – Over-raced in the middle stages.

S Spratt (WAIHI WARRIOR) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift out when not sufficiently clear of MOTUMAN passing the 500 metres.
