RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 | **JENNY SMITH MEMORIAL MAIDEN 1550**

DEEP PURPLE (S McKay) – Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover throughout. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. Following a veterinary examination including an endoscopic examination DEEP PURPLE was confirmed to have bled. DEEP PURPLE shall not be ridden in exercise for a period of two months or start in any race or trial for a period of three months, and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a Veterinarian.

STAR IN THE SKY (W Pinn) - Slow to begin.

TOMMY GUN (L Satherley) – Leapt in the air as the start was initiated losing ground. Over-raced in the middle stages.

MERSEY BEAT (C Barnes) - Began awkwardly.

YOU KNOW (J Fawcett) – Raced in restricted room shortly after the start when runners either side shifted ground.

BUBBLE TROUBLE (A Goindasamy) – Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained.

NISHANE (W Kennedy) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

COMPOSURE (T Thornton) – Lay in under pressure in the final straight.

ANNETARZ (T Newman) - Commenced to hang outwards in the home straight proving difficult to ride out with the mare reluctant to make a run approaching the 100 metres.

Race 2 | **SADDLERY WAREHOUSE MAIDEN 1550**

XRATED (W Kennedy) – Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover from near the 1000 metres. When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no excuse.

PULCHRA ROSA (A Goindasamy) – Restrained to the rear of the field shortly after the start.

BRONTES GOLD (T Mitchell) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages before easing out passing the 1000 metres to race three wide without cover.

KARAOKE (K Asano) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

JUSTICE (L Satherley) - Lay out rounding the final bend and continued to lay out under pressure in the straight.

PRIMO VINO (M McNab) - Held up entering the final straight until approaching the 150 metres.

LEBOWSKI (J Fawcett) – When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 3 | **OAKVUE LODGE/SERENITY PARK 1550**

NOBLE MAN (W Pinn) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after arriving late on course due to transport difficulties and was cleared to start.

DEEP BEAUTY (R Elliot) - Slow to begin.

URBAN MYTH (V Colgan) – Began awkwardly. Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Improved onto heels approaching the 1200 metres before being heavily restrained by its rider having to be eased three wide near the 1000 metres. Connections were advised a warning would be placed against the gelding’s racing manners.

LA DOLCE VITA (M McNab) – Began slowly being restrained to a rear position shortly after the start. Held up for clear running room entering the final straight until passing the 150 metres.

MISS INTERPET (T Newman) – Raced three wide without cover.

TOUCH THE CLOUDS (C Lindsay) – Forced to race wide without cover when URBAN MYTH shifted ground passing the 1000 metres.

S Logan (EVE’S SONG) - Issued with a warning after presenting EVE’S SONG to race with a nasal strip which was not declared.

Race 4 | **WAIPA EARTHWORKS MAIDEN 1300**

SHE WROTE MORE (M Sanson) - Began awkwardly. Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages. Steadied near the 1100 metres when REDSHEIS shifted in. W Kennedy (REDSHEIS) was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

RADIO GA GA (J Nishizuka) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

NOTABADPONY (K Hannan) - Began awkwardly making contact with CINNAMON GIRL shortly after the start. Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the home straight.

CINNAMON GIRL (C Barnes) - Began awkwardly making contact with NOTABADPONY shortly after the start.

VILLON (B Rogerson) - Began awkwardly making contact with TIMING shortly after the start. Raced keenly when leading in the early and middle stages.

TIMING (S Weatherley) - Began awkwardly making contact with VILLON shortly after the start.

REDSHEIS (W Kennedy) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the home straight.

Race 5 | **ELLICE TANNER HART MAIDEN 1300**

BREEZYLEXUS (C Barnes) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up for a majority of the home straight and was not fully tested over the concluding stages.

IMAGERY (T Newman) - Restrained at the start from its wide barrier. When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no excuse. Trainer J Dalley advised Stewards that the gelding's racing future would be reassessed over the coming days.

THE ODYSSEY (M McNab) – Crowded at the start. Raced wide without cover throughout. Raced greenly in the home straight.

MS CANDEE LANE (T Thornton) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

CHIVALROUS (B Grylls) - Raced keenly through the middle stages. Lay in under pressure in the straight. Hampered over the concluding stages when BREEZYLEXUS was shifting outwards.

SON OF SATONO (W Pinn) – Had to be momentarily steadied approaching the 100 metres when THE ODYSSEY was racing greenly making slight contact.

CARRINGTON (K Asano) - Lay in over the concluding stages.

Race 6 | **WAIKATO TRACTORS 1300**

PISCO SOUR (W Kennedy) – Began awkwardly. Raced three wide without cover from near the 900 metres.

UP 'N' GONE (C Grylls) - Restrained to the rear of the field at the start from a wide barrier.

WHISKEY NEAT (M McNab) – Over-raced in the early stages when being restrained and continued to over-race in the middle stages.

AOIDE (T Mitchell) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages when being restrained. Rider reported that the mare was inclined to hang out throughout the race proving a difficult ride. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed against the mare's racing manners.

Race 7 | **CARTER CONTRACTING MAIDEN 970**

JADE (W Kennedy) - Slow to begin. Briefly held up entering the home straight until near the 100 metres.

BUENOS DIAS (S Weatherley) - Began awkwardly. Raced ungenerously in the middle stages. Briefly held up for clear running entering the final straight until near the 200 metres.

DISCOVERY BAY (T Thornton) – Jumped inwards at the start contacting ALMACETA. Raced wide throughout.

ALMACETA (C Grylls) – Raced in restricted room shortly after the start when DISCOVERY BAY shifted in then over-raced when being restrained to the rear of the field. Made the turn leaving the back straight awkwardly.

ORGULLO (M McNab) - Made the home turn awkwardly.

HEADING TO NOOSA (K Asano) - Lay in under pressure in the final straight.

Race 8 | **PAYNTERS CATERING 970**

CHAMPAGNE LOLA (T Newman) – Slow to begin.

MAGIC TOUCH (T Mitchell) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

HASSTOBEFAST (M McNab) - Slow to begin.

THATZ DAISY (M Hudson) – Raced wide throughout.

FELIX FAURE (B Grylls) - Raced wide throughout.

ALICE TINKER (T Thornton) - Improved onto heels having to be steadied passing the 800 metres.

MIDNIGHT SPECIAL (S Spratt) - Returned to the enclosure with blood present in its mouth. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the mare to have a small laceration to its tongue.

Race 9

COOKIES FOOD TRUCK MAIDEN 970

ANNIE (V Colgan) - Began awkwardly then restrained to the rear of the field.

ICE COLD GOLD (R Elliot) - Began awkwardly. Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Made the final turn awkwardly when improving.

AVAYA (K Asano) – Began awkwardly contacting APACHE LAD shortly after the start.

APACHE LAD (V Jalalkuncha) – Contacted at the start.

POKURU SHOW (W Kennedy) – Restrained at the start from its wide barrier.

YOUNG DIVA (M Sanson) – Over-raced in the early stages when being restrained.

KA YING LUCKY (M McNab) - Held up entering the final straight.

Race 10

CAMBRIDGE EQUINE HOSPITAL 2000

ROESLARE (B Grylls) – Leapt in the air as the start was initiated, losing ground.

MUSE (S Spratt) – Crowded at the start. Briefly steadied over the concluding stages when racing in restricted room between JOYFUL WINKLE and TAVIDORA.

OUTRIVAL (M McNab) - Knuckled shortly after the start losing ground.

CARAVELLA (J Kamaruddin) – Restrained at the start from its wide barrier.

SOCIAL DISTANCE (S Weatherley) – Over-raced when being restrained to a rear position in the early stages.

JOYFUL WINKLE (J Fawcett) - Over-raced in the early stages then raced wide without cover throughout.

POW TONG (C Grylls) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

SHADOW BOXER (A Goindasamy) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running throughout the home straight.

TAVIDORA (R Elliot) – Lay out under pressure over the concluding stages.
