C Lammas contacted Stewards on the morning of the races advising he was unwell and would not be attending today's meeting. C Lammas was advised that he is required to provide a medical clearance to Stewards prior to riding next.

RACE COMMENTS	
Race 1	ULTIMATE MAZDA 2100
<p>PYTHAGORAS (B Lammas) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Commenced to give ground passing the 1000 metres and became tailed off. When questioned, rider could offer no explanation. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the gelding to be 3/5 lame in the right foreleg. Connections were advised a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing or trialling next.</p> <p>ENDEAN AFFAIR (L Douglas) – Began awkwardly making contact with OXYGEN. When questioned regarding the performance the rider reported that the mare never travelled during the running and failed to respond when placed under pressure.</p> <p>OXYGEN (S Karnicnik) - Began awkwardly making contact with ENDEAN AFFAIR then restrained to the rear of the field from its wide barrier. Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>TAHUROA HEIGHT (M Roustoby) - Began awkwardly.</p> <p>TAKEITEASY (P Matthews) - Raced wide in the early stages.</p> <p>ZEDMAN (N Downs) – Raced wide in the early stages.</p>	
Race 2	MOUNT NEW WORLD MAIDEN 1600
<p>FAY KHAN IT (M Roustoby) - Reared as the start was effected, losing ground. Lay out when placed under pressure near the 250 metres.</p> <p>TYNESIDER (L Douglas) - Reared as the start was effected, losing ground. Over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>RIKKI RICARDO (N Downs) – Began awkwardly making contact with TEMPEST KHAN shortly after the start.</p> <p>TEMPEST KHAN (D Parker) - Began awkwardly making contact with RIKKI RICARDO shortly after the start.</p> <p>AULD JOCK (P Matthews) - Began awkwardly.</p> <p>THE EASY BATCHELOR (M Cropp) - Eased down near the 350 metres when racing at the rear of the field and was retired from the race. When questioned, rider reported that the gelding hung outwards throughout. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities.</p> <p>CADA CAMINO (S Karnicnik) - Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
Race 3	GARTSHORE CONSTRUCTION MAIDEN 3YO 1600
<p>NORTHERN RAIDER (T Moodley) - Began awkwardly dislodging its rider shortly after the start. T Moodley was attended to by St John Ambulance personnel and found to be uninjured. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed against the gelding's barrier manners.</p> <p>POSITIVE POWER (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly then contacted by the riderless NORTHERN RAIDER shortly after the start. Over-raced through the early and middle stages.</p> <p>MUSCOVADO (J Kamaruddin) – Jumped inwards at the start contacting THE IBERIAN. Raced wide without cover throughout. Shifted out and away from THE IBERIAN approaching the 300 metres.</p> <p>OCEAN ROAD (M Hashizume) – Inconvenienced by the riderless horse near the 450 metres having to be steadied.</p>	

THE IBERIAN (W Kennedy) – Contacted at the start. When questioned regarding the performance rider reported that the filly failed to handle today’s heavy track conditions.

B Rogerson (ROCEM) - Reminded of her obligations when using her whip on a runner that is out of contention.

T Moodley (NORTHERN RAIDER) - Issued with a warning after failing to claim his full allowance. Stewards interviewed T Moodley in the presence of N Harris and D Mansour and reminded him of his obligations in future regarding his weight variances.

R Elliot (HUTSON) - Failed to make the declared weight on HUTSON with the Adjudicator imposing a fine of \$150 under the Minor Infringement Schedule. R Elliot was replaced by S Spratt.

Race 4 | **STRINGER & CO REALTY MAIDEN 1400**

LADY KHAN (N Hailey) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

CHOCTAW SPIRIT (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced wide throughout.

FOOTLOOSE (T Moodley) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced keenly in the early stages. Apprentice rider T Moodley, assisted by N Harris and D Mansour, was shown the replays of his ride in the early stages for educational purposes.

RAMIREZ (V Colgan) - Shifted inwards shortly after the start when not fully clear of FOOTLOOSE which shifted in and away resulting in CHOCTAW SPIRIT having to be steadied when placed in restricted room near the 1300 metres. Rider V Colgan was advised he must exercise greater care when shifting ground.

TAWI (T Thornton) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Race 5 | **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES MAIDEN 1300**

CHARLISE (H McNeill) - Slow to begin. Had to be steadied off heels approaching the 1000 metres when racing keenly.

SHOWME DA MOOLAH (S Spratt) – Jumped outwards at the start.

CHUCKLE’S DAUGHTER (B Grylls) - Jumped inwards at the start. Not persevered with over the final 200 metres when out of contention. When questioned regarding the performance rider reported that the filly had resented the kickback and failed to handle today’s heavy track conditions. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities.

KHUTULUN KHAN (J Kamaruddin) – Raced in restricted room shortly after the start when runners either side shifted ground.

MY EXPLOSIVE (T Newman) – Over-raced in the early stages. Raced wide without cover throughout.

LADY GREY (B Rogerson) – Over-raced in the early stages.

Race 6 | **RENTLINK PROPERTY MANAGEMENT 1200**

LOVE AFFIRMATIONS (T Moodley) - Slow to begin.

FLIGHT PLAN (J Fawcett) – Slow to begin.

SHE’S A SHOWOFF (R Elliot) – Stood flat footed when the gates opened losing ground.

PUZZLE SOLVED (J Kamaruddin) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Steadied off heels passing the 1000 metres when FLIGHT PLAN shifted outwards when not fully clear, also inconveniencing CLASSICO. Rider J Fawcett was advised that she must exercise greater care when shifting ground.

CLASSICO (W Kennedy) – Contacted by FARRENC shortly after the start. Over-raced through the early and middle stages. Inconvenienced by FLIGHT PLAN passing the 1000 metres. Improved onto heels having to be steadied passing the 900 metres when runners to the inside shifted ground outwards when not fully clear.

FARRENC (J Allen) - Began awkwardly contacting CLASSICO. Shifted across heels approaching the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

DAPPER LAD (D Cooper) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

STELLA ECLIPSE (L Satherley) – Over-raced near the 1000 metres having to be steadied. Inconvenienced shortly after when runners to its inside had shifted ground outwards.

SHOOTIN TO SAKS (N Hailey) - Had to be steadied off the heels of CAITLYNS WISH which shifted inwards when not fully clear near the 1000 metres. Rider M Sanson assisted by N Harris was advised that she must exercise greater care when shifting ground.

OUR WONDERLAND (B Rogerson) – Inconvenienced passing the 1000 metres when runners to the inside shifted ground outwards.

WHOSHE’S GIRL (V Jalalkuncha) - Commenced to weaken passing the 600 metres. Finished a distant last. When questioned, the rider could offer no explanation.

D Cooper (DAPPER LAD) - Apprentice rider D Cooper was shown the replays and assisted by N Harris and D Mansour. Issued with a warning for using his whip on a runner that is out of contention.

Race 7	SUPER LIQUOR GREERTON MAIDEN 2100
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IN A PICKLE (T Newman) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after galloping riderless for a full circuit of the track and was late scratched at 4.05 pm. T Newman was uninjured.

SHADEZ (W Kennedy) – Began awkwardly. Lay out when placed under pressure passing the 100 metres having to be corrected by its rider.

CRYSTAL FALLS (C Barnes) – Began awkwardly then shifted outwards. Raced keenly in the early stages. Lay out when placed under pressure over the concluding stages.

ABU DHABI (H McNeill) – Slow to begin.

JACK WESTEND (L Douglas) – Raced in restricted room shortly after the start when CRYSTAL FALLS shifted outwards.

WHOSHE’S BOY (V Jalalkuncha) - Commenced to give ground from near the 800 metres. Finished a distant last. When questioned, the rider could offer no explanation. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities. Connections were advised that the gelding would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next due to being uncompetitive.

DEE JAY DEE (R Elliot) - When questioned regarding the performance rider reported that the gelding failed to respond when placed under pressure in the final straight.
