Race 7 NUTRITECH 1400

CORBATIN (J Fawcett) – Trainer Mr. J Collett advised Stewards, the gelding underwent a veterinary examination on Tuesday 23 May, which included a cardiograph and an endoscopic examination, as well as blood tests, which were taken on Wednesday 24 May, with all results showing no abnormalities. J Collett further advised it is his intention to carry on with CORBATIN'S current preparation and may look to nominate the gelding for the Cambridge JC trials on Tuesday 6 June.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1

ELLERSLIE EVENT CENTRE 1100

FOLLOW YOUR DREAMS (K Hannan) - Slow to begin.

JOHNY JOHNY (J Allen) - Laid out when placed under pressure in the home straight.

Race 2

PUKEKAWA PONY CLUB 1200

ALCHEMIA (M McNab) - Began awkwardly contacting the barrier, losing ground. Laid in approaching the 250 metres.

DARCI'S QUEEN (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin then crowded shortly after, losing ground.

OUR TRISTABELLE (W Kennedy) – Shifted out shortly after the start.

MANRICO (A Lawson-Carroll) - Raced three wide without cover from near the 900 metres.

GUNNAR (T Moodley) – Raced three wide without cover until near the 900 metres before improving forward to sit outside the leader.

TURN THE ACE (E Nicholas) – When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding failed to handle today's heavy track conditions.

Race 3

BARFOOT & THOMPSON AUCKLAND FUTURITY STAKES 1400 (Listed Race)

PARAGON (W Kennedy) - Required farrier attention at the start and as a result this race ran approximately 5 minutes late. Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after losing ground. Made the home turn awkwardly.

FULL TILT (M McNab) - Jumped inwards shortly after the start. Eased down approaching the 250 metres. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the filly failed to handle today's heavy track conditions. Trainer A Forsman will look at spelling the filly after today's run.

EGYPTIAN QUEEN (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin.

ONEIRA (T Newman) - Raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages.

SALTCOATS (K Asano) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Lost the near fore plate during the running.

ORGULLO (S Spratt) – Laid out in the home straight.

Race 4

MOUNT SHOP 1400

FOODIE BROTHERS (D Cooper) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

GOOD DAY (M Hashizume) – Began awkwardly.

MISCHIEF MANAGED (K Hannan) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider reported that the filly resented the kickback on today's surface.

DEVASTATE (M McNab) – When questioned regarding the performance the rider reported that the gelding felt flat today second up, and failed to handle today's heavy track conditions.

Race 5

DUNSTAN HORSE FEEDS 1400

SONOFABUTCHER (K Hannan) - Slow to begin.

SUMMER WARRIOR (C Lindsay) - Slow to begin.

RUBELLITE (M Hashizume) - Began awkwardly.

TEQUILA SPIRIT (T Mitchell) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

VISTOWN (J Fawcett) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

DIGGER (D Prastiyou) - Shifted in approaching the 1300 metres placing AQUA MAN in restricted room forcing that runner inwards onto DASHWOOD which had to be steadied. Rider D Prastiyou was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

GREASE LIGHTNING (S Spratt) - Shifted out approaching the 1300 metres placing DASHWOOD in restricted racing room which had to be steadied. Rider S Spratt was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground. Shifted out approaching the 200 metres placing DASHWOOD in restricted racing room.

DASHWOOD (N Hailey) - Had to be steadied approaching the 1300 metres when crowded for room from both sides. Had to be steadied approaching the 200 metres when GREASE LIGHTNING laid out.

AQUA MAN (A Lawson-Carroll) - Laid out abruptly approaching the 200 metres when placed under pressure. Rider dropped his whip passing the 100 metres.

Race 6 JRA TROPHY 1500

GEE CEE (S Spratt) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding failed to handle today's heavy track conditions.

NO LOITERING (J Nishizuka) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

HELENA BABY (K Hannan) – Over-raced in the early stages.

CRYSTALLIZE (A Lawson-Carroll) – Laid out over the concluding stages.

Race 7 NZB AIRFREIGHT 1600

MAGDALA (E Nicholas) - Slow to begin then raced in restricted room shortly afterwards.

CLEESE (K Hannan) - Began awkwardly crowding MAGDALA shortly after the start then raced ungenerously in the early stages.

TIMBERLAKE (D Cooper) – Jumped outwards at the start crowding MAGDALA.

ROCABURY (T Thornton) –Proved difficult to settle in the early and middle stages. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

MOLLYS GAME (T Mitchell) – Had to be steadied approaching the 100 metres when runners either side shifted ground.

BLUE MOON (M Hashizume) - Laid in over the concluding stages making brief contact with ROYAL ROC.

ROYAL ROC (W Kennedy) - Laid out over the concluding stages making brief contact with BLUE MOON. Rider reported that the mare felt sore in its front legs on pulling up. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the mare to be 4/5 lame in the near fore front. Trainer S Marsh was advised the mare would need a veterinary clearance before resuming.

Race 8 NZB NATIONAL WEANLING BROODMARE SALE 16 JUNE 2100

CHASE 'N' GOLD (T Mitchell) - Slow to begin then over-raced in the middle stages.

SILK 'N' DALE (T Moodley) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

KHAN HUNTER (M Sanson) – Began awkwardly contacting TE ATATU MEMPHIS shortly after the start.

RENEGADE FIGHTER (V Jalalkuncha) – Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after, losing ground.

BURCHA (M Hashizume) - Made the home turn awkwardly briefly contacting QUEEN SARABI.

QUEEN SARABI (K Asano) - Made the home turn awkwardly briefly contacting BURCHA.

THE SPRINKLER (A Lawson-Carroll) – Laid out in the home straight.
