**RACE COMMENTS** 

Race 1 CAMBRIDGE EQUINE HOSPITAL MAIDEN 1550

THE ODYSSEY (M McNab) - Slow to begin. Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

**PRIMO VINO** (O Bosson) – Slow to begin. When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no explanation. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

MISTER PUCCI (B Grylls) - Steadied off heels when racing keenly passing the 1300 metres.

UHTRED (K Hercock) - Briefly inconvenienced near the 1100 metres when MYLETT shifted out.

KAWATIRI (K Asano) - Raced wide throughout.

**INFER** (R Elliot) - Held up for clear running near the 400 metres. Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

## Race 2 SADDLERY WAREHOUSE 1550

**PRINCESS DISCREET** (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly losing ground. When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no explanation. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

**INVINCIBEEL** (O Bosson) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**DEEP BEAUTY** (T Mitchell) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Apprentice rider T Mitchell, assisted by riding mentor N Harris, was questioned regarding her tactics adopted from the 600 metres to the 400 metres. T Mitchell explained that her riding instructions were to be in a forward position but after beginning awkwardly she had settled further back than intended. Approaching the 400 metres, T Mitchell elected to save ground and make an inside run rather than going wide and being forced over more ground. Having reviewed the replays and considered T Mitchell's evidence, Stewards accepted that her actions were reasonable and permissible in the circumstances. The gelding underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

**SUPER LOVE DRAGON** (A Goindasamy) – Raced keenly in the early stages when leading.

**OPAEA JOE** (K Hannan) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

WAIHI WARRIOR (S Spratt) – Held up behind a weakening runner rounding the final bend.

**CHARLIE CHUCKLE** (R Elliot) - Lost the near fore plate during the running.

**T Mitchell** (DEEP BEAUTY) - Admitted a charge in that she failed to take all reasonable and permissible measures to obtain the best possible placing over the final 150 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of T Mitchell's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 3 June up to and including racing on Saturday 17 June, 11 national riding days.

## Race 3 CAMBRIDGE GRAINS MAIDEN 1300

TE AROHA BOY (S Spratt) - Slow to begin.

JAMAICA FAREWELL (T Newman) - Slow to begin.

**RIGHTLY SO** (J Kamaruddin) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Lay out when placed under pressure over the concluding stages.

**CINNAMON GIRL** (C Barnes) - Steadied off heels when placed in restricted room approaching the 800 metres then commenced to over-race for a distance. Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages when runners on either side shifted ground.

**AEQUUS** (C Grylls) - Lay in when placed under pressure over the concluding stages.

**POUVOIR** (M Sanson) - Rider dropped her whip near the 700 metres.

#### Race 4 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES MAIDEN RACE 1300

**ANNIE** (V Colgan) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

VARUNI (C Grylls) - Slow to begin.

**ARROWETTE** (W Kennedy) - Knuckled leaving the barriers losing ground.

GINTYS STAR (A Lawson-Carroll) - Contacted leaving the barriers.

**TEMPSFORD** (R Elliot) – Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages after jumping from an outside barrier.

**DIAMOND ALLEY** (M McNab) – Held up for clear running early in the final straight.

**TRU PLANET** (S Weatherley) – Lay out when placed under pressure over the concluding stages.

## Race 5 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1300

OH NO NO NO (K Asano) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**HAYATE** (J Kamaruddin) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**SYMPHONY OF LOVE** (W Kennedy) – Slow to begin. Improved onto heels rounding the final bend having to be steadied.

**ALICE TINKER** (T Thornton) - Over-raced in the early stages.

KELLY KEEPER (C Barnes) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

**PENNY ROYAL** (K Hercock) – Steadied off the heels of AFTER PARTY approaching the 600 metres. Rider B Grylls was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances. Hampered by a weakening runner rounding the final bend.

BRANCIFORTI (S Spratt) - Held up for clear running over the final 100 metres.

# Race 6 WAIPA EARTHWORKS 970

FLAT TRACK BULLY (C Barnes) - Reared as the start was initiated losing ground.

**MERLOTTI** (O Bosson) – Skied its head in the early stages. Steadied off the heels of SHAMPAGE DANCER which was laying out approaching the 150 metres.

**BERBIZIER** (W Kennedy) - Raced wide throughout.

**SHAMPAGNE DANCER** (T Thornton) - Lay out when placed under pressure near the 150 metres inconveniencing MERLOTTI which had to be steadied off heels.

**HAPPY EGO** (M Sanson) - Steadied away from the heels of MERLOTTI approaching the 150 metres.

**LUXURIANT** (C Grylls) – Returned to the birdcage with blood present in one nostril. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the mare to have a laceration to its left nostril.

**WITH YOU** (K Asano) - When questioned regarding the improved performance, trainer M Wallace advised that the mare had previously won a trial on the synthetic track and the addition of side winkers had been beneficial.

#### Race 7 PRYDE'S EASIFEED MAIDEN 970

**LEX'S ONE** (O Bosson) - Bounded as the start was initiated then hampered shortly after, losing ground. Over-raced in the early stages having to be steadied off heels then made the bend awkwardly near the 700 metres hampering POKURU SHOW. Lay in under pressure over the concluding stages.

HOBSON STREET (M Sanson) - Jumped inwards leaving the barriers hampering LEX'S ONE.

POUR SUM MOUR (D Cooper) - Bounded as the start was initiated then ducked inwards shortly after the start.

FAIRYTALE TYME (L Satherley) – Raced greenly in the early stages when racing to the inside of LEX'S ONE.

**POKURU SHOW** (W Kennedy) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Hampered near the 700 metres. Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages when LEX'S ONE lay in.

## Race 8 MIKE ALTON MOBILE ENGINEERING MAIDEN 2000

**STAR IN THE SKY** (W Kennedy) - Fractious in its barrier. Began awkwardly losing ground. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed against the filly's barrier manners.

**XRATED** (V Colgan) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained.

**SHADOW BOXER** (A Goindasamy) - Began awkwardly.

**KARAOKE** (L Satherley) - Raced wide in the early stages before being allowed to improve forward to lead near the 1300 metres.

**POW TONG** (C Grylls) - Raced keenly in the middle stages. Had to be steadied off heels approaching the 600 metres. Held up for clear running until passing the 200 metres.

## Race 9 MAGNUM INDUSTRIES MAIDEN 2000

**DEE JAY DEE** (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly. Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

**TEQUILA** (M McNab) - Began awkwardly.

**EVIDENTLY** (S Weatherley) – Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages after jumping from an outside barrier.

**THATSAWRAP** (B Rogerson) – Raced keenly in the early stages when being steadied.

GO FIONA (K Hercock) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**TOMMY GUN** (L Satherley) - Contacted by EVIDENTLY briefly becoming unbalanced passing the 500 metres. S Weatherley was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

**JUSTICE** (T Thornton) – Lay out near the 400 metres despite the efforts of its rider.
