Race 9 RYDGES WELLINGTON MAIDEN 1600m

TOP OF THE LINE (J Parkes) – Trainer Mr. P Didham advised Stewards, TOP OF THE LINE, has now been retired from racing, due to a grade 4 wind issue.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 REILLY JOINERY/SPRAY SPECIALISTS LTD MAIDEN 1400m

VERY OPTIMISTIC (A Bohorun) - When refusing to load became fractious behind the barriers, rearing over backwards, underwent a veterinary examination and was declared a late scratching at 12.19pm for refusing to load. Connections were advised the filly must barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next. Trainer A Sharrock advised

Stewards the filly's racing future would be considered. On return to the tie-ups received veterinary treatment for a superficial wound on the left hind fetlock.

CALL ME SASSY (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that in her opinion the mare may not have been suited to the synthetic track conditions.

ZAC FLASH (J Parkes) - Slow to begin.

MRS WEBB (K Hercock) - Slow to begin.

GUM BASHER (M Hudson) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout. Lay inwards under pressure through the early stages of the run home.

QUICK STORY (T Taiaroa) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 2 HENRY'S PLUMBING LTD 1400m

DOUBTFUL SOUND (L Sutherland) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

MADRID (T Mitchell) - Commenced to over-race, ducking in abruptly near the 1200 metres having to be corrected by its rider. Made the bend awkwardly when laying outwards near the 800 metres. When questioned into the performance rider could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

HERE COMES TROUBLE (T Taiaroa) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

MOONLIGHT HUSTLER (K Hercock) - Held up early in the final straight having to shift outwards to obtain clear running.

TUI ROCKS (K Asano) - Denied a run near the 250 metres when MOONLIGHT HUSTLER shifted out to obtain clear running and was then in restricted room for the remainder. When questioned as to why he did not angle his mount outwards to obtain clear running earlier, K Asano advised he was established inside the hind quarters of HERE COMES TROUBLE and was of the opinion his best option was to wait for a run which did not eventuate.

Race 3 WENHAM GRAIN & SEED MAIDEN 1200m

PACE ATTACK (K Asano) - Late scratching on veterinary advice at 11.23am, after sustaining an injury en route to the course.

SYMPHONY (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin.

MY MAN'S BACK (J Parkes) - Slow to begin.

DAWN ESTELLE (K Hercock) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

LINCOLN VALLEY (J Riddell) - Over-raced, getting its head up on a number of occasions through the early and middle stages. Held up through the early stages of the final straight and when in clear racing room, finished the race off only fairly.

Race 4 TOMO'S ALUMINIUM/PROPERTY BROKERS FEILDING MAIDEN 1000m

BAILEYS ON ROCKS (T Mitchell) - Began awkwardly, shifting outwards hampering LE VOLT. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

LE VOLT (J Parkes) - Slow to begin and was then hampered, losing ground as a result. Rider reported the gelding had raced greenly throughout the running.

RUBY SEEKER (K Asano) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced wide without cover throughout.

AMEND (K Hercock) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

PLATINUM FURY (L Sutherland) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

Race 5 CARTERS 1000m

JUDGE KELLIE (K Hercock) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Held up rounding the final bend.

THATZ DAISY (M Hudson) - Began awkwardly and was then crowded shortly after the start when runners either side shifted ground, and as a result lost ground.

BEEBEEP (T Mitchell) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

GRACIE LEE (L Sutherland) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

MISS SWEET PEE (Mahipal Singh) - Made the bend awkwardly near the 800 metres, running wider on the track.

Race 6 POWER FARMING MANAWATU MAIDEN 2140m

SUPERPOMPIDIOUS (C Grylls) - Slow to begin.

TELLEMALIE (M Hudson) - Shifted outwards shortly after the start crowding BOCAGE.

BOCAGE (K Hercock) - Contacted then crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Held up rounding the final bend and early in the home straight.

STORMCAST (J Riddell) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

CANBITEABIT (J Parkes) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

SWEET TABOO (L Sutherland) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

AFTERALLTHISTIME (T Taiaroa) - Lay inwards under pressure throughout the final straight.

Race 7 HYGAIN TRACKTORQUE 2140m

MAZZINI (T Davies) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up throughout the home straight, with the mare going to the line not fully tested.

JESKO (J Parkes) - Began awkwardly. Raced three-wide without cover through the early stages.

JUSTASKPERCEY (L Sutherland) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

PONTARDAWE (T Taiaroa) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start. When over-racing lay outwards rounding the bend near the 1900 metres becoming awkwardly placed on heels, having to be restrained and as a result got its head up. When questioned regarding performance rider advised the gelding had over-raced

throughout the running, which had been detrimental to PONTARDAWE'S performance. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 8 TUI BACKING A WINNER SINCE 1889 MAIDEN 1700m

OCEAN CRUIZER (Mahipal Singh) - Began awkwardly briefly unbalancing its rider, losing ground. Shifted inwards under pressure throughout the final straight.

NO TEARS (T Davies) - Slow to begin.

TAVIVIKI (T Taiaroa) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

SPARTA (K Hercock) - Slow to begin.

FOURTY EIGHT (K Asano) - Raced three-wide without cover through the early stages.

SPINAYARN (L Sutherland) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

TAHI TAMA (J Parkes) - Raced three-wide without cover from the 1200 metres.

SMOKIN MO (J Chung) - Held up early in the final straight having to shift inwards to obtain clear running. Placed in restricted room having to be steadied passing the 150 metres when OCEAN CRUIZER shifted inwards when not fully clear. After questioning riders, Mahipal Singh was shown footage of his ride in the presence of the Apprentice Mentor and issued with a warning.

Mahipal Singh (OCEAN CRUIZER) - Issued with a warning after allowing his mount to shift inwards when not fully clear of SMOKIN MO which was placed in restricted room for a distance passing the 150 metres.

Mahipal Singh (OCEAN CRUIZER) - Shown footage with regards to his whip use in the home straight.
