RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 ONLOC LOCATIONS 2YO MAIDEN 1200

TEQUILA SUNSET (A Goindasamy) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

BELLUTTA (A Lawson-Carroll) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

SALTNESSE (H McNeill) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

QUIRKY HABITS (M Hashizume) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 250 metres. Lay out over the concluding stages.

ANTRIM COAST (T Newman) - Lay in when placed under pressure in the early part of the final straight. Forced outwards passing the 300 metres.

GELDOF (W Kennedy) - Shifted out passing the 300 metres forcing ANTRIM COAST over extra ground.

Following the running of this race connections of the 3rd placed horse ANTRIM COAST lodged a protest alleging interference in the final straight by the 1st placed horse GELDOF. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee dismissed the protest with placings standing 1st GELDOF, 2nd QUIRKY HABITS, 3rd ANTRIM COAST, 4th, RIDE SALLY RIDE.

Race 2 GREAT SOUTHERN TELEVISION 3YO SWP 1200

MIGHTY BRIGHT (R Elliot) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

GET LIT (K Asano) - Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after. Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

POUR THE WINE (W Kennedy) – Restrained at the start from its wide barrier. Momentarily held up early in the final straight.

INCA BELLE (J Allen) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

RUSSIAN SATIRE (K Hannan) - Saddle slipped in the middle stages of the race placing the rider at a disadvantage. Rider reported that the filly felt indifferent in its action over the concluding stages. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the filly to be lame in the right front foot. Connections were advised a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.

Race 3 RAMONA DAY MEMORIAL MAIDEN 1200

ROC ON HOME (J Allen) - Began awkwardly. Raced wide without cover throughout.

APHADON (K Asano) - Slow to begin.

KEREOPA (K Hannan) - Slow to begin.

MONSANNA (R Elliot) - Steadied away from heels approaching the 1000 metres when placed in restricted room and then commenced to over-race for a distance.

Race 4 ALL SPARK ELECTRICAL MAIDEN 1200

STRUCK GOLD (E Nicholas) - Slow to begin then crowded shortly after. Raced keenly in the early stages.

BALLS OF FIRE (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin.

SON OF SUN (S Weatherley) - Slow to begin.

SWINDLE (K Hannan) - Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained. Raced wide without cover throughout. Shifted in under pressure passing the 150 metres making contact with HEART OF ALLADIN which was forced inwards making contact with SUPER WRAITH which had to be steadled when unbalanced. K Hannan was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.

SUPER WRAITH (T Mitchell) - Contacted and unbalanced passing the 150 metres. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions.

HEART OF ALLADIN (J Fawcett) – Contacted passing the 150 metres.

Race 5 WESTBROOK CELLAR DOOR WAIMAUKU RATING 65 1200

LEEDOX (W Kennedy) - Restrained at the start from its wide barrier. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 200 metres.

THE LETTER (T Abel) - Restrained at the start from its wide barrier.

HEY HEY BABY (T Mitchell) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

HAYLEY (J Fawcett) - When questioned the rider reported that the mare had failed to handle today's track conditions further advising that the bit had become displaced in the mare's mouth however this had not been detrimental to its chances. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the mare to have suffered cardiac arrhythmia. Co-trainer P Gerard was advised that HAYLEY will not be permitted to start in any race or trial until a veterinary certificate declaring the horse free of any cardiac arrhythmia following a gallop of at least 1000 metres.

Race 6 ITM/GIB CHAMPIONSHIP 75 BENCHMARK 1400

ONEROA (E Nicholas) - Slow to begin.

MAGDALA (N Parmar) - Slow to begin.

MANRICO (A Lawson-Carroll) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

HERO WORSHIP (J Allen) - Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

Race 7 RACE IMAGES MAIDEN 3YO 1600

BLUE BAY (K Asano) - Slow to begin.

SO THE FOX (R Elliot) – Restrained at the start from a wide barrier.

CHOCTAW SPIRIT (L Satherley) - Slow to begin.

ROC UP RALPH (M Hashizume) - Restrained at the start from a wide barrier.

TOMMY PERFECT (A Lawson-Carroll) - Raced greenly over the concluding stages.

ALMANAC (V Colgan) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding had not travelled comfortably throughout and had failed to handle today's track conditions. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

BEAU ONDAGO (V Jalalkuncha) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding had failed to respond when placed under pressure. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 8 ITM/GIB CHAMPIONSHIP OPEN HANDICAP 1600

NEW ARRANGEMENT (K Asano) - Slow to begin.

HIT THE ROAD JACK (E Nicholas) - Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after.

GEE CEE (S Spratt) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 9 ITM/GIB CHAMPIONSHIP 65 BENCHMARK 1600

PARADING (K Hannan) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

PATSYS LAD (S Spratt) - Slow to begin.

STYLIANI BELLE (L Satherley) - Contacted at the start by THEODEN which jumped outwards. Gave ground quickly passing the 800 metres being retired from the race. Was immediately attended to by the oncourse veterinarian and found to have suffered an acute cardiac event being humanely euthanised.

ONEZEDBEE (T Mitchell) - Contacted at the start becoming briefly unbalanced.

THEODEN (S McKay) - Raced keenly in the early stages. Held up rounding the final bend.

Race 10 WESTBROOK – FLOWS FROM THE LAND RATING 65 BENCHMARK 2200

CHASE 'N' GOLD (K Hannan) - Slow to begin.

BROOKBOURNE (B Rogerson) - Began awkwardly.

TE ATATU MEMPHIS (N Parmar) - Improved onto heels having to be steadied passing the 2100 metres.

KID WARRIOR (S Spratt) - Raced keenly in the early stages. Shifted out abruptly near the 450 metres into the line of MY MAEBELLINE GIRL which clipped a heel and blundered.

SHADEZ (W Kennedy) - Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 700 metres.

MY MAEBELLINE GIRL (L Satherley) – Clipped a heel and blundered near the 450 metres.

M Sanson (TOUCH THE CLOUDS) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of SHADEZ which had to be steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 700 metres.
