WILD ROVER (K	Chowdhoory) - Held up rounding the final bend. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.
•	Montes de Oca) - Weakened abruptly passing the 150 metres. When questioned regarding the er could offer no explanation. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

Race 3	THE MOSGIEL TAVERN (1400m)
	(C Campbell) - Began awkwardly, then inconvenienced shortly after the start when IN DISGUISE s. Held up for clear running rounding the final bend.

SILENT BATTLER (T Moseley) - Began awkwardly. Dictated inwards by SO NATURAL near the 1300 metres checking GOODANYA.

IN DISGUISE (T Jonker) - Shifted outwards shortly after the start inconveniencing SEA SHEPHERD. Lay out in the early stages.

GOODANYA (K Chowdhoory) - Checked near the 1300 metres when SILENT BATTLER was dictated inwards by SO NATURAL.

SO MUCH MOUR (S Khetoo) - Contacted near the 450 metres, with the rider becoming unbalanced when IN DISGUISE shifted ground outwards when insufficiently clear.

Y Atchamah (SO NATURAL) - Admitted a charge of careless riding (assisted by Apprentice Riding Mentor, Mr D Walsh) in that he permitted his mount SO NATURAL to shift inwards near the 1300 metres when not sufficiently clear of SILENT BATTLER which was dictated inwards checking GOODANYA. After hearing submissions, the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Sunday 11 June until the conclusion of racing on Friday 23 June, 7 national riding days.

T Jonker (IN DISGUISE) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount IN DISGUISE to shift outwards near the 450 metres when not sufficiently clear, making contact with SO MUCH MOUR and unbalancing its rider, which resulted in SILENT BATTLER being hampered. After hearing submissions, the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of her licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Sunday 11 June until the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 21 June, 5 national riding days.

PINHEAD (B May) - Slow to begin.			

KILOWATT (S Khetoo) - Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages after jumping from the outside barrier.

ESTABLISHMENT (K Chowdhoory) - Over-raced through the early and middle stages

HEY MICKEY (J Fawcett) - Held up for clear running until approaching the 250 metres.

SUTHERLAND (K Mudhoo) - Briefly came together and brushed with PAR TEE over the concluding stages when both horses shifted ground.

PAR TEE (C Campbell) - Briefly came together and brushed with SUTHERLAND over the concluding stages when both horses shifted ground.

Following this race, the connections of the 2nd placed PAR TEE viewed Stewards footage of the concluding stages before electing not to proceed with a protest against the winner SUTHERLAND.

Following this race rider **K Mudhoo** reported he was feeling unwell and after examination by on course St John Paramedics was found to be suffering from cramp and initially stood down from his riding engagement in Race 5, being replaced by T Moseley. Mr Mudhoo was subsequently cleared to fulfil his remaining riding engagements.

Race 5 PROPERTY BROKERS (2200m)

ASTRADEEL (S Weatherley) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

BAILADOR (S Muniandy) - Slow to begin.

CAPTAIN OUMUAMUA (D Bothamley) - Raced wide in the early stages.

ZAMBEZI ZIPPER (S Khetoo) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

THE LAST THYME (K Williams) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

HALLELUJAH BROTHER (K Kwo) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

PRIMA DONNA (B May) - Finished a distant last. When questioned regarding the performance rider could offer no explanation.

T Moseley (VILLANELLE) - Issued with a warning for the manner in which he used his whip over the concluding stages.

Race 6 DUNEDIN CITY MOTORS (1200m)

The start was delayed 2 minutes due to **REDMOND** proving difficult to load. Connections were advised a warning was placed on the gelding's barrier manners.

DIVINE REGULUS (L Callaway) - Fractious in the barriers and was unloaded from its gate to undergo a veterinary examination before being cleared to start.

BENAUD (D Montes de Oca) - Slow to begin.

DIRECT FLIGHT (S Muniandy) - Slow to begin.

GO LOTTE (S Khetoo) - Slow to begin. Raced wide throughout.

BARI (T Moseley) - When questioned regarding the performance rider reported that the gelding would appreciate a step up in distance.

REDMOND (Y Atchamah) - Lay outwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.

S Muniandy (DIRECT FLIGHT) - Issued with a warning for weighing in at 1kg in excess of that at which he weighed out.

Race 7 BAILEY KENNEDY @ EDINBURGH REALTY MAIDEN (1400m)

QUICK TAP (C Campbell) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

BLEAKHOUSE BURTIE (S Khetoo) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

CARMENTHISSWEY (T Jonker) - Began awkwardly and was then restrained to obtain cover in the early stages.

BALTIMORE (T Moseley) - Bounded at the start losing ground. When questioned regarding the performance rider reported the gelding had failed to handle today's Heavy 10 track conditions.

FLICK THE SWITCH (K Williams) - Jumped outwards leaving the barriers hampering REINEDELARIVIERE. When questioned regarding the improved performance rider reported that the mare had derived benefit from its fresh up race and appreciated today's looser track conditions.

REINEDELARIVIERE (D Montes de Oca) - Hampered leaving the barriers. Raced wide without cover throughout.

THROW THE DICE (B May) – Briefly lay inwards when placed under pressure passing the 350 metres.

NIPPY THE HIPPY (Y Atchamah) - Improved onto the heels of THROW THE DICE when that runner briefly lay inwards near the 350 metres having to be steadied.

Race 8 CENTRAL CITY CAR PAINTERS (1400m)

MAKABAR (Y Coonee) - Shifted outwards abruptly leaving the barrier, making heavy contact with DARCI'S BELLE which in turn contacted EL ROSEAY out onto NO BOUQUET which made heavy contact with LA OPCION unbalancing the rider, with PURE ZAMBEZI, CHOUX MACHER and BELLA ROSE also being hampered losing ground.

STOP YELLING (G Jogoo) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

CHOUX MACHER (L Callaway) - Hampered on jumping away. Over-raced in the early stages.

BELLA ROSE (K Chowdhoory) - Hampered on jumping away losing ground.

MORE THAN WORDS (J Fawcett) - When questioned regarding the performance rider reported the mare failed to handle the very testing heavy track conditions.

ARCTIC GLOW (C Campbell) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

LOCKDOWN LEGACY (Y Atchamah) - Raced four wide without cover throughout.

DARCI'S BELLE (S Weatherley) - Contacted heavily leaving the barriers when MAKABAR shifted outwards abruptly. When questioned regarding the performance rider reported the mare failed to handle the very testing heavy track conditions.

EL ROSEAY (B May) - Contacted leaving the barriers when DARCI'S BELLE was dictated outwards by MAKABAR.

LA OPCION (K Kwo) - Heavily contacted on jumping away when NO BOUQUET was dictated outwards with the rider becoming badly unbalanced losing ground.

PURE ZAMBEZI (K Williams) - Hampered on jumping away losing ground.

NO BOUQUET (K Mudhoo) - Dictated outwards on jumping away making heavy contact with LA OPCION.

Y Coonee (MAKABAR) - Admitted a charge of careless riding (assisted by Apprentice Riding Mentor, Mr D Walsh and his employer, Mr M Pitman) in that he permitted his mount MAKABAR to shift outwards abruptly leaving the barriers making heavy contact with DARCI'S BELLE and dictating that runner outwards onto EL ROSEAY with the outside runners, NO BOUQUET, LA OPCION, PURE ZAMBEZI, BELLA ROSE and CHOUX MACHER also being hampered to varying degrees and the rider of LA OPCION becoming unbalanced in the saddle. After hearing submissions, the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing today until the conclusion of racing on Thursday 15 June, 7 national riding days.

The Stewards directed Y Coonee to meet with an NZTR appointed Rider Skills Review Panel for remedial training under the provisions of Rule 343 due to the degree of today's incident.
