RACE COMMENTS

Race 1	CUP WEEK TICKETS ON SALE NOW 1800m
<p>OCEANS AWAY (L Callaway) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after starting at Wingatui on Thursday and was cleared to race. Slow to begin then improved forward to lead passing the 1200 metres. Under pressure passing the 500 metres finishing in last placing. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding would be more suited to a track with more moisture in it. Trainer P Harris advised that the gelding will now be retired as a racing proposition.</p> <p>ILLICIT MISS (J Kamaruddin) - Knuckled badly at the start losing considerable ground. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.</p> <p>SECOND THOUGHT (K Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Over raced in the middle stages.</p> <p>NOBLE KNIGHT (K Asano) - Got its head up when being steadied passing the 1700 metres to take a trailing position.</p> <p>DOUBLE PROSPERITY (B May) - Lay out rounding the bend near the 600 metres.</p> <p>POLAR NIGHT (J Chung) - Held up by tiring runner from the 600 metres until entering the home straight.</p>	

Race 2	VAST BILLBOARDS MAIDEN 1400m
<p>WILLIAM JOHN (G Jogoo) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after suffering a minor injury enroute to the course and was cleared to race. Began awkwardly shifting inwards making contact with MY DEGREE. Rider advised that the gelding which had been disappointing was better suited to a track with more moisture in it.</p> <p>MY DEGREE (D Montes de Oca) - Hampered at the start losing ground. Held up behind tiring runner in the run home and when attempting a run between runners near the 175 metres became awkwardly placed on heels having to be firmly restrained.</p> <p>SATELLITE (L Callaway) - Slow to begin and was then restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start. When asked to comment on the performance of this favoured runner, rider advised that the mare was not entirely comfortable with today's firmer track conditions.</p> <p>BELLA ROSE (J Chung) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Got its head up when being steadied after being placed in restricted room passing the 1100 metres losing ground as a result.</p> <p>YOU HAVE SEEN (J Laking) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.</p> <p>Following the running of this race the track was upgraded to Good 3.</p>	

Race 3	TUNNEL WASH MAIDEN 1400m
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L Vaughan (LOCHNABERRY) - The explanation tendered for the late declaration of rider was accepted on this occasion.

The start was delayed approximately 6 minutes due to LOCHNABERRY requiring a bridle change prior to the start and several runners being reluctant to load.

POW TONG (T Comignaghi) - Declared a late scratching at 12.37 pm on veterinary advice after rearing over backwards and becoming cast in the barriers. Rider T Comignaghi was attended to by St John Paramedics and cleared to fulfil her remaining riding engagements. The connections were advised that POW TONG will now be required to barrier trial on two occasions to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed general soreness. Stable foreman R Mildon advised Stewards that POW TONG will be returning to the Cambridge based stable for further barrier training.

PHEROZ FRIENDS (S Wynne) - Declared a late scratching at 12.39 pm after refusing to load. The connections were advised that PHEROZ FRIENDS will now be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

GOLDIE'S CHANCE (K Kwo) - Removed from the barriers to undergo a veterinary examination prior to the start and was cleared to race.

FOLKTALE (R Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

COVARCHI (G Jogoo) - Slow to begin. Contacted and badly unbalanced near the 450 metres.

TAWHIRIMATEA (B May) - Slow to begin and then raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

NIPPY THE HIPPY (S Toolooa) - Raced greenly through the middle stages, and near the 450 metres when in restricted room made heavy contact with COVARCHI with both runners becoming badly unbalanced, then when being corrected by its rider again made contact with COVARCHI. Continued to race greenly over the concluding stages with the rider being unable to ride his mount out fully. The connections were advised that the mare would be placed on a racing manners warning.

ZAPPOLINO (L Callaway) - Held up for several strides near the 350 metres when a marginal run closed.

ALLASERA (C Carmine) - Briefly held up rounding the final bend.

Race 4	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 800m
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ILLICIT DREAMS (T Comignaghi) - Began awkwardly shifting outwards crowding outside runners. Placed in restricted room and briefly steadied across the junction near the 600 metres when SKY ON FIRE (S Wynne) improved forward to lead. S Wynne was advised to exercise greater care. Held up early in the run home until approaching the 200 metres.

GWYNVER (L Callaway) – Crowded at the start losing ground. Near the 400 metres improved onto the heels of SEMPER SUPRA shifting out to avoid those heels hampering TRIKSTA.

TRIKSTA (K Kwo) - Crowded at the start losing ground. Hampered near the 400 metres.

YAK SHA (B May) - Slow to begin.

SURF QUEEN (J Fawcett) - Held up early in the run home having to shift outwards across heels passing the 250 metres to find clear racing room and in doing so briefly hampered SEMPER SUPRA.

SEMPER SUPRA (T Moseley) - Held up early in the run home. Briefly hampered near the 250 metres.

Race 5	NZB AIRFREIGHT ROAD TO JERICHO 3000m
<p>RED SUNDAY (B May) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after the rider had some concerns with the gelding's action in the preliminary and was cleared to race.</p> <p>FIVE PRINCES (D Montes de Oca) - Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover from the 1000 metres.</p> <p>DEELS DONE (K Williams) - Began awkwardly shifting in crowding inside runners.</p> <p>WANNABE 'N' PARIS (J Kamaruddin) - Blundered on jumping losing ground.</p> <p>EULOGY SHOW (S Wynne) – Hampered at the start then crowded shortly after losing ground. Held up early in the run home.</p> <p>EKSTREMEMISS (G Jogoo) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Raced three wide without cover through the run down the back straight.</p> <p>LEITRIM LAD (T Moseley) - Shifted out shortly after the start crowding outside runners.</p> <p>JILDI JILDI (A Balloo) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.</p> <p>ATHENE (K Mudhoo) - Over raced in the early stages.</p> <p>NASSAK DIAMOND (L Allpress) - Lay out in the run home and had to be straightened passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>ON THE RIVET (J Fawcett) - Quickly beaten in the run home, with the rider expressing disappointment with the gelding's effort. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.</p>	
Race 6	HELSTON & ASSOCIATES 1200m
<p>OUR ROSETTE (J Chung) - Began awkwardly and then crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages and passing the 1000 metres had to be firmly restrained when improving quickly onto the heels of VINO BELLA.</p> <p>BENAUD (D Montes de Oca) - Blundered at the start contacting THE BOLD LOOK.</p> <p>SELFIE (K Mudhoo) - Slow to begin and then restrained behind runners to obtain cover.</p> <p>ZOULANDER (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Passing the 250 metres was bumped by SANTISSIMA (T Comignaghi) which was laying outwards, with ZOULANDER then making contact with BENAUD's hind quarters and as a consequence was turned inwards resulting in ZOULANDER being checked.</p> <p>THE BOLD LOOK (J Laking) - Buffeted and contacted shortly after the start. Rider reported that the gelding had raced greenly in only its second race day start and would take natural benefit from today's race.</p> <p>BOOT IT SCOOTER (K Chowdhoo) - Held up in the middle stages of the run home before angling outwards passing the 100 metres to find clear racing room.</p> <p>SANTISSIMA (T Comignaghi) - Lay outwards in the run home contacting BENAUD and becoming unbalanced passing the 250 metres.</p>	

ROCASTANO (L Allpress) - When asked to comment on the performance of this favoured runner, rider advised that the gelding had found the Good 3 conditions today unfavourable for its first up effort in five months.

T Comignaghi (SANTISSIMA) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount SANTISSIMA to shift out marginally passing the 250 metres contacting ZOULANDER which then contacted BENAUD's hind quarters resulting in ZOULANDER having to be restrained to avoid heels. In assessing this matter Stewards took into account that BENAUD had been laying in at the point of contact and had contributed to the incident.

Race 7 | **NZB READY TO RUN SALE TRAINERS SERIES 1200m**

M Walker (IMAGE OF YOU) - Issued with a warning after presenting his runner without notified gear (nasal strip).

MATSCOT (T Moseley) - Slow to begin.

SHEZZACATCH (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

IMAGE OF YOU (J Kamaruddin) – Shifted out shortly after the start making contact with TREYBON and as a result lost ground.

TREYBON (J Laking) - Contacted shortly after the start losing ground.

ADANNAYA (T Comignaghi) - Placed in restricted room losing some ground passing the 1000 metres, with rider T Comignaghi advising that the mare had resented being crowded and was not comfortable in today's firmer track conditions.

DANCARINA (L Allpress) - Had some trouble obtaining clear running throughout the run home.

RADIANT ROSIE (B May) - Crowded and placed in restricted room briefly having to steady when tiring passing the 300 metres.

EPTIMUM (L Callaway) - Crowded and had to steady passing the 150 metres when runners either side shifted ground.

J Laking (TREYBON) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount TREYBON to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of RADIANT ROSIE which was crowded having to steady passing the 300 metres.

C Johnson (STREET FIGHTIN MAN) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount STREET FIGHTIN MAN to shift outwards under pressure passing the 150 metres crowding EPTIMUM which had to steady.

S Wynne (SHEZZACATCH) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount SHEZZACATCH to shift inwards passing the 150 metres crowding EPTIMUM which had to steady.

Race 8 | **WAR DECREE STAKES (G3) 1600m**

DELMONICO (B May) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

MOOLOOLABA (K Asano) - Slow to begin and then restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start. Improved onto heels having to be restrained passing the 1200 metres.

IT'S NOT UNUSUAL (C Johnson) - Slow to begin then raced three wide without cover through the early to middle stages.

BLUE SOLITAIRE (S Wynne) - Over raced in the middle stages and got its head up when being restrained to gain cover passing the 1000 metres. Continued to over race for some distance.

COGNITO (J Laking) - Improved quickly onto the heels of IT'S NOT UNUSUAL which was tiring passing the 600 metres and when shifting out dictated MOOLOOLABA wider on the track for a distance.

B May (DELMONICO) - Issued with a warning after using his whip on DELMONICO when the horse was out of contention.

Race 9 | **COUPLAND'S BAKERIES MILE PRELUDE 1400m**

SERIOUSLY (T Moseley) - Slow to begin. Rider could offer no tangible explanation for the disappointing performance.

KHIMAR WAR (K Asano) - Contacted then hampered shortly after the start losing ground.

NOD OF THE HEAD (S Wynne) - Contacted shortly after the start. Briefly placed in restricted room getting its head up for a distance near the 1000 metres.

PHELAN THE POWER (J Laking) - Raced three wide without cover throughout and shifted in under pressure over the concluding stages.

PERFECT SCENARIO (J Kamaruddin) - Improved onto heels having to be steadied and as a result shifted wider on the track near the 1000 metres.

ZELENSKI (J Fawcett) - Shifted outwards passing the 900 metres to sit outside the leader and in doing so briefly hampered HARBOURSIDE. J Fawcett was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground. When questioned regarding her decision to leave the trailing position, J Fawcett advised Stewards she was aware she was following an unfavoured runner and that her mount was carrying top weight so she decided it was a better option to race with clear running sitting outside the leader.

AVAQUINELLA (T Comignaghi) - Held up for clear running for the majority of the run home going to the line untested by its rider.

Race 10 | **SOTHYS SPRING CLASSIC 2000m**

ASATHOUGHT (J Laking) - Slow to begin.

RAINMAN (T Moseley) - Slow to begin.

BELLE OF THE BALL (J Kamaruddin) – Restrained from a wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start. Improved three wide without cover from the 800 metres. Contacted 400 metres.

LETSBRINGITON (D Montes de Oca) - Improved three wide without cover from the 800 metres.

CAMPIONESSA (L Allpress) - Held up rounding the final bend and when shifting out made contact with BELLE OF THE BALL passing the 400 metres.

RIVIERA ROCK (L Callaway) - Raced in restricted room having to briefly steady passing the 450 metres when LETSBRINGITON lay in and ELIZABETH ROSE shifted out looking for clear racing room.

SUMMER FESTIVAL (C Johnson) - Lay out under pressure over the concluding stages having to be straightened passing the 100 metres.

K Chowdhoo (ELIZABETH ROSE) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount ELIZABETH ROSE to shift out passing the 450 metres when not fully clear of RIVIERA ROCK which had to steady briefly.

Race 11	PRYDE'S EASIFEED 1600m
<p>D Champion/K Murphy (ANCHOR ME) - The explanation tendered for the late declaration of rider was accepted on this occasion.</p> <p>The start was delayed approximately 3 minutes when POWERFUL MOSS refused to load.</p> <p>POWERFUL MOSS (J Fawcett) - Declared a late scratching at 5.19pm after refusing to load. The connections were advised that the gelding will now be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.</p> <p>INVINCIBEEL (J Kamaruddin) - Began awkwardly. Held up rounding the final bend and had to shift ground outwards across heels passing the 400 metres to find clear racing room and in doing so dictated WAIHORA MIST wider on the track.</p> <p>BEAU ROUGE (J Laking) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Got its head up when racing ungenerously as the field made the bend near the 1000 metres.</p> <p>SCARLETT'S PROMISE (C Campbell) - Placed in restricted room shortly after the start when ATAAHUA (D Montes de Oca) shifted in briefly. D Montes de Oca was advised to exercise greater care. Held up for clear running through the middle stages of the run home.</p> <p>ANCHOR ME (S Wynne) - Hampered and then crowded losing ground shortly after the start when the runner to its outside shifted ground.</p> <p>SWEET LILLY (R Mudhoo) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>TAVILIGHT (K Williams) - Not persevered with in the final straight with the rider reporting that the gelding had been under pressure and had been disappointing. Co-trainer M Pitman advised that the gelding will now be retired as a racing proposition.</p> <p>A Balloo (AMAZON GODDESS) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount AMAZON GODDESS to shift in at the start crowding ANCHOR ME ad BEAU ROUGE which both lost some ground. In assessing this incident Stewards took into account some outward movement from an inside runner.</p>
