GENERAL

Pre-race blood testing was carried out at this meeting.

SUPPLEMENTARY

Gore RC – Wednesday 26 October 2022

Race 3 - Gore Town & Country Club 1800m

Trainer **R Didham** was issued with a warning under Rule 613(c) when presenting **THE GROWLER** with marginal racing plates that required farrier attention prior to the race.

Race 4 – MLT Publican Punters Day 1800m

Trainer **G Eade** advised Stewards that after the disappointing effort from **COSY NOOK** he had a further veterinary inspection at his home stable which was all clear. He further advised that the gelding would carry on its current campaign.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 GRAND SSLAM TRADING COMPANY PREMIER MAIDEN 1600m

THE ARCTIC BLAST (J Parr) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Was inclined to race ungenerously in the middle stages when being restrained getting its head up and having a tendency to lay out. When attempting to improve into a tight run to the outside of **YOU HAVE SEEN** near the 350 metres became awkwardly placed on that runner's heels when **YOU HAVE SEEN** shifted outwards away from runners to its inside. As a result **THE ARCTIC BLAST** made contact with **ROYAL KHAN** which was checked when forced outwards across the heels of **NINE REALMS**. When assessing this incident Stewards took into account the outward movement from **YOU HAVE SEEN**, the racing manners of **THE ARCTIC BLAST**, along with **NINE REALMS** racing tight to the outside of **ROYAL KHAN** rounding the bend. J Parr was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

CHAMONIX (L Allpress) - Raced ungenerously getting its head up through the early and middle stages.

YOU HAVE SEEN (R Elliot) - Over raced getting its head up on a number of occasions through the early stages. Raced wide without cover throughout.

SASSY CHOUXS (G Jogoo) - Had to be restrained after improving onto heels near the 1400 metres then over racing for a distance. Held up early in the final straight and did not obtain clear running until passing the 200 metres.

ZAPPOLINO (L Sutherland) - Raced three wide without cover from the 1000 metres.

WHILE YOU'RE THERE (K Chowdhoo) - Held up rounding the final turn and early in the straight not obtaining clear running until near the 200 metres.

JUSTA LAD (K Asano) - Held up approaching the 400 metres and was unable to obtain clear running until near the 250 metres.

ROYAL KHAN (T Moseley) - Made contact with **NINE REALMS** when shifting outwards to obtain clear running rounding the bend near the 450 metres. Checked when contacted and forced outwards across the heels of **NINE REALMS** near the 350 metres.

POWERLITE (M McNab) - Held up early in the final straight having to shift outwards across heels to obtain clear running near the 250 metres.

NIGHTFALL (T Comignaghi) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised in her opinion the gelding would be better suited by some easing of the ground.

The track was upgraded to Good 3 retrospective to R1.

Race 2 NZB READY TO RUN SALE TRAINERS SERIES MAIDEN 1200m

The start was delayed approximately 5½ minutes due to **EXPRESS COUP** escaping from the birdcage riderless then undergoing a veterinary inspection after being recaptured being passed fit to race.

TAKING MY TIME (R Elliot) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after being fractious in the barriers and was passed fit to race.

ARCHERFIELD (L Sutherland) - Blundered shortly after the start losing ground. Dipped near the 250 metres.

KINDRED SPIRIT (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Over raced in the middle stages.

THE NUMBER ONE SON (R Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

TWITCHY SQUIRREL (G Saejorhor) - Hampered shortly after the start losing ground.

EXPRESS COUP (K Chowdhoo) - Began awkwardly and was then restrained behind runners shortly after the start to obtain cover.

THIRD DECREE (T Comignaghi) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained shortly after the start.

ABIT SASSY (K Asano) - Briefly steadied to avoid the heels of BORNHOLM which shifted outwards to obtain clear running near the 350 metres.

HEMI RIDAPEST (C Grylls) - Over raced in the middle stages. Held up entering the straight until approaching the 200 metres.

BORNHOLM (B Murray) - Held up entering the final straight before shifting outwards across heels to obtain clear running near the 350 metres.

NIGHT RAIDER (M McNab) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.

B Murray (BORNHOLM) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount BORNHOLM to shift outwards when not fully clear of ABIT SASSY which was steadied near the 350 metres.

Race 3 | **ONE GOOD HORSE AT AVONHEAD TAVERN PREMIER 1200m**

BOOT IT SCOOTER (K Chowdhoo) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground. Held up having to be briefly steadied when improving onto the heels of the weakening O'JESSICA near the 100 metres.

DUBAI LADY (K Williams) - Contacted then blundered at the start losing ground.

SMALL TOWN BELLE (K Asano) - Contacted then crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

MIDNIGHT JANE (L Allpress) - Slow to begin.

ZOULANDER (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

GOODANYA (T Taiaroa) - Slow to begin.

AVITUS (J Laking) - Began awkwardly shifting outwards abruptly from the outside barrier losing ground shortly after the start and then commenced to race ungenerously through the early to middle stages. Contacted near the 800 metres when YARI shifted outwards to avoid the heels of LORNA DOON (T Comignaghi) which shifted inwards when not fully clear. T Comignaghi was advised to exercise greater care.

HELSINKI (V Colgan) - Over raced through the early and middle stages.

Race 4 | **GARRARDS HORSE HOUND PREMIER 1100m**

ROC CHA (K Asano) - Became fractious in its barrier and was then slow to begin. Briefly placed in restricted room when DANCARINA lay in near the 100 metres.

RIPA RUBY (T Comignaghi) - Blundered badly at the start losing ground. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

GELATO (R Mudhoo) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

SWISSWATCH (L Sutherland) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

GOLDEN HARVEST (S Wynne) - Lost its footing and blundered leaving the barriers.

JUSTANACE (K Chowdhoo) - Jumped away awkwardly.

OUR GIRL GILLY (M Taylor) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

MARIA FARINA (C Grylls) - Held up near the 400 metres.

Race 5	DONALDSON BROWN PEGASUS STAKES 1000m (Listed Race)

OKAY PAL (S Wynne) - Very slow to begin. Held up rounding the final turn until passing the 400 metres.

BURGUNDY ROSE (J Parr) - Slow away. Rider dropped his whip near the 150 metres.

BUOYANT (K Asano) - Slow away. Held up early in the straight until passing the 300 metres.

RADIANT ROSIE (T Taiaroa) - Began very awkwardly losing ground. Raced wide without cover throughout.

STREET FIGHTIN MAN (C Johnson) - Blundered badly at the start losing ground. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

LINCOLN'S KRUZ (L Allpress) - Over raced through the early and middle stages.

CHALLA (C Grylls) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had travelled well until when asked to quicken and may have been feeling the firm nature of today's footing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slow rate of recovery with an elevated heart rate.

JILDI JILDI (A Balloo) - Slow to begin.

BEAUDZ WELL (V Colgan) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

DR VELOCIOUS (K Mudhoo) - Blundered shortly after the start with the rider becoming briefly unbalanced.

YOLO (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had been inclined to over race which had been detrimental to its chances.

LUCKY VIKING (S O'Malley) - Slow to begin then improved forward and raced three wide without cover.

IFITHAPPENSAGAIN (C Johnson) - Commenced to over race shifting outwards to avoid heels near the 1200 metres inconveniencing VOLVIK and VICENZA.

VOLVIK (T Moseley) - Inconvenienced near the 1200 metres.

VICENZA (K Asano) - Inconvenienced near the 1200 metres.

VERMONT (C Campbell) - Held up over the concluding stages when improving onto the heels of ASTRAKHAN.

Race 7

NAUTICAL BOAT INSURANCE METROPOLITAN TROPHY 2500m (Listed Race)

ASATHOUGHT (J Laking) - Slow to begin. Held up approaching the 400 metres before shifting ground inwards to obtain clear running near the 350 metres.

QUOTA (L Allpress) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up passing the 400 metres then failed to finish the race off once obtaining clear running.

LETSBRINGTON (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly then further hampered when crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

EKSTREMEMISS (G Jogoo) - Slow to begin.

CAMPIONESSA (J Parr) - Restrained behind runners from a wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start.

HIT THE ROAD JACK (M Cropp) - Raced wide without cover through the early stages then improved forward to lead near the 1500 metres.

MONDORANI (S O'Malley) - Held up for a distance passing the 400 metres behind the weakening HIT THE ROAD JACK.

STARRYBEEL (M McNab) - Held up rounding the final turn being contacted by HERSELF which lay in near the 400 metres then having difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 250 metres.

BELLE OF THE BALL (J Kamaruddin) - When questioned regarding performance rider was of the opinion the mare had failed to see out the distance of today's race.

Race 8

GOLD CLUB PREMIER 1400m

ZACAT became fractious in the barriers prior to the start, with **TREYBON** which was in an adjacent stall reacting and getting its head cast over the front of the barrier. When being freed by opening the front gate **TREYBON** escaped riderless and was declared a late scratching at 4.03pm. As a result this race ran approximately 7 minutes late.

ZACAT (C Johnson) - Became fractious in its barrier with the rider becoming dislodged. **ZACAT** underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was cleared to race, with rider C Johnson being attended to by St John Paramedics and found fit to fulfil his riding engagement. Trainer S Wynne was advised that a barrier warning would be recorded against the mare and indicated that **ZACAT** would now be spelled. A bandage on the right hind leg dislodged near the 200 metres after becoming loose during the race.

NAVALHA (J Parr) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination at the barriers and was cleared to race.

MATSCOT (t Moseley) - Slow to begin.

DORIS DIOR (C Campbell) - Jumped away very awkwardly losing ground.

VICTOR ROUGE (R Elliot) - Raced ungenerously when steadied near the 1100 metres.

KEEN TO RUN (S O'Malley) - Raced three wide without cover.

KOPUA (T Comignaghi) - Raced four wide without cover.

FETTERCAIRN (S Wynne) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 150 metres.

DA VINCI GIRL (K Chowdhury) - Held up passing the 200 metres. Required post-race veterinary attention for superficial abrasions to the lip, nose and stifles.

S Wynne (FETTERCAIRN) - Issued with a warning after LETTERCAIRN was presented without the notified gear of side winkers.

SPECIALTY (B May) - Began awkwardly shifting outwards crowding JAFFIRA.

PIER (M McNab) - Began awkwardly and blundered. Commenced to over race on a moderate tempo and shifted outwards to avoid heels then racing three wide without cover from the 1000 metres.

MOOLOOLABA (K Asano) - Jumped away awkwardly hampering MR TWINKLETOES.

MR TWINKLETOES (S O'Malley) - Hampered leaving the barriers. Got its head up when being restrained to obtain cover approaching the 1100 metres.

JAFFIRA (J Kamaruddin) - Began awkwardly briefly unbalancing its rider and was then crowded losing ground shortly after the start. Had to be steadied passing the 200 metres when COGNITO lay in.

CHARBANO (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly then crowded losing ground shortly after the start.

ALFRISTON (J Fawcett) - Rider dropped her right rein as the start was effected and as a result was slow to begin.

REDMOND (T Comignaghi) - Had to be steadied when DISS IS DRAMATIC (L Allpress) which was being steadied shifted inwards when not fully clear passing the 1300 metres.

DYNASTIC (J Parr) - When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse.

DISS IS DRAMATIC (L Allpress) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the filly had travelled when enough but had failed to respond once placed under pressure and had been disappointing. A post-race veterinary inspection found the filly to have a slow recovery with a persistently high heart rate.

L Allpress (DISS IS DRAMATIC) - Issued with a warning after steadying her mount DISS IS DRAMATIC when shifting inwards and not fully clear of REDMOND near the 1300 metres.

ITS ALL OVER ROVER (T Moseley) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

HEY SOUL SISTER (G Jogoo) - Slow to begin. Held up rounding the final turn and early in the straight.

HOW UNUSUAL (S Wynne) - Slow to begin then blundered shortly after the start losing ground.

GABBY DIAZ (K Mudhoo) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

TANTALEE (R Mudhoo) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

BURITZ (R Elliot) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

LADY MODENA (S Muniandy) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

SANTISSIMA (L Allpress) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

LOGAN'S LOGIC (M McNab) - Contacted by **COLOSSAL** (M Taylor) passing the 1200 metres and forced inwards. M Taylor was advised to exercise greater care.

ELLENAWROE (T Comignaghi) - Had to be firmly restrained when improving onto the heels of **LOGAN'S LOGIC** near the 1100 metres going back onto **WAIHORA MIST** which also had to be steadied as a result.

WAIHORA MIST (V Colgan) - Had to be steadied off heels near the 1100 metres.

TAIMATE DIVA (K Chowdhury) - Over raced in the middle stages on a moderate tempo. Had to be steadied to avoid heels over the concluding stages.

STAR BALLOT (K Asano) - Had to be steadied off the heels of **TAIMATE DIVA** near the 1000 metres.

DEMAND RESPECT (K Williams) - Over raced in the middle stages being inclined to get its head up.

ANCHOR ME (C Grylls) - Badly held up until near the 200 metres.

INVINCIBEL (J Parr) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had never travelled overly well and may have been feeling the firmish nature of today's track. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.
