Race 4 - DUNEDIN CITY MOTORS R85 2200 METRES

Trainer J Dalton advised stewards that after a disappointing performance, **ZENDORA** was found post-race to be suffering from high liver enzymes and as a result has been given a brief freshen up before carrying on in its current campaign.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 VERNON AND VAZEY TRUCK PARTS MAIDEN 1500m

ROYAL KHAN (R Mudhoo) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after falling over leaving the parade ring and was cleared to race. Slow away. Raced four wide when attempting to improve forward from the 600 metres.

OLD NAVY (K Mudhoo) - Bumped with MARCHING ON TAVI leaving the barriers.

MARCHING ON TAVI (J Laking) - Bumped with OLD NAVY leaving the barriers.

NINJA (T Moseley) - Lay out under pressure making slight contact with DUPUG passing the 100 metres, with those two runners again making contact just short of the finish. Prior to the authorisation of dividends T Moseley viewed Stewards' films before electing not to proceed with a protest.

DUPUG (L Sutherland) - Made contact with NINJA passing the 100 metres and again just short of the finish.

Race 2 GREYMOUTH STAR/GREYMOUTH BUSINESSES SPRINT 1100m

KOPUA (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin. Lost the near front plate passing the 400 metres, becoming awkward in its action losing its footing and falling to the track. Neither horse nor jockey were injured in this incident.

DIVINE DIVE (K Mudhoo) - Got its head up in the early stages when being steadied to take cover near the 800 metres.

Following this race a delegation of Stewards and senior riders inspected the area of the fall. After hearing from all riders it was agreed that the meeting would continue.

Race 3 FRANK MCLAUGHLIN MEMORIAL MAIDEN 1100m

PROPER TWELVE (L Sutherland) - Slow away. Rider L Sutherland was dislodged on returning to scale, with her mount escaping for a short distance before being recaptured by the Clerk of the Course. L Sutherland was uninjured in this incident.

WAYNES RUBY (K Mudhoo) - Raced greenly passing the 400 metres and shifted in abruptly before being straightened by its rider. Rider K Mudhoo reported that the gelding had felt indifferent in its action, believing it was feeling the very firm nature of today's track. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 4 THANKS FOR THE MEMORIES FRANK STAMMERS 1100m

MOREIRA (L Sutherland) - Slow away.

KAPALKA (K Chowdhoory) - Slow away.

TAP 'N' GO (J Laking) - Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover after jumping from the outside barrier.

AUNT CINDY (R Mudhoo) - Raced four wide without cover in the early stages. Steadied away from heels passing the 700 metres when racing keenly. Raced wide from the 500 metres when improving.

COME BACK TIGER (T Jonker) - Raced three wide without cover.

STREET KID (K Mudhoo) - Rider reported that the gelding did not handle the firm nature of today's track.

Race 5

WESTLAND RACING CLUB MISS SCENICLAND STAKES 1500m

DA VINCI GIRL (K Chowdhoory) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

NAMIBIA MISS (K Williams) - Began awkwardly.

SEVEN TWENTY (T Moseley) - Slow to begin and then hampered shortly after the start losing ground. Brushed with YAMUNA on two occasions passing the 225 metres when looking for clear racing room.

CASTLE ON THE HILL (K Mudhoo) - Slow to begin. Raced three wide without cover through the early stages.

YAMUNA (L Sutherland) - Blundered shortly after the start and then hampered losing ground. Contacted on two occasions near the 225 metres.

LADY MODENA (R Mudhoo) - Held up briefly passing the 400 metres.

BRUNO MAGILE (L Sutherland) - Slow away. Held up over the concluding stages going to the line not fully tested by its rider.

POWER 'N' PASSION (K Chowdhoory) - Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages.

REALDOSER (K Kwo) - Raced wide without cover.

ILLUSION (K Mudhoo) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home. Again held up over the concluding stages having to be steadied inside the final 50 metres.

DRAKE BAY (J Laking) - Underwent a post-race veterinary examination after returning to the enclosure with blood present in the right nostril, which revealed a laceration consistent with having banged its head on the starting gates.

Race 7RECREATION HOTEL GREYMOUTH CUP 2000mTHE GROWLER (K Chowdhoory) - Rider dropped his whip near the 200 metres.

ALJAY (L Sutherland) - Rider reported that the gelding had been out-paced in the early stages but found the line well over the concluding stages and would take natural benefit from its first up run in some time.

Race 8 GREG DALY REAL ESTATE 2000m

REDGUM (K Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly and was slow away as a result.

TRAV (T Moseley) - Slow away.

TELLING TALES (L Callaway) - Got its head up when being steadied off heels near the 1600 metres.

SPINDLESHANKS (R Mudhoo) - Raced three wide without cover until near the 1200 metres.

WANNABE 'N' VEGAS (L Sutherland) - Raced three wide without cover from the 1200 metres. When asked to comment on the performance of this favoured runner, rider advised she had been trapped wide throughout which had been detrimental to the mare's chances today.

LUCKY VIKING (J Chung) - Held up for a distance passing the 500 metres.
