RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 AUTO WINDSCREEN REPLACEMENTS / CALDWELL CONTRACTING MAIDEN (1200m)

RAGHALLAIGH (R Beeharry) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after rearing over backwards in the parade ring and was cleared to start. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

SUSPECT OR VICTIM (G Jogoo) - Proved very difficult to load. Stood flat footed as the start was effected losing considerable ground. Connections were advised the filly must barrier trial to Stewards satisfaction prior to racing next.

WHATA SHAMBLES (K Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

WAIHOAKA (S Khetoo) - Slow to begin.

FARAH (T Moseley) - Slow to begin.

PHILOTE (C Campbell) - Shifted out at the start hampering KEEP IT LOOSE. Had some difficulty obtaining clear racing room over the final 100 metres.

KEEP IT LOOSE (L Callaway) - Hampered at the start. Shifted in abruptly passing the 200 metres hampering NAVAHO JO. Continued to lay in throughout the run home.

NAVAHO JO (D Montes de Oca) - Hampered near the 200 metres initially when KEEP IT LOOSE (L Callaway) shifted in and then some outwards movement from MOROCCO MISS. L Callaway was advised to exercise care.

TE TUA (J Mudhoo) - Out paced throughout.

Following this race the official track conditions were upgraded to Good 3.

Race 2 THREE RIVERS HOTEL FIRESIDE CUP (1200m)

HENRY HUBBER (D Montes de Oca) - Slow to begin.

SACRED KITTY (K Kwo) - Shifted out abruptly shortly after the start making contact with and hampering ALBATROSS, which was then forced out on to RUBY ROYALE which was crowded losing ground. Lay outwards throughout the race and particularly in the run home. Rider dropped his whip approaching the 150 metres.

RUBY ROYALE (C Campbell) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

ALBATROSS (K Mudhoo) - Contacted and hampered shortly after the start.

THE GOOD SHEPHERD (K Kalychurun) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

GIVEHERAGO (T Moseley) - When asked to comment rider could offer no tangible excuse for the disappointing performance.

Race 3 GORE ELITE PLUMBING / ADVANCE AGRICULTURE MAIDEN (1335m)

LEICA STAR (G Jogoo) - Reared in the gates just prior to the start. Began awkwardly losing ground.

REDDINGTON (J Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly.

AUSPICIOUSOCCASION (C Campbell) - Slow to begin.

RACONTEUSE (K Chowdhoory) - Slow to begin.

BUSH MILLS BILLY (K Kalychurun) - Improved on to heels when over-racing passing the 1150 metres and shifted out hampering PURE ZAMBEZI which was forced wider on the track. Raced three wide without cover throughout. Rider was of the opinion the gelding had not handled today's firm track conditions.

PURE ZAMBEZI (B Murray) - Hampered near the 1100 metres. Rider was of the opinion the mare had not handled today's firm track conditions.

CHOUX MACHER (L Callaway) - Lay out rounding the final bend and continued to lay out in the run home.

Race 4 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1335m)

ZENDORA (B Murray) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up rounding the final bend until near the 275 metres.

CASTLE ON THE HILL (K Chowdhoory) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start. Raced keenly through the middle stages.

SHAZZA (K Kwo) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

Race 5 LES FRISBY CONTRACTING / TITIROA TRANSPORT / BEATTIES COLLISION REPAIR (1335m)

PLAY THE FIELD (G Jogoo) - Began awkwardly.

THE CLUSTER (D Bothamley) - Slow to begin.

PAMPAS (C Campbell) - Slow to begin.

ANGE DE REVE (K Chowdhoory) - Slow to begin.

DECEPTIO VISUS (L Callaway) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

ARCEUS (D Montes de Oca) - Over-raced through the early stages when being restrained to obtain cover.

ELUSIVE TEN (K Kwo) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Race 6 AON INSURANCE BROKERS & AB LIME WYNDHAM CUP (2000m)

HUMBUCKER (C Campbell) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

KILOWATT (T Moseley) - Slow to begin and was then hampered shortly after the start losing ground.

EKSTREMEMISS (G Jogoo) - Slow to begin. When asked to comment on the performance rider advised in his opinion the mare is better suited to races with more distance.

ZAMBEZI ZIPPER (D Montes de Oca) - Shifted out shortly after the start hampering KILOWATT.

CAMINO ROCOSO (J Laking) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

SUTHERLAND (K Mudhoo) - When asked to comment on the apparent improved performance trainer J Gordon expressed surprise at the result but added the gelding had received a soft run in front and this combined with the light weight may have led to the better performance today.

Race 7 HILLSIDE METALS /MCKENZIE FAMILY PINE BUSH CUP (2000m)

GERRY JOYCE (K Kalychurun) - Blundered at the start making contact with ABRUZZI.

ABRUZZI (D Bothamley) - Contacted at the start. Held up rounding the final bend.

THE TUI TOILER (G Jogoo) - Ran off on the first bend near the 1700 metres shifting to the outside fence for a distance and losing ground, then re-joined the field near the 1000 metres and raced wide without cover from that point. As this was the third occasion that the gelding had proved difficult to steer or run off during a race the connections were advised the THE TUI TOILER must complete two official trials to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

CARLOS (S Khetoo) - Raced in restricted room over the final 50 metres when runners either side shifted ground.

K Kalychurun (GERRY JOYCE) – Issued with a warning when striking his mount GERRY JOYCE 6 times prior to the 100 metres with Stewards taking into account Mr Kalychurun's clear recent record with regard to any breach of a whip rule.

Race 8 HERBERTS TRANSPORT / VETCO EDENDALE MAIDEN (2000m)

LEO'S HIPPO (D Bothamley) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after sustaining a minor skin laceration just below an eye in the tie-up stalls and was cleared to start. Shifted out abruptly at the start crowding several runners. Made the first bend awkwardly, shifting wider on the track and proving a difficult ride in the early stages.

CALL ME AL (B Murray) - Fractious in its gate prior to the start then bounded as the start was effected losing ground.

MAGGIE MAY (K Kalychurun) - Began awkwardly and was then crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

LEVON (T Moseley) - Crowded shortly after the start when inside runners shifted out and SANDY COOL lay inwards. Raced keenly through the middle stages. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the run home.

PROPOSAL (K Kwo) - Contacted and forced wider shortly after the start.

BETH DUTTON (K Chowdhoory) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Rider reported the mare had been unsuited to the mixed tempo of today's race and the firm nature of the track.

MI JADORE (R Beeharry) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover.

ZA BEAUTEOUS (S Khetoo) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

COMPLIMENT (C Campbell) - When asked to comment rider could offer no tangible excuse for the disappointing performance.
