RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 STALLION TENDER NOW OPEN MAIDEN 2200m

KARA ZOR EL (K Hercock) - Slow to begin. Over raced in the early stages and had to be heavily restrained away from heels passing the 1600 metres.

ENERGETIC (C Campbell) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover.

RELENTLESS KAYDEN (R Mudhoo) - Over raced in the early and middle stages before being allowed to improve forward to lead near the 1100 metres. Lay out under pressure over the concluding stages crowding FAH PHA onto FRANNI CACCINI.

IRISH MOSS (K Williams) - Lay out rounding the final turn. Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 300 metres by KARA ZOR EL which was taken out by FAH PHA (L Douglas) when looking for clear racing room at that stage. Rider L Douglas was advised to exercise greater care. Rider reported the mare had not been suited by the mixed tempo of today's race.

FRANNI CACCINI (A Balloo) - Struck a heel of IRISH MOSS and blundered near the 400 metres when IRISH MOSS lay out rounding the final bend. Unbalanced when crowded over the concluding stages.

FAH PHA (L Douglas) - Briefly held up passing the 300 metres having to shift ground outwards to find clear running. Crowded over the concluding stages.

R Mudhoo (RELENTLESS KAYDEN) - Issued with a warning after allowing his mount RELENTLESS KAYDEN to shift outwards over the concluding stages crowding and unbalancing FAH PHA and FRANNI CACCINI.

Race 2 3F AT WEST FITZROY APARTMENTS MAIDEN 1600m

TRUE HOPE IS SWIFT (T Jonker) - Slow away.

KEEP IT LOOSE (B Murray) - Jumped away awkwardly getting its head up losing ground then commencing to over race shortly after the start and continuing to do so over the middle stages. Rider advised that the gelding over racing through the early and middle stages had led to a disappointing performance.

COSSETTE (R Mudhoo) - Steadied to obtain cover in the early stages after jumping from the outside barrier.

Race 3 ELMWOOD TRADING CO MAIDEN 1400m

BENJI'S BOY (J Doyle) - Slow to begin.

DARKHAN ROAR (B Murray) - Crowded between runners at the start losing some ground.

DEAR JOHN LINCOLN (H McNeill) - Slow to begin. Rider reported that after beginning slowly the gelding had found the line okay and at this stage may be looking for further ground.

PHILOTE (T Jonker) - Raced four wide without cover through the early and middle stages before being restrained back to take cover.

BALTIMORE (L Callaway) - Raced three wide without cover through the early and middle stages.

CRUISE (Y Atchamah) - Held up early in the run home.

THATS CHARMING (K Asano) - Shifted ground inwards over the concluding stages inconveniencing PERFECT MOMENT passing the 50 metres.

PERFECT MOMENT (T Comignaghi) - Inconvenienced passing the 50 metres.

Race 4 JOHNNY FRESH DARFIELD & YALDHURST HANDICAP 1400m

SAVVY BOY (D Montes de Oca) - Slow away.

LOCKDOWN LEGACY (T Moseley) - Slow away.

LA RAPIDE (B Murray) - Jumped away awkwardly.

CHEEKINI (K Hannan) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

SELFIE (G Jogoo) - Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages after jumping from the outside barrier. Steadied to avoid the heels of JACK ATTACK (C Campbell) which shifted inwards near the 1100 metres. C Campbell was advised to exercise greater care.

JACK ATTACK (C Campbell) - Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages after jumping from a wide barrier.

AUNT CINDY (R Mudhoo) - Raced three wide without cover.

DOUBTFUL SOUND (L Sutherland) - Raced wide throughout.

SHOW BAZZ (K Asano) - Lay inwards under pressure in the straight.

Race 5 NAUTICAL INSURANCE GRAND NATIONAL AMATEUR CHAMPS 2200m

ALLASERA (H Hassman) - Slow away.

KHAFEEF (S MacNab) - Raced keenly in the early stages with the saddle shifting forward, severely disadvantaging the rider for the remainder of the race.

ECCELLENZA (L Kennedy) - Raced wide from the 1400 metres.

HILLERSDEN (E Woller) - Raced keenly when sitting outside the leader in the middle stages. Bumped near the 400 metres.

DEVIL IN DISGUISE (A Frye) - Held up rounding the final bend and when shifting in to find clear running made contact with HILLERSDEN passing the 400 metres.

DAME COUNTY (T Solomon) - Rider dropped his whip near the 100 metres.

DEMAND RESPECT (M Northcott) - Rider reported the gelding had been disappointing, with the only excuse being having to carry the top weight allocated today.

Race 6 BETAVET MAIDEN 1200m

The start of this race was delayed approximately five minutes as a result of **LUVNWAR** escaping riderless during the preliminary, followed by **SNORKEL** proving difficult to load.

LUVNWAR (K Williams) - Dislodged its rider during the preliminary and escaped riderless taking some time to be recaptured. LOVNWAR was declared a late scratching at 2.13pm. Rider K Williams was attended to by St John personnel and stood down from her two remaining rides due to some back soreness.

SNORKEL (C Campbell) - Proved very reluctant to load with connections advised that a barrier manners warning would be placed against the gelding. Steadied to avoid heels passing the 1000 metres. Lay inwards in the straight and was unable to be fully ridden out as a result.

ATAAHUAWHATADREAM (T Moseley) - Slow away.

STEVIE NIX (K Hercock) - Slow away.

POUTINI ROSE (G Jogoo) - Steadied shortly after the start to avoid the heels of FAYTINA which shifted in.

PEACE LOVER (K Asano) - Crowded near the 200 metres having to steady after FRENCH ROSE and WAR COURT both shifted ground.

A Balloo (FAYTINA) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount FAYTINA to shift inwards near the 1000 metres when insufficiently clear of SNORKEL which had to be steadied away from heels.

Race 7 NZB READY TO RUN SALE TRAINERS SERIES 1200m

Trainer **S Marsh** (MISS NICO BELLE) - Fined \$100 under the Minor Infringement Schedule after presenting MISS NICO BELLE without notified gear (blinkers).

THE BOLD LOOK (D Tait) - Jumped away awkwardly hampering PLATINUM ROAD.

PLATINUM ROAD (K Hercock) - Jumped away awkwardly then being further hampered by THE BOLD LOOK and losing ground.

MUMBO JUMBO (R Mudhoo) - Jumped away awkwardly.

OH NO NO NO (L Douglas) - Slow to begin. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the run home.

CHARBANO (J Doyle) - Crowded leaving the barriers. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

JUSTANACE (L Callaway) - Raced fiercely when being restrained to take cover passing the 1000 metres.

RADIANT ROSIE (Y Atchamah) - Rider dropped the whip passing the 400 metres.

SOOO DUSTY (T Moseley) - Briefly held up early in the run home.

RED VIENNA (K Asano) - Lay in throughout the run home having to be straightened passing the 50 metres.

MEGALOMANIAC (L Allpress) - Was inclined to lay in over the concluding stages. Rider reported the saddle had shifted forward passing the 800 metres placing her in some difficulty.

RUSSIAN ROSETTE (D Montes de Oca) - The saddle shifted forward during the running placing the rider at a disadvantage.

MISS NICO BELLE (C Barnes) - Rider reported the mare may be better ridden with cover.

Race 8 HAASE MARSHALL DRAINAGE HANDICAP 2200m

WIND IN MY WINGS (K Hannan) - Slow to begin.

PROSERVE (T Comignaghi) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground. Lay in passing the 300 metres having to be corrected by its rider.

HAIL DAMAGE (T Moseley) - Raced keenly in the early to middle stages. Held up entering the straight near the 400 metres, then having to be checked when improving onto heels near the 250 metres and going to the line untested by its rider.

GLORIFIED (L Allpress) - Held up early in the straight shifting outwards across heels to obtain clear running near the 300 metres.

MISS TAVI (K Hercock) - Was dismounted on pulling up, with the horse ambulance and course Veterinarian both in quick attendance. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed the mare to have suffered an injury to the off-fore tendon, being transported by the horse ambulance to the Canterbury Equine Clinic for further treatment. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to MISS TAVI racing next. Stewards will follow up in coming days.

Race 9 HOTELIERS CHALLENGE HANDICAP 1400m

BLUEY'S CHANCE (A Balloo) - Slow away.

NAVALHA (L Allpress) - Slow away. Rider reported the gelding had felt indifferent in its action over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed moderate muscle tie up. Stewards will follow up in coming days.

TANNAHILL (K Hannan) - Slow away.

MISS CARTIER (H McNeill) - Jumped away awkwardly. When asked to comment on the performance, the rider advised that after being slow to begin he got further back than he wanted and the mare had then failed to respond to his riding in the run home and had been disappointing.

DEAR OH DEAR (L Callaway) - Raced three wide without cover.

MAKE BELIEVE (C Barnes) - Retired from the race near the 500 metres, being immediately attended to by the course Veterinarian and humanely euthanised after being found to have suffered a catastrophic fracture to the near front leg.

Race 10 RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE 1600m

THE ARCTIC BLAST (T Moseley) - Jumped away awkwardly crowding WAY ABOVE.

WAY ABOVE (L Sutherland) - Crowded leaving the barriers losing ground. Raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 200 metres.

DA VINCI GIRL (K Hercock) - Slow away.

LAGERFELD (A Balloo) - Slow away.

CEDDY SMITH (D Montes de Oca) - Raced wide without cover. Lay in under pressure in the straight.

PEUT RESPIRER (K Asano) - Raced wide without cover.

POVERTY BAY (R Mudhoo) - Over raced in the middle stages having to be firmly restrained to avoid heels near the 700 metres. When asked to comment on performance, rider was of the opinion the gelding had failed to see out the distance of today's race.
