RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 | **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES MAIDEN RACE 1550**

KAAPTIVATING (J Fawcett) - Connections were advised that a warning would be placed against the filly's barrier manners.

BUBBLE TROUBLE (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin. Briefly held up entering the final straight.

JOYOLA (W Kennedy) – Slow to begin.

HIGH CURRENCY (K Asano) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

ALBAZINGA (L Satherley) – Raced wide until improving to lead near the 900 metres.

OVER THE MOON (S Spratt) - Raced wide without cover from the 900 metres.

ELUSIVE EMPIRE (J Kamaruddin) - Reared as the start was initiated, losing ground (4L). Connections were advised that a warning would be placed against the gelding's barrier manners.

PATTON (K Asano) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

STYLISH OFFICER (L Satherley) - Over-raced in the early stages. Made the turn near the 1000 metres awkwardly. Raced wide without cover until passing the 800 metres.

ALBY PARK (J Bayliss) – Briefly steadied approaching the 200 metres when racing in restricted room on the outside of POW WOW and the inside of MR BIGGLESWORTH which had shifted in slightly. Rider reported that the gelding travelled well but resented the kickback in the home straight.

RUSAVY (K Hannan) - Improved into restricted room over the concluding stages with the rider unable to fully test the gelding to the line. Stewards questioned rider K Hannan in the presence of N Harris regarding her ride over the concluding stages with her explanation being that RANGER shifted out when placed under pressure over the concluding stages and as a consequence inconvenienced the geldings run in the final stages of the race.

RANGER (B Rogerson) – Laid out when placed under pressure over the concluding stages.

LOUISIANA MAN (M McNab) - When questioned regarding the performance rider reported that the gelding did not back up from last week's race.

ANELA (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin, losing ground.

ICE COLD GOLD (J Bayliss) - Began awkwardly, losing ground. Made the turn leaving the 1000 metres awkwardly running out and away from other runners. Refused to settle for its rider throughout the race. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed against the gelding's racing manners.

IMPULSE CONTROL (K Asano) – Crowded at the start.

WONKYDONKEY (L Satherley) – Crowded at the start.

NIGELLA LANE (B Rogerson) - Had to be steadied near the 1100 metres when LHASA was dictated inwards by CATCH MY DRIFT. Over-raced for a considerable distance after having to be steadied. Made the turn entering the home straight awkwardly. Had to be steadied off heels in the home straight when looking for clear racing room.

MAGGIE RUTH (M McNab) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

CATCH MY DRIFT (K Hannan) - Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. Following a veterinary inspection CATCH MY DRIFT was confirmed to have bled. CATCH MY DRIFT shall not be ridden in exercise for a period

of two months or start in any race or trial for a period of 3 months and then only then after a gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a veterinarian.

K Hannan (CATCH MY DRIFT) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she allowed her mount CATCH MY DRIFT to shift in when insufficiently clear of WONKYDONKEY and IMPULSE CONTROL which had to be steadied, with NIGELLA LANE being steadied and hampered as a result near the 1100 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of K Hannan's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 25 February up to and including racing on Saturday 4 March, 4 national riding days.

SYMPHONY (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin. Hampered passing the 1100 metres being forced wider on the track.

LOT'S OF TORQUE (J Bayliss) – Briefly steadied passing the 1100 metres when PEPE PEPERONI shifted in. When questioned regarding the performance rider reported that the gelding did not handle today's surface. Laid in when placed under pressure over the concluding stages.

TELLURIAN (M McNab) - Raced keenly in the middle stages. When questioned regarding the performance rider was unable to offer any excuse.

ELUSIVE NATION (K Hannan) – Held up in the home straight until approaching the 100 metres.

SEAMSEW (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover throughout.

TREAT DAPAINTER (C Barnes) - Slow to begin.

MACFIRE (L Satherley) - When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the gelding would benefit from today's race experience.

JIMMY DEAN (K Asano) – Restrained from its wide barrier at the start.

CALL ME FLINT (W Kennedy) - Began awkwardly.

STRATTY'S WAY (B Rogerson) – Crowded at the start. Contacted by another rider's whip entering the home straight.

SIDE HUSTLE (C Zackey) - Raced wide until improving to sit outside the leader passing the 1500 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the mare had felt indifferent in its action. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no significant findings.

POSTER BOY (T Mitchell) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

REET PETITE (S Spratt) - Raced four wide without cover from the 1200 metres to near the 800 metres.
