Race 3 CAMBRIDGE EQUINE HOSPITAL 1550

PIZZAZZ (M McNab) – Co-trainer R Wellwood advised Stewards that the mare revealed no irregularities in the days post-race. They will continue with her preparation.

Race 4 MARTIN COLLINS NEW ZEALAND MAAT 1300

AVAYA (J Doyle) – Co-trainer C Murray advised Stewards that the mare pulled up fine in the days post-race and that AVAYA has now been sent for a spell.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 WAIPA EARTHWORKS MAIDEN 1550

KRIMINAL (W Kennedy) - Slow to begin.

GEE VEE CRYSTAL (V Colgan) - Restrained at the start from its wide barrier.

DONUT (S Spratt) - Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained. Lay in rounding the final bend.

PEPE PEPERONI (L Satherley) - Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained.

COMPOSURE (T Thornton) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

VITALITY (K Hannan) - Raced wide without cover throughout. When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

MS CANDEE LANE (J Doyle) - Held up early in the final straight.

WOLF MOON (B Grylls) - Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

Race 2 CAMBRIDGE EQUINE HOSPITAL 1550

KOOLASCUZ (V Colgan) - Slow to begin.

GOODO JO (S Spratt) – Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

FAY KHAN IT (M McNab) - Briefly steadied when racing in restricted room to the outside of SONOFABUTCHER entering the final straight.

Race 3 MAJESTIC HORSE FLOATS MAIDEN 1300

ZIGANI (J Doyle) - Slow to begin.

STYLISH RED (M Sanson) – Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

THE ARCHITECT (T Newman) - Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained. Held up until near the 100 metres.

YESTERDAY'S GONE (A Goindasamy) – Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

MARMAC BOY (M McNab) – Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

HADID (S Spratt) – Came together with GOOD BROTHERS over the concluding stages.

Race 4 PRYDE'S EASIFEED 1300

KEATS (C Lindsay) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

E Nicholas (GUNNAR) - Issued with a warning in that she used her whip with an action which raised the rider's arm above shoulder height.

Race 5 | **KINGSCLERE STABLES 970**

SUPER WARRIOR (C Lindsay) - Began awkwardly. Over-raced in the early stages. Raced wide without cover throughout.

COTE DE BEAUNE (W Kennedy) - Slow to begin.

GOLDBURG (M McNab) - Crowded shortly after the start.

AOIDE (K Hannan) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

FARRAVALLO (S Weatherley) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

OTTAVIO (S Spratt) - Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. Following a veterinary examination OTTAVIO was confirmed to have bled. OTTAVIO shall not be ridden in exercise for a period of two months or start in any race or trial for a period of three months, and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a Veterinarian. Connections advised Stewards that the gelding would now be retired from racing.

Race 6 | **NZ HORSE AMBULANCE MAIDEN 970**

TAILORED (E Nicholas) – Escaped under the front of its barrier stall before being recaptured. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was declared a late scratching at 3.29 pm. Connections were advised that the gelding would be required to barrier trial the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

HIGHGRASS (W Kennedy) - Slow to begin.

MARY ELIZABETH (K Hannan) - Began awkwardly.

SWEET TALKING (S Spratt) – Over-raced in the early stages. Inconvenienced approaching the 200 metres when TOOTIE shifted out abruptly.

ROZEL (J Doyle) - Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

MIVIRGO (M McNab) – Inconvenienced approaching the 200 metres when SWEET TALKING was dictated outwards.

TOOTIE (V Colgan) - Raced greenly in the home straight.

T Moodley (STAR TRAIL) - Admitted a charge in that he was unable to make the declared weight on STAR TRAIL. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a fine of \$100 under the minor infringement schedule.

Following the running of this race, connections of the 2nd placed runner SWEET TALKING viewed Stewards footage before electing not to proceed with a protest against the winner TOOTIE.

Race 7 | **SADDLERY WAREHOUSE MAIDEN 2000**

BLUSHING RUDOLF (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin.

JIVETALKIN (T Newman) - Slow to begin.

ESTELLA KHAN (K Bakker) - Raced keenly in the early stages having to be steadied away from heels near the 1500 metres.

PENURIOUS (W Kennedy) - Lay out rounding the final turn and continued to do so in the straight when placed under pressure.
