Race 8 - 19 AUG CAMBRIDGE STUD NORTHLAND BREEDER'S STAKES 2100

MISCHIEF MANAGED (M McNab) - Co-Trainer K Rae advised Stewards that the mare had pulled up fine and will be continuing with her preparation.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 SVS STARTING GATES MAIDEN 2100

PEANUTBUTTERFALCON (M Hashizume) - Slow to begin.

CADA CAMINO (B Rogerson) – Began awkwardly contacting TEMPEST KHAN. Raced three wide without cover until near the 1200 metres.

TEMPEST KHAN (D Cooper) – Contacted by CADA CAMINO shortly after the start becoming unbalanced.

ASTILLA (E Nicholas) – Had to be steadied leaving the home straight on the first occasion when TYNESIDER shifted outwards when over-racing.

TYNESIDER (N Parmar) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

MIDDLE KHAN (M Sanson) - Raced three wide without cover for a majority of the race. Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 400 metres to the outside of PENURIOUS which shifted out slightly. W Kennedy was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.

SMUG (K Asano) - Raced wide without cover from near the 1100 metres.

PREFERENTIAL (V Colgan) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

STASH (O Bosson) – Held up for clear running until approaching the 150 metres.

NYAH (S Weatherley) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that after being pressured for a position outside the leader in the early and middle stages the mare had failed to respond when placed under pressure.

Race 2 LODGE REAL ESTATE MILE 1600

HOT SALSA (N Parmar) – Began awkwardly contacting ESS VEE ARE.

ESS VEE ARE (J Allen) – Contacted by HOT SALSA shortly after the start, losing ground. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding would benefit from improved track conditions and a step up in distance.

EL NYMPH (L Satherley) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

MAHRAJAAN (K Asano) - Over-raced in the middle stages.

Race 3 SKYCITY HAMILTON WAIKATO CUP DAY 16 DECEMBER 1400

CASINO PRINCESS (E Nicholas) - Slow to begin.

ANNA GRACE (N Parmar) - Slow to begin.

HIGHLIGHTER (S Spratt) – Over-raced in the middle stages when leading.

REDMOND (O Bosson) – Over-raced in the early stages. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding had made abnormal breathing noises when pulling up. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination including an endoscopic examination which revealed a minor laceration to the left foreleg.

C'EST MOI (W Kennedy) - Crowded shortly after the finish between **ELECTRIC TIME** and **CASINO PRINCESS** which both shifted ground. Both D Cooper and E Nicholas were advised to exercise care.

Race 4 | **FAIRVIEW MOTORS MAIDEN 1400**

IMPAIRED VISION (L Satherley) - Slow to begin.

LUCKY CHARM (T Newman) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground, then raced ungenerously shortly after.

SUPER SCHEME (J Allen) - Began awkwardly then contacted becoming unbalanced, losing ground.

GIBRALTAR RISING (B Rogerson) – Crowded shortly after the start.

MAJOR MAJOR (T Harris) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

TURNAROUND (V Colgan) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Had to be steadied near the 450 metres.

BONNIE ISLAY (E Nicholas) – Raced wide throughout.

POUR SUM MOUR (D Cooper) - Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

S Spratt (ANELA) - Reminded of her obligations in that she must ride her mounts out fully to the end of the race when circumstances permit her to do so.

T Harris (MAJOR MAJOR) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift in when not sufficiently clear of **TURNAROUND** which had to be steadied near the 450 metres.

O Bosson (THE DIVINER & HOT PINX) - Issued with a minor infringement notice after being unable to make the weight on **THE DIVINER** and **HOT PINX** with the Adjudicator imposing a fine of \$200.

Race 5 | **WAIKATO DRAUGHT 1200**

KA YING LUCKY (O Bosson) - Over-raced in the early stages.

DIGNITOSA (N Parmar) - Raced keenly when being steadied through the middle stages.

WHOSHE'S GIRL (V Jalalkuncha) - Raced wide without cover until near the 500 metres when working forward to sit outside the leader.

Race 6 | **WAIKATO STUD FOXBRIDGE PLATE DAY 26 AUGUST 1200**

LINGJUN HERO (K Asano) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced wide throughout. Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

DEEBEE ZAPOWER (N Parmar) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

FONTEYN (T Newman) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Race 7	DUNSTAN HORSEFEEDS 2100
<p>BRIAN LAMONT (N Parmar) – Crowded shortly after the start. Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 1650 metres.</p> <p>LATE TO THE PARTY (W Kennedy) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>NASSAK DIAMOND (K Asano) – Raced four wide without cover from near the 1600 metres.</p> <p>IN A PICKLE (B Rogerson) - Over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>NASHA RIVA (K Hannan) - Checked near the 1650 metres.</p> <p>IN A PICKLE (B Rogerson) – When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding would benefit from more rain affected footing.</p> <p>V Colgan (HOT PINX) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he angled his mount inwards when not sufficiently clear of BRIAN LAMONT which was forced inwards checking NASHA RIVA near the 1650 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of V Colgan’s licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 16 August up to and including racing on Thursday 24 August, 5 national riding days.</p>	
Race 8	GOOD LUCK ONE NZ WARRIORS MILE 1600
<p>KAIMAI QUEEN (N Parmar) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>SO GORGEOUS (S Spratt) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>LEX REX (T Thornton) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>LA PALMA (L Satherley) - Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>MAGIC ACE (W Kennedy) - Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 450 metres after improving to the inside of SO GORGEOUS which became awkwardly placed on the heels of the weakening KORO’S PRINCESS. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding had not travelled comfortably throughout and had not responded when placed under pressure. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.</p> <p>HIT THE SWITCH (E Nicholas) – Lay in over the concluding stages when placed under pressure.</p> <p>T Thornton (LEX REX) - Issued with a warning for raising her arm above shoulder height on two occasions approaching the 50 metres.</p> <p>S Spratt (SO GORGEOUS) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift in when not sufficiently clear of MAGIC ACE which had to be steadied near the 450 metres.</p>
