<b>Race 1</b>	<b>TARANAKI/WHANGANUI BREEDERS MAIDEN HURDLE 3100</b>

**PEANUTBUTTERFALCON** (H McNeill) – Restrained at the start after beginning awkwardly and then lost ground at each fence when jumping awkwardly throughout.

**PRINCE TURBO** (D Parker) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

**WAIAGARA** (J Power) - Was inclined to run down its fences throughout. Lost the left front plate during the running.

**DRUMSTORM** (G Walsh) – Jumped the last fence in the back straight on the final round awkwardly, losing ground.

**TORQUE TIME** (M Cropp) – Had to be angled inwards abruptly after jumping the last fence in order to improve.

**S Fannin** (MR BEANS THE NAME) - Issued with a warning after using the whip in two consecutive strides on MR BEANS THE NAME near the 25 metres with Stewards taking into account his clear recent record with regard to a breach of this rule.

<b>Race 2</b>	<b>HAWERA WELDING CONTRACTORS MAIDEN HURDLE 3100</b>

**SPEED CALL** (S Karnicnik) - Shifted in abruptly prior to jumping the first fence dislodging rider S Karnicnik who required treatment by Paramedics. Hampered in this incident were MONT VENTOUX, STATIC, SHOCKING PENNY and SWEET TABOO. As a result, the field was diverted around the fence near the 1200 metres on the second occasion. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality. S Karnicnik was stood down from his remaining rides and advised a medical clearance would be required prior to riding next.

**MONT VENTOUX** (M Roustoby) - Hampered after jumping the first fence.

**SHOCKING PENNY** (E Farr) - Hampered after jumping the first fence. Hampered when jumping the second fence by the riderless horse.

**STATIC** (D Parker) - Hampered after jumping the first fence. Hampered when jumping the second fence by the riderless horse. Came under pressure some distance out and slowed noticeably at the fence near the 1000 metres prior to being pulled out of the race in the home straight and did not finish.

**SWEET TABOO** (H McNeill) - Hampered after jumping the first fence. Hampered when jumping the second fence by the riderless horse. Hampered by the riderless horse when jumping the third fence.

**GALILEO INVADER** (J Power) - Hampered when jumping the second fence by the riderless horse.

**ONEZEDBEE** (M Cropp) - Put in a poor jump at the second fence.

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>ZED @ GRANGEWILLIAM STUD HURDLE 3100</b>

Due to there being no suitable replacement rider for S Karnicnik, LORD SPENCER was late scratched by Stewards at 12.35 pm.

**SMUG** (M Roustoby) – Stewards accepted the explanation from trainer C Wood regarding his late declaration of rider.

**BANKS ROAD** (B Lammas) – Slow to begin. Raced wide throughout.

**OBRIGADO** (D Parker) - Retired from the race from near the 800 metres when well back and out of contention. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding would benefit from some easing in the ground. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to be mildly lame in both forelegs consistent with having jarred up.

**HARRY HARRISON** (M Cropp) – Blundered after jumping the second to last fence.

**METALLO** (H McNeill) – Landed awkwardly at the second to last fence after making contact with the inside wing.

**IAN'S LEGACY** (J Power) - Misjudged the second to last fence. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the gelding to have suffered a tendon injury to the left foreleg. Connections were advised a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.

**J Power** (IAN'S LEGACY) - Issued with a warning for raising his arm above shoulder height when using the whip near the 50 metres.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>CHILLCO REFRIGERATION STEEPLECHASE 3900</b>

Due to there being no suitable replacement rider for S Karnicnik, DUCK ROAD was late scratched by Stewards at 1.00 pm.

**AULD JOCK** (J Power) - Misjudged the fence near the 1000 metres and fell, dislodging rider J Power who was immediately attended to by Paramedics and stood down from his remaining ride. J Power was advised a medical clearance would be required prior to riding next. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

**BLACK EYED SUE** (E Farr) – Had to take evasive action to avoid the fallen runner near the 1000 metres and shifted out abruptly into the line of POITIN which was taken out over extra ground.

**KENTUCKY BOY** (P Matthews) - Hampered when trying to avoid the fallen runner near the 1000 metres.

**QUAFF** (M Roustoby) – Retired from the race when well back and out of contention near the 600 metres.

**PLUSHENKO** (G Walsh) - Mixed its jumping throughout and was retired from the race near the 400 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

<b>Race 5</b>	<b>GARDEN EDGE STEEPLECHASE 3900</b>

This race ran approximately 3 minutes late due to the runners being late into the enclosure.

**ZAMORA** (G Walsh) – Inclined to run its fences down in the early and middle stages. Retired from the race prior to jumping the second to last fence when well back and out of contention. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

**COUNTRY BUMPKIN** (P Matthews) – Made contact with the running rail leaving the home straight on the last round.

**MONDORANI** (D Parker) - Landed awkwardly after jumping the second to last fence.

**IZYMYDAAD** (M Cropp) – Retired from the race prior to jumping the second to last fence when well back and out of contention. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

**S Fannin** (MONDORANI) - Issued with a minor infringement and fined \$100 for failing to make the declared weight on MONDORANI. S Fannin was replaced by D Parker.

**Race 6** | **FLAIR DAFFODIL DAY AMATEUR RIDERS 2100**

**KOOLASCUZ** (H Fleming) - Stood in the barrier and refused to jump away. Connections were advised the gelding would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

**HAMISH** (A Scott) - Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

**RUN JAKKO RUN** (S MacNab) - Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

**CAPTAINWINKLETOES** (H Hassman) - Raced ungenerously in the early stages when being steadied.

**LOCHWINNOCH** (E Quinn) – Inclined to get its head in the air near the winning post on the first round.

**HEY HEY HEY** (A Frye) - Had to shift outwards off the heels of LOCHWINNOCH near the winning post on the first round.

**GO BUTCH** (K Singh) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

**SAILOR JACK** (L Olsen) - Raced three wide without cover until near the 800 metres.

**Race 7** | **GRANGEWILLIAM STUD BREEDER'S STAKES SATURDAY 7<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER 1600**

**SACRED PEARL** (L Sutherland) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

**LLANACORD** (L Hemi) - Came together for several strides with KOPIUA when CIAMBELLA shifted out when making the home turn awkwardly.

**Race 8** | **JOHNNY NEIL BUILDER LTD 1200**

**O'RIORDAN** (J Chung) - Slow to begin.

**WHISKEY NEAT** (J Riddell) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**MY ZOI** (E Nicholas) - Steadied near the 950 metres. Held up for some distance rounding the home turn, having to be restrained off heels.

**N Hailey** (IS THAT SO) - Reminded of his obligation in that he must ride his mounts out to the end of the race when circumstances permit him to do so.

**C Lindsay** (CATSACHARMER) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of MY ZOI which had to be steadied approaching the 950 metres.

**Race 9** | **HEATHER D. YAXLEY MARTINEZ MAIDEN 1400**

**TAMBERI** (C Lindsay) - Began very awkwardly and settled well back. Connections were advised the gelding would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

**OPAL SPIRIT** (J Chung) - Steadied when racing in restricted room towards the end of the back straight.

**BAULETTO** (H McNeill) – Raced keenly when being steadied to obtain cover approaching the 1000 metres.

**LADY HIKA** (L Allpress) – Raced wide throughout.

**SPIELBERG** (J Riddell) – When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no excuse.

**Race 10** | **RACING NEXT SATURDAY OCTOBER 7<sup>TH</sup> 1400**

**SHE'S MISS GEVIOUS** (L Hemi) - Slow to begin.

**BOURBON FALLS** (J Riddell) - Began awkwardly.

**HUNGRY** (J Chung) – Over-raced in the early to middle stages.

**LIBRARS** (A Bohorun) - Steadied when placed in restricted room for a distance passing the 1200 metres.

**BOZO** (L Sutherland) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.
