Race 10 - LIVAMOL - INTERNATIONAL ANIMAL HEALTH PRODUCTS PREMIER 1600m

Stable foreperson T Riddell reported that following a veterinary examination which was clear, the condition of WHITE NOISE deteriorated markedly with the gelding becoming distressed. WHITE NOISE subsequently received further veterinary attention. T Riddell was requested to inform Stewards of the gelding's progress over coming days. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance is required prior to WHITE NOISE racing again.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 TOTAL TRANSPORT MAIDEN 1200m

HIGH FIVE (J Parkes) - Declared a late scratching at 12.33pm after refusing to load. As a result the start of this race was delayed approximately 4 minutes. Connections were advised that HIGH FIVE would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to racing next.

INCREDIBLE (E Nicholas) - Began awkwardly and then improved to the inside of BODACIOUS KATE which was racing to the inside of SWISS BELT and was then checked when both those runners shifted ground inwards. After questioning riders and viewing available footage which proved inadequate, no further action was taken.

ENTITLEMENT (K Hercock) - Restrained to the rear on jumping from a wide barrier draw.

FOREIGN AFFAIR (K Asano) - Raced wide throughout.

SWISS BELT (C Lindsay) - Raced greenly near the 800 metres.

NO RAIN EVER (C Grylls) - Raced greenly over the concluding stages.

Race 2 ENTAIN – NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES MAIDEN RACE 1200m

BOW STREET (J Chung) - Declared a late scratching at 1.04pm on veterinary advice at the barriers after becoming fractious and charging the barrier. As a result the start of this race was delayed approximately 4 minutes. Connections were advised that BOW STREET would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to racing next.

IMA BRAZEN ONE (K Asano) - Raced greenly through the early stages. Lay in over the concluding stages.

OUR SASSIE ANNE (C Grylls) - Raced wide through the early and middle stages.

CHEVEUX (J Riddell) - Raced wide throughout.

MONARDO (L Douglas) - Rider reported that after being steadied from its wide draw the mare had got further back than he intended after racing greenly.

Race 3 WANGANUI MOTORS 1200m

BOSTON STRONG BOY (E Nicholas) - Began awkwardly. Raced wide through the early and middle stages.

MERMAID (K Hercock) - Began awkwardly hampering ARCADIAN LYNX and HAVARTI. When questioned, rider confirmed the mare had hung badly throughout and could not be ridden out fully in the final straight. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed on MERMAID's racing manners. Trainer S Wilson advised Stewards the mare would now be spelled.

ARCADIAN LYNX (J Parkes) - Hampered at the start losing ground.

HAVARTI (M Hudson) - Hampered at the start. Performed below market expectations. When questioned the rider could offer no tangible excuse.

IMARICHGIRL (L Allpress) - Over raced having to be steadied passing the 800 metres.

Race 4 ANDREWS CONTRACTING & NEIL LIVESTOCK AGENT MAIDEN 1400m

LES BOOTS (L Allpress) - Slow away. Performed below market expectations. When questioned, rider advised the gelding had pulled up in a normal post-race condition and she had no excuse.

JUST A NUDGE (M Singh) - Momentarily held up rounding the final bend.

Race 5 WANGANUI INSURANCE BROKERS MAIDEN 1650m

KNOCK OFF (L Allpress) - Raced wide for the majority of the event and taken forward towards the end of the back straight. Rider advised the gelding had lay inwards rounding the final bend and in her opinion would be better suited to a shorter distance.

COMEDY (J Riddell) - Returned to the birdcage with blood present in its mouth consistent with having bitten its tongue through the tongue tie.

RISING RULER (C Grylls) - Finished last. When questioned regarding performance, rider advised in his opinion the gelding is better suited to more rain affected going. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 6 WAVERLEY HARVESTING & BLADE HEDGE CUTTING MAIDEN 1650m

ROULADE (K Asano) - Slow away.

OUR LADY BROOKE (E Nicholas) - Slow away.

OPAL SPIRIT (J Chung) - Slow away.

LADDIE BOY (C Grylls) - Over raced through the early and middle stages.

KAWATIRI (C Dell) - Checked entering the back straight inconveniencing SOUND TRACK.

SOUND TRACK (K Hercock) - Inconvenienced entering the back straight.

MCDREAMY (M Hudson) - Lay in having to be straightened near the 250 metres.

L Allpress (TSHIEBWE) - Defended a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount TSIEBWE to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of KAWATIRI which was checked entering the back straight. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of L Allpress's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 16 September until the conclusion of racing on Friday 22 September, 4 national riding days.

Race 7 STELFORMERS ROOFING KIWI MEMORIAL WAVERLEY CUP 2200m

SEMPER MAGICO (K Asano) - Over raced through the early stages.

JERRICOOP (J Chung) - Raced wide for the majority of the event.

KINGFISHER LAD (L Sutherland) - Held up having to angle across heels to obtain clear racing room passing the 200 metres.

MAUNA LOA (L Allpress) - Held up when attempting a narrow run which did not fully develop near the 300 metres and was then in restricted room and unable to improve for some distance inside the 100 metres, going to the line not fully tested.

Race 8 TONY WILSON LIVESTOCK LTD & C R GRACE LTD 2200m

HARDTIMES (M Singh) - Began awkwardly.

MONKEY TOWN (T Taiaroa) - Raced wide throughout.

MOMENTS LIKE THESE (L Allpress) - Held up rounding the final bend.

ALL IN BLACKBERRY (J Chung) - Held up for clear racing room until inside the final 100 metres having to angle inwards inconveniencing TICKFORD near the finish.

TICKFORD (K Hercock) - Inconvenienced over the concluding stages.

J Chung (ALL IN BLACKBERRY) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount ALL IN BLACKBERRY to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of TICKFORD which was inconvenienced over the concluding stages.

Race 9 SUMMIT ELECTRICAL MAIDEN 2200m

THINK AHEAD (C Dell) - Began awkwardly. Held up when attempting a marginal run behind the tiring SUNSET SAM over the concluding stages.

MOSSRAAJ (L Douglas) - Began awkwardly.

TWOOUTATHREE (M Hudson) - Began awkwardly bumping OVERAGAIN.

OVERAGAIN (L Sutherland) - Bumped at the start.

EL ATTITUDE (T Davies) - Raced wide throughout.

VERARDINO (J Riddell) - Held up rounding the final bend.
