Race 7 HBPB THOROUGHBRED BREEDERS ASSN GOLD TRAIL STAKES (G3) 1200m

FULL TILT (J Doyle) – Trainer Mr. A Forsman advised Stewards, that upon return to the stable the filly was examined by two veterinarians with no abnormalities being detected by either veterinarian. A Forsman further advised FULL TILT has now been sent for a spell.

Race 8 WORLDS BEST SPRINTER - LUCKY SWEYNESSE PREMIER 1400m

ONE DREAM ONE SOUL (L Allpress) – Trainer Mr. L Somervell reported to Stewards, he examined the mare on return to his stable, where he found a nail, which was then extracted from ONE DREAM ONE SOUL'S near front foot. L Somervell further advised the mare has continued with light track work and at this stage will look to nominate ONE DREAM ONE SOUL for the second day at the Hawke's Bay Spring Carnival.

Race 9 WESTBURY STUD TARZINO TROPHY (G1) 1400m

LICKETY SPLIT (L Allpress) – Trainer Mr. A Forsman advised LICKETY SPLIT has been retired from racing and will be sent to stud.

Race 10 LIVAMOL – INTERNATIONAL ANIMAL HEALTH PRODUCTS PREMIER 1600m

WHITE NOISE (J Doyle) – Trainer Mr. A Forsman reported that upon return to his stable WHITE NOISE underwent a veterinary examination which included blood test, with results showing the gelding to have tied-up. A Forsman further advised that after the gelding had become distressed post-race, WHITE NOISE has recovered well, and at this stage will carry on with the gelding's preparation.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 MAJESTIC HORSE FLOATS MAIDEN 1400m

DASH OF RED (J Chung) - Began awkwardly, then contacted, losing ground. Checked near the 600 metres when BINIKA (C Lindsay) shifted in when not fully clear. When questioned rider reported that after receiving interference the gelding had failed to respond when placed under pressure. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

LAS RAMBLAS (J Riddell) - Began awkwardly making contact with JESTIN CASE, and as a result lost ground.

SCHUSKI (M Singh) - Began awkwardly contacting DASH OF RED.

JESTIN CASE (L Allpress) - Contacted then hampered at the start when LAS RAMBLAS shifted out.

PRADASPHERE (K Hercock) - Slow to begin. Held up through the early stages of the final straight.

LOOSE MONEY (L Sutherland) - Made contact with LOVEHELEN on two occasions passing the 100 metres.

LOVEHELEN (C Dell) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout. Made contact with LOOSE MONEY on two occasions passing the 100 metres.

C Lindsay (BINIKA) - C Lindsay, in the presence of the Apprentice Mentor, admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted BINIKA to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of DASH OF RED, which was checked near the 600 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of her licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 23 September, until the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 30 September, 5 national riding days.

Race 2 PYRAMID TRUCKING 1400m

DERRYAIRE (M McNab) - Slow to begin.

SUSIE JANE (E Nicholas) - Slow to begin. Had to shift ground inwards passing the 100 metres when GUM BASHER (M Hudson) lay outwards under pressure. M Hudson was advised to exercise greater care.

HUNGRY (J Riddell) - Slow to begin.

JUGADOR (C Barnes) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Lay outwards rounding the final bend.

PRINCESSA GOLD (T Davies) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

GUM BASHER (M Hudson) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Lay outwards under pressure passing the 100 metres.

Race 3 MCMILLAN EQUINE FEEDS MAIDEN 1200m

THE STOLEN ONE (C Lindsay) - Proved difficult to load. Made contact with BALLYANE at the start and as a result shifted out and away from that runner, dictating MAGGIE MCMUFFIN and CHENEY wider on the track. Connections were advised a warning has been placed against the barrier manners of THE STOLEN ONE.

BALLYANE (L Allpress) - Contacted at the start. Raced keenly for a distance shortly after the start.

MAGGIE MCMUFFIN (T Davies) - Dictated wider on the track shortly after the start.

MY MAN'S BACK (J Riddell) - Slow to begin.

CHENEY (J Chung) - Dictated wider on the track shortly after the start. Hung outwards rounding the bend near the 800 metres and throughout the final straight.

Race 4 H R JONES LTD CELEBRATING 75 YEARS IN BUSINESS 1200m

GEE STRING (K Hercock) - Became fractious in its barrier and reared as the gates were effected, losing considerable ground. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination with did not reveal any abnormality.

MOCHATINI (L Allpress) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Over-raced and when doing so became awkwardly placed on heels, having to be steadied on a number of occasions throughout the back straight. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in the mare's mouth which was consistent with having a cut to the tongue.

DUNEAGLE (C Dell) - Raced greenly for a distance shortly after the start. Lay outwards rounding the bend near the 600 metres and again on the final bend.

CHARLOTTE'S WAY (J Chung) - When being steadied was placed in restricted room when runners to either side shifted ground shortly after the start. Held up approaching the 400 metres and was unable to obtain clear running until early in the final straight.

BEE ENCHANTED (M McNab) - Lay inwards under pressure throughout the final straight having to be corrected by its rider.

Race 5 FIBER FRESH ACTIVE 1000m

HICKORY JACK (M McNab) - Began awkwardly, making contact with ONE BAD PRINCESS. Over-raced, getting its head up on a number of occasions throughout the back straight. Held up rounding the final bend.

ONE BAD PRINCESS (K Hercock) - Contacted at the start.

BUENOS DIAS (M Singh) - Began awkwardly, shifting outwards dictating runners to its outside wider on the track. Raced three-wide without cover throughout. Raced ungenerously throughout, making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly. Raced greenly throughout the final straight.

RACE ACE (L Allpress) - Dictated wider at the start.

FASHION ICON (T Davies) - Began awkwardly and was then dictated wider and as a result lost ground. Briefly held early in the final straight.

Race 6 RYAL BUSH TRANSPORT MAIDEN 2140m

IZZIE'S BEAU (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin. Contacted and forced wider near the 800 metres.

POROTENE STORM (M McNab) - Slow to begin. Inconvenienced when becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 100 metres.

LICORICE ALLSORTS (M Singh) - From its wide barrier draw was restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start. Improved on to heels and then attempted to shift outwards making contact and forcing IZZIE'S BEAU wider on the track near the 800 metres. M Singh was advised to exercise greater care.

PANIC AND RUN (C Carmine) - Raced three wide without cover through the early stages. Commenced to give ground near the 800 metres and was not persevered with for the remainder of the race. When questioned regarding performance rider advised the gelding had hung outwards throughout the running and in his opinion was not suited to the synthetic track conditions. Trainer B Lammas advised Stewards that in his opinion PANIC AND RUN had failed to see out the 2140 metre distance and will consider a shorter distance for its next start.

KHAN'S CLOWN (K Hercock) - Shifted in abruptly passing the 200 metres. Lay inwards under pressure over the concluding stages. Pulled up noticeably lame and was attended to immediately by the on-course veterinarian with the horse ambulance being deployed. The gelding underwent X-rays on course which revealed a fracture to both of the left fore sesamoids, having to be humanely euthanised.

Race 7 HADLEY SEARLE @ SEAHORSE SUPPLEMENTS 1700m

NEVER LOOK BACK (T Taiaroa) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up throughout the final straight, and when attempting to improve into a marginal run had to steady near the 150 metres when runners to either side shifted ground simultaneously.

BAHIA EMERALD (M McNab) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground when runners to its inside shifted ground.

PASHAMALA (M Singh) - Crowded shortly after the start when WENEEDASHOCK (E Nicholas) shifted in. E Nicholas was advised to exercise care. Lay inwards under pressure throughout the final straight, making contact with SPARTA near the 200 metres and again near the 150 metres.

ALBUFEIRA (J Chung) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout. Lay outwards rounding the final bend and continued to do so throughout the final straight, dictating SPARTA wider passing the 100 metres. J Chung was advised to exercise greater care and straighten his mounts sooner than he did on this occasion.

SPARTA (K Hercock) - Contacted near the 200 metres and again at the 150 metres. Dictated wider passing the 100 metres.
