Race 1 - DAVE GRANT & NEIL KINGSTON MAIDEN 1200m

BORNHOLM (B Murray) -Trainer Miss M Cunneen reported to Stewards that on Monday 9 October BORNHOLM underwent a veterinary examination which included blood tests, with results showing the gelding to have a low white blood cell count. M Cunneen further advised it is her intention to continue on with BORNHOLM'S current preparation and may look to nominate the gelding for the Ashburton RC meeting on Sunday 22 October.

Race 7 - MICHAEL & MATTHEW PITMAN MILE 1600m

HEMI RIDAPEST (T Comignaghi) - Trainer Ms L Latta advised Stewards that the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of the gelding, and it is their intention to continue on with HEMI RIDAPEST'S current preparation.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 VERNON & VAZEY TRUCK PARTS MAIDEN 1600m

BENJI'S BOY (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin.

QUINTABELLE (K Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

CLYDE BARROW (A Lawson-Carroll) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

MY DEGREE (C Barnes) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

TELLME YOU LOVEME (T Comignaghi) - Over raced having to be restrained off heels through the early stages.

WARLAC (D Tait) - Raced three wide without cover through the early and middle stages.

EL CHAPEAU (N Parmar) – Lay out under pressure throughout the final straight.

Race 2 RD PETROLEUM 1400m

FINAL SAVINGS (M Singh) - Slow to begin and was then crowded when runners to either side shifted ground.

MAZZUCATO (N Parmar) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Rider reported that after losing ground at the start he found it difficult to make ground in today's windy conditions.

SHARPIE (J Kamaruddin) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

ABLE WHITE (K Mudhoo) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

VAUDEVIRE (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

HE'S TUNZA GRUNT (T Comignaghi) - Placed in restricted room having to steady near the 1300 metres. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

EREBUS (T Jonker) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

DECISION TIME (K Williams) - When over racing had to be steadied to avoid heels near the 900 metres.

MISS NICO BELLE (T Newman) - When asked to comment on the apparent improved performance, stable representative L Young advised that the mare had 4 weeks between runs and struck an improved track which led to a better performance.

Following the running of this race a number of riders expressed concerns due to the high winds experienced during the race. A meeting of all riders in Race 2 was convened with Stewards and Club Officials, with the decision made to delay racing by one race to monitor the extremely high prevailing winds.

Race 3 CLEM & RUSSELL BRAND MEMORIAL 1400m

The start of this race was rescheduled to 1.10pm, with the following races tentatively put back one race.

DECEPTIO VISUS (T Newman) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Got its head up when over racing in the early stages.

TURF WAR (T Comignaghi) - Began awkwardly.

JUSTA LAD (A Lawson-Carroll) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

MUMBO JUMBO (R Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

VALYRIAN (B Rogerson) - Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover in the early stages.

LADY'S LEGACY (S Muniandy) - Slow to begin and then hampered losing ground.

PONZI PONY (T Jonker) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

LOUISIANA MAN (K Williams) - Crowded at the start losing ground when an outside runner shifted in.

TELEKINETIC (D Montes de Oca) - Was inclined to lay inwards in the run home.

J Kamaruddin (CEDDY SMITH) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount CEDDY SMITH to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of LOUISIANA MAN which was crowded at the start.

Following the running of this race a second meeting was held with all riders in Race 3, with the decision made to abandon today's meeting due to unsafe conditions resulting from the high winds.
