Apprentice E Nicholas did not attend today's meeting after suffering a fractured right ankle at Wingatui on Thursday 19 October.

RACE COMMENTS**Race 1** | **TE RAPA EVENT CENTRE 1400**

LERADO (W Kennedy) - Began awkwardly.

STRINGLINE (A Goindasamy) - Began awkwardly.

PAUL DAVID (C Grylls) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Contacted near the 400 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the gelding had sweated up prior to the race but had been disappointing and could otherwise offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

KAIDU'S PRIDE (A Lawson-Carroll) – Raced three wide without cover.

LINGJUN XIONGFENG (V Colgan) - Held up rounding the final turn making contact with PAUL DAVID when attempting to obtain clear running near the 400 metres.

RIBBONS (J Doyle) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the straight.

GIRLS LIGHT UP (R Elliot) – When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the mare had not been suited by the firmer nature of today's footing and would be better suited by some easing of the ground.

Race 2 | **WAIKATO DRAUGHT 1400**

TARTED UP (B Grylls) - Slow to begin. Held up for a short distance near the 200 metres.

THREE NINETY (A Lawson-Carroll) - Crowded at the start.

JACK IN THE BOX (L Satherley) - Crowded at the start losing ground. Rider reported that the gelding would be better suited by some easing of the ground.

MISS ROCKETTE (W Kennedy) – Raced wide without cover until improving to sit outside the leader near the 800 metres.

CINDY FALLS (J Kamaruddin) - Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race. Failed to respond once placed under pressure in the straight and was eased down over the final 200 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the mare had felt sore in the left foreleg. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the mare to be 1/5 lame in the left foreleg. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.

HASSTOBE PERFECT (V Colgan) – Held up early in the straight having to shift outwards across heels to obtain clear running near the 200 metres.

Following this race, the track was upgraded to Good 3.

<p>ROC UP RALPH (A Lawson-Carroll) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>AMARILLO SLIM (J Kamaruddin) - Began awkwardly. Gave ground quickly near the 700 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the gelding would be better suited by rain affected footing. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.</p> <p>MAGGIE RUTH (B Rogerson) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages when being restrained.</p> <p>JOHNNIE KASTLE (V Colgan) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages when being restrained.</p> <p>EL BANDOLERO (T Moodley) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>SPECIAL PRIVILEGE (J Doyle) - Hampered by the weakening AMARILLO SLIM near the 600 metres.</p> <p>WHAT A CHARMA (J Fawcett) - When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that in her opinion the gelding had not been suited by today’s firmer track conditions.</p> <p>MR FAHRENHEIT (J Allen) - When questioned regarding the improved performance trainer N Quinn advised that the gelding’s only previous flat win had been on a firm track. Mr Quinn further advised that with all its recent racing being over fences, it had gone into today’s race a fit horse and he was also of the opinion it had reacted well to gear changes made today but nonetheless had been surprised by today’s winning effort.</p> <p>M Hashizume (DAYDREAM BELIEVER) – Issued with a warning for using his whip on a runner out of contention.</p> <p>L Satherley (TICKLE ME ALMO) - Admitted a charge in that she struck her mount seven times prior to the 100 metres with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a fine of \$250.</p>	
Race 4	CK TREEWORX 2400
<p>ZA’FARAN (C Grylls) - Crowded at the start. Hampered passing the 800 metres.</p> <p>DIAMOND JAK (M Hashizume) - Slow to begin. Hampered passing the 800 metres.</p> <p>MALFY ROSA (A Lawson-Carroll) - Contacted shortly after the start becoming briefly unbalanced.</p> <p>ALL IN ALL (J Kamaruddin) - Went amiss when racing free of interference passing the 800 metres with ZA’FARAN, DIAMOND JAK, RAAJOICES and NASSAK DIAMOND all being hampered as a result. ALL IN ALL was immediately attended to by the Veterinarian and the horse ambulance deployed with the gelding having to be humanely euthanised as it was found to have fractured the right shoulder.</p> <p>RAAJOICES (S Spratt) - Hampered passing the 800 metres.</p> <p>NASSAK DIAMOND (B Rogerson) - Hampered passing the 800 metres.</p>	
Race 5	BILL MORELAND MEMORIAL 1400
<p>THUNDER (M Hashizume) – Restrained at the start to obtain cover from its wide barrier.</p> <p>MONZA (J Doyle) - Blundered leaving the barriers.</p> <p>POW WOW (S Spratt) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p>	

PUNTURA (L Douglas) - Held up entering the final straight then had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 200 metres.

CLEVER RUDS (B Rogerson) - Crowded near the 150 metres.

MARY LOUISE (C Grylls) - When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the mare had never travelled well during the running and had been very disappointing and was unable to offer any excuse.

S Spratt (POW WOW) - Issued with a warning after allowing her mount POW WOW to shift inwards crowding CLEVER RUDS near the 150 metres.

Race 6 | **KARL DAVIS TEAM BAYLEYS – A SURE BET 1100**

SEAMSEW (J Kamaruddin) - Required farrier attention at the barrier after losing a hind plate prior to commencing its preliminary and was unable to be reshod being subsequently late scratched at 3.00 pm.

SHOW COURAGE (J Chung) - Became fractious in its barrier having to be removed for a veterinary inspection being declared a late scratched at 3.03 pm on veterinary advice. Connections were advised the gelding would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

JAARFFI (W Kennedy) - Began awkwardly then knuckled shortly after the start, losing ground.

DODDLE (M Hashizume) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from its wide barrier.

ABANDON (C Grylls) - Knuckled at the start.

DAPPER LAD (S Spratt) - Over-raced in the early stages when leading. Lay out rounding the bend.

SUPER TIME (J Fawcett) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

SHOOTIN TO SAKS (L Satherley) - Underwent a post-race veterinary examination after the trainer reported it had returned to the enclosure with a small amount of blood present in a nostril which found the blood to be from external trauma.

Race 7 | **JAMES AND ANNIE SARTEN MEMORIAL 1400 (G2)**

SOLIDIFY (S Spratt) - Began awkwardly. Steadied approaching the 250 metres when runners on either side shifted ground.

CROCETTI (W Kennedy) - Jumped away awkwardly then blundered when making contact with SOLIDIFY.

BEAST OF BURDEN (M Hashizume) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from its wide barrier. Lay out rounding the final turn and continued to do so in the straight.

FONSI (M Cameron) - Raced greenly early in the straight shifting away from LUPO SOLITARIO near the 300 metres.

LUPO SOLITARIO (R Elliot) - Raced greenly once placed under pressure in the straight.

Race 8 | **SWEYNESSE STAKES 1200 (G3)**

PACKING ROCKSTAR (J Doyle) - Crowded at the start.

TEVERE (V Colgan) - Crowded at the start.

BEEBEEP (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly briefly unbalancing its rider. Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

RIODINI (S Spratt) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

SASSY MERLOT (C Grylls) - Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

HABANA (W Kennedy) - Held up early in the straight and continued to have some difficulty obtaining clear running being inconvenienced near the 150 metres when BEEBEEP shifted inwards under pressure.

Race 9 | **PROTEK COATINGS MILE 1600**

FINEST WINE (L Satherley) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

ANOTHER BELLA (C Grylls) - Slow to begin.

TRUST IN YOU (A Lawson-Carroll) - Knuckled at the start. Held up until near the 200 metres.

ROCKET LAD (W Kennedy) - Slow to begin.

BRONTES GOLD (L Douglas) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Inconvenienced approaching the 600 metres when SULABELLA shifted out.

STRATHTAY (J Doyle) - Was inclined to lay inwards under pressure in the straight. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the gelding had been disappointing and, in his opinion may be better suited by some easing of the ground.

Race 10 | **NZB READY TO RUN SALE TRAINERS SERIES 1300**

IFFSHECAN (C Grylls) - Late scratched at 1.43 pm on veterinary advice due to being mildly lame after casting a plate prior to being loaded onto the transporter.

HOT SALSA (J Allen) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Steadied when improving onto the heels of HASSTOBEFAST approaching the 1000 metres.

NIGELLA LANE (J Fawcett) - Contacted at the start by runners either side, becoming briefly unbalanced.

SIR STERLING (J Doyle) - Slow to begin. Had to be briefly steadied away from the heels of KAI passing the 150 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider was of the opinion that the gelding would be better suited by some easing of the ground.

PATRICIA (L Satherley) – Jumped away awkwardly making contact. Rider reported that the mare was better suited to some easing of the ground.

HASSTOBEFAST (M Hashizume) - Steadied off heels approaching the 1000 metres going back onto HOT SALSA. Held up early in the final straight.

LHASA (J Kamaruddin) - Raced three wide without cover. Rider reported that the gelding was better suited to some easing of the ground.

WINDSPEED (C Lindsay) – Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of SELVA VERDE near the 600 metres. Apprentice K Bakker was advised that she must exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

CALEDONIE (S Spratt) - Had to be steadied off heels passing the 200 metres.
