## RACE COMMENTS

Race $1 \quad$ BAYLEYS MOUNT MAUNGANUI MAIDEN 1200
NIKAIA (M Hashizume) - Began awkwardly. Inconvenienced approaching the 100 metres.

LA MEZQUITA (V Colgan) - Crowded at the start losing ground. Steadied when placed in restricted room just prior to the winning post.

JINN WARRIOR (L Satherley) - Began awkwardly.

MARS (M McNab) - Slow to begin.

DECEMBER (S Weatherley) - Began awkwardly then contacted by CINNAMON GIRL at the start. Raced greenly when racing in restricted room near the 750 metres. Held up early in the final straight.

TRUECOLOURS (J Whiteside) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Ran wide rounding the final bend when laying out and continued to do so for the remainder of the race.

CHARMING EMPEROR (C Barnes) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

PART TIME LOVER (M Cameron) - Shifted out and away from MARS which had shifted out slightly inconveniencing NIKAIA approaching the 100 metres.

## Race 2 AONGATETE AVO-JECT 3YO 1200

DID THE TRICK (S Spratt) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Lay out entering the final straight forcing TOSSUFORIT and ONEIRA wider then continued to lay out for the remainder of the race.

SASPERELLA (V Colgan) - Steadied when placed in restricted room to the outside of CU CHULAINN and inside of DID THE TRICK which was shifting inwards near the 1000 metres. S Spratt was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

CHARMER (C Barnes) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Made contact with the running rail near the 1000 metres.

ONEIRA (M Cameron) - Forced wider entering the final straight.

TOSSUFORIT (M McNab) - Contacted and forced wider entering the final straight.

CU CHULAINN (J Kamaruddin) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding had travelled comfortably throughout however when placed under pressure, had failed to respond and he had been disappointed with the performance. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the gelding to be $2 / 5$ lame in the right hind leg along with minor lacerations on the right hind coronet and left hind pastern.
Connections were advised a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.

## Race 3 RIKI WALLS BAYLEYS COUNTRY \& LIFESTYLE MAIDEN 1400

SONNET (V Colgan) - Began awkwardly making contact with DOUBLE VISION.

DOUBLE VISION (M McNab) - Contacted at the start.

GOLD DIGGER (J Fawcett) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

IMA CAVALIER (S Weatherley) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from its wide barrier.

AN SO IT BE (C Barnes) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

RUNNINWITHTHEDEVIL (J Kamaruddin) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages when leading.

SPRING HOLIDAY (J Whiteside) - Checked passing the 1100 metres.
S Phelan (AN SO IT BE) - Issued with a minor infringement and fined the sum of \$50 for failing to declare a rider by the required time for $A N$ SO IT $B E$.

J Kamaruddin (RUNNINWITHTHEDEVIL) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of SPRING HOLIDAY which was checked passing the 1100 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of J Kamaruddin's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 11 November up to and including racing on Friday 17 November, 4 national riding days.

## Race 4 SUPER LIQUOR GREERTON MAIDEN 1400

THE WEAPON (J Fawcett) - Slow to begin. Held up early in the final straight until shifting out to obtain clear running near the 300 metres.

ZABMANZOR (M Hashizume) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from its wide barrier.
PERFECTMANZ (J Allen) - Began awkwardly.
STICKTO THE ORDERS (A Lawson-Carroll) - Steadied passing the 1200 metres when HIGHLY GIFTED shifted in. Held up until near the 150 metres.

HIGHLY GIFTED (C Barnes) - Lost the near hind plate during the running.

## Race 5 FLYING MULLET SPORTS BAR 1400

MADAME LE FAY (V Colgan) - Crowded at the start then clipped a heel blundering.
FONTEYN (A Goindasamy) - Knuckled at the start.
CLEESE (D Danis) - Slow to begin.
BRANDO (J Allen) - Crowded at the start losing ground. Held up rounding the final bend.

SELVA VERDE (J Fawcett) - Crowded at the start losing ground.
GOSPODIN (M Sanson) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that in her opinion the gelding would benefit from more rain affected footing.

TIGHTLIGN (S Weatherley) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding had not travelled comfortably throughout and was of the opinion that it was unsuited by today's track conditions. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Following this race, the track was upgraded to Soft 7.

## Race 6 TEAM WEALLEANS 1200

ONEROA (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin.
OUR TURN (C Barnes) - Began awkwardly.

I CHOOSE YOU (M McNab) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from its wide barrier. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the mare had been unable to make up ground in the straight after the moderate mid-race tempo and was of the opinion that it would now benefit from a step up in distance.

DUBAI DIVA (S Weatherley) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from its wide barrier. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the mare to have a slower than normal recovery.

TIVAAN WARRIOR (S Spratt) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Contacted and forced wider near the 250 metres.

ORANGE PEARL (M Sanson) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

OUTBACK OPAL (M Hashizume) - Held up until near the 250 metres.

## Race 7 SNOW WILLIAMS BAYLEYS COUNTRY 1200

MARMAC BOY (C Barnes) - Slow to begin.

PIZZAZZ (V Colgan) - Slow to begin.
KHUTULUN KHAN (J Kamaruddin) - Knuckled on jumping away.
SUPER TIME (A Goindasamy) - Over-raced through the early and middle stages.
MAGAWA (J Fawcett) - Inconvenienced near the 700 metres when SUPER TIME was over-racing to its inside being forced to race wide for the remainder of the race.

WEY TOO COOL (T Moodley) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Made the bend awkwardly entering the final straight becoming awkwardly placed on heels, having to be steadied.

L O'Sullivan \& A Scott (MAGAWA) - Issued with a minor infringement and fined the sum of \$100 for failing to declare a rider by the required time for MAGAWA.

## Race 8 SEEKA 2100

EL NYMPH (L Satherley) - Began awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early stages. Hampered passing the 350 metres. Badly hampered approaching the 100 metres. Received veterinary attention post-race to treat a laceration on the left hind leg.

HIT THE ROAD JACK (J Allen) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from its wide barrier. Steadied to avoid heels passing the 350 metres.

EL BANDOLERO (C Barnes) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from its wide barrier.

ROGER THAT (T Moodley) - Knuckled at the start.
HUSK (K Bakker) - Began awkwardly.

MOTUMAN (M Sanson) - Raced three wide for a majority of the race. Gave ground from near the 600 metres.

ABOVE THE CLOUDS (A Goindasamy) - Shifted outwards abruptly when struck with the whip passing the 350 metres hampering EL NYMPH which shifted outwards into the line of HIT THE ROAD JACK which had to be steadied to avoid
heels. Ducked outwards abruptly when being struck with the whip approaching the 100 metres badly hampering EL NYMPH, CORK, TRUST IN YOU and FINEST WINE. Connections were advised that the mare would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

CORK (M McNab) - Badly hampered approaching the 100 metres.
TRUST IN YOU (A Lawson-Carroll) - Badly hampered approaching the 100 metres.
FINEST WINE (S Spratt) - Badly hampered approaching the 100 metres.

## Race 9 <br> BAYLEYS TAURANGA 2100

IN A PICKLE (A Goindasamy) - Contacted and crowded at the start losing ground.
FAY KHAN IT (M McNab) - Began awkwardly making contact with IN A PICKLE. Lay out rounding the final bend. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the mare had hung outwards throughout, and he had been unable to ride it out in the final straight. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

PRINCESS ADDA (S Weatherley) - Crowded at the start. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the mare had been unsuited by the fast tempo of today's race.

KIWI MAN (B Rogerson) - Slow to begin.
YOULEDO (V Colgan) - Raced three wide without cover for a majority of the race.

DOUBLE TAKE (K Bakker) - Improved onto heels near the 450 metres having to be firmly restrained for a distance.

MAGGIE RUTH (M Cameron) - Steadied off heels approaching the 400 metres. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that in his opinion the mare was feeling the effects of recent racing. Trainer S Phelan advised that he would now be considering sending the mare for a spell. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 10 CELEBRATING 150 YEARS OF RACING IN TAURANGA 1600
ALMINETTE (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin.

CINDY FALLS (S Spratt) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

APACHE BOY (M Hashizume) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from its wide barrier. Held up for a distance approaching the 200 metres.

THE QUEEN BEE (C Barnes) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the mare had not travelled comfortably throughout. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed swelling in the right foreleg.

ELTON ROCKS (T Moodley) - Improved onto heels passing the 400 metres having to be firmly restrained. Contacted and forced wider passing the 200 metres.

KEY LARGO (M McNab) - Came together with DROP OF SOMETHING entering the final straight becoming unbalanced. When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no excuse.

DROP OF SOMETHING (R Elliot) - Came together with KEY LARGO entering the final straight becoming unbalanced.

ROCABURY (L Satherley) - Contacted and forced wider becoming unbalanced passing the 200 metres.
M Cameron (LATRELLE) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of ELTON ROCKS which was contacted and forced outwards onto the hindquarters of ROCABURY which became unbalanced passing the 200 metres.
