Race 4 H R JONES LTD CELEBRATING 75 YEARS IN BUSINESS 1200m

MOCHATINI (L Allpress) – Stable representative Ms. M Marshall advised Stewards the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of the mare, and it is their intention to continue on with MOCHATINI'S current preparation. M Marshall further advised that in their opinion the mare may have not been suited to the synthetic track conditions and will now go back to being nominated for grass track racing.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 RUAHINE PROPERTY WORKS MAIDEN 2100m

CATCH AND RELEASE (L Hemi) - Began awkwardly and was then hampered and crowded when runners to its outside shifted ground and as a result lost ground. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Held up rounding the final bend and was unable to obtain clear running until near the 100 metres.

IZYMYDAAD (K Asano) - Contacted at the start losing ground. Restrained and hampered 1600 metres.

SOUND TRACK (C Dell) - Began awkwardly making contact with IZYMYDAAD.

TRIGGER HAPPY (L Douglas) - Slow to begin.

SCOOBYWILLDO (C Carmine) - Began awkwardly losing ground and was then ridden with urgency to recover. Raced greenly through the early stages of the home straight.

HOME RULE (L Sutherland) - Over-raced through the early and middle stages. Raced greenly throughout the final straight.

SWEET TABOO (M Hudson) - Improved onto the heels of BINIKA (V Jalalkuncha) near the 1600 metres having to be steadied abruptly then going back on to IZYMYDAAD, which had to be firmly restrained and was then hampered.

HERECOMESTHESUN (M Singh) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

EL ATTITUDE (T Davies) - Briefly held up in the early stages of the final straight, shifting inwards and when doing so improved onto the heels of SCOOBYWILLDO, which was racing greenly.

V Jalalkuncha (BINIKA) - Issued with a warning after easing the pace markedly near the 1600 metres which resulted in SWEET TABOO and IZYMYDAAD having to be steadied abruptly.

Race 2 DANNEVIRKE CARRIERS 3YO MAIDEN 1200m

GRID GIRL (C Grylls) - Slow to begin. Held up rounding the final bend and was unable to obtain clear running until passing the 300 metres.

RESPOND (K Asano) - Began awkwardly shifting out, crowding outside runners, quickly being corrected by its rider. Commenced to race keenly when being restrained to obtain cover passing the 1000 metres.

PSYCLONE (J Kamaruddin) - Began awkwardly and was then crowded, losing ground. Held up through the early stages of the final straight, having to shift outwards across heels to obtain clear running near the 250 metres. Rider reported the filly had raced greenly throughout.

PLATINUM DESIGNS (J Riddell) - Began awkwardly and was then crowded shortly after the start, losing ground. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

JETALAL (T Taiaroa) - Slow to begin.

KINGSTON HEATH (M McNab) - Slow to begin.

COSMIC STAR (J Doyle) - From its wide barrier was restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

DANJURO (J Parkes) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Lay inwards throughout the final straight.

BODACIOUS KATE (T Bau) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

BELLA CORNO (L Hemi) - Lay outwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

Track Upgraded to Good 4 retrospective to Race 2

Race 3 MERRYLEES HOTEL MAIDEN 1200m

HORONUKU (S Weatherley) - Slow to begin. Lay outwards rounding the final bend and throughout the final straight.

WAZA DREAM (M Hudson) - Began awkwardly.

MIDNIGHT SCANDAL (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly, shifting outwards crowding outside runners. Briefly contacted 250 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider advised the mare had greenly throughout and may have got its tongue over the bit which was confirmed by a subsequent veterinary examination. Rider further advised MIDNIGHT SCANDAL will derive benefit from today's race.

PADDY GIFT (K Asano) - Contacted then crowded shortly after the start, then having to be firmly restrained off heels and as a result lost ground.

HELLO CUPID (J Doyle) - Contacted then crowded, losing ground shortly after the start. Held up rounding the final bend.

TOUCH O'PARADISE (C Dell) - Began awkwardly, crowding inside runners.

LOVELY RITA (C Lindsay) - Began awkwardly, losing ground.

SNIPSNAP (J Kamaruddin) - When over-racing near the 800 metres improved on to heels, having to shift outwards making contact with SEVENAYES and was then obliged to race three-wide without cover throughout.

SEVENAYES (J Chung) - Raced wide without cover through the early stages. Contacted 800 metres. Raced greenly throughout the final straight.

POPSAGOOSEY (J Riddell) - Held up rounding the final bend.

MAIN FOCUS (T Taiaroa) - Lay outwards passing the 250 metres, making brief contact with MIDNIGHT SCANDAL.

Race 4 DON STEPHENSON MEMORIAL HANDICAP 1200m

BELLESGIRL (J Doyle) - Late scratching at 2.24pm after refusing to load. Connections were advised BELLESGIRL must barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

FIZZY MOON (K Asano) - Reared as the gates were effected and as a result lost ground. Over-raced through the early and middle stages. Held up rounding the final bend, shifting outwards, forcing OFF TO THE NUNNERY wider on the track. K Asano was advised to exercise greater care. Rider reported the mare had hung throughout the running.

BIKINDY (L Douglas) - Began awkwardly making contact with HERE COMES TROUBLE and as a result lost ground.

HERE COMES TROUBLE (T Taiaroa) - Contacted at the start when runners either side shifted ground.

BARONET (M McNab) - Began awkwardly crowding inside runners.

PACE ATTACK (L Hemi) - Began awkwardly contacting JUS WING IT.

JUS WING IT (T Davies) - Contacted at the start. Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

NEVER FEAR (J Parkes) - Slow to begin.

FREEDOM REINS (L Sutherland) - From its wide barrier was restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start. Held up through the early stages of the final straight, having to shift outwards across heels to obtain clear running near the 250 metres.

OFF TO THE NUNNERY (J Chung) - Forced wider rounding the final bend.

RAGAMUFFIN (J Kamaruddin) - When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no excuse.

Race 5 THE DANNEVIRKE MEAT COMPANY 1200m

KANA (M Hudson) - Began awkwardly and was then restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

VISHAKHA (T Taiaroa) - Slow to begin.

FLEMING (J Parkes) - Slow to begin. When questioned regarding performance rider advised the gelding would benefit from some easing in track conditions. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

ROYAL FLOWER (C Lindsay) - Began awkwardly making contact with SOPHMAZE and as a result lost ground.

SOPHMAZE (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly making contact with ROYAL FLOWER and as a result lost ground.

FREE BEE (T Davies) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

GEE STRING (J Riddell) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

MAGNESS (C Dell) - When attempting to shift inwards to obtain cover made contact with DUNCAN CREEK near the 900 metres.

DUNCAN CREEK (J Doyle) - Contacted 900 metres. Lay outwards under pressure for the majority of the final straight.

Race 6 WENHAM GRAIN & SEED MAIDEN 1400m

TURKEY (M Singh) - Began very awkwardly and as a result lost considerable ground. Raced wide without cover throughout. Connections were advised a warning is placed on the mare's barrier manners.

YELSERP (C Butler) - Slow to begin and was then crowded shortly after the start, losing ground. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in the mouth. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a bite to the tongue or lip.

MYAZAWA (M Hudson) - Slow to begin.

KEEN ON BUBBLES (T Taiaroa) - Began awkwardly, shifting inwards shortly after the start, having to be corrected by its rider. Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

LILI MARLENE (J Parkes) - Shifted inwards and away from KEEN ON BUBBLES and as a result crowded YELSERP shortly after the start. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

CENTRE PAGE (T Davies) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

BELLE LAUREL (S Weatherley) - Briefly held up rounding the final bend and through the early stages of the final straight.

Race 7 ROLLY ELLIS MAIDEN 1600m

DIVA KINGDOM (S Weatherley) - Slow to begin. Held up through the early stages of the final straight and was unable to obtain clear running until passing the 150 metres.

ITALIAN KING (J Parkes) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

THE UGLY SISTER (J Doyle) - From its wide barrier draw was restrained behind runners shortly after the start.

MISS RAINEY (J Kamaruddin) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Had to angle his mount outwards to obtain clear running passing the 250 metres.

DOUBLEDEE (J Riddell) - Steadied off heels on the bend entering the back straight. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

KUVALDA (C Carmine) - Made the first bend awkwardly when over-racing and when being steadied shifted inwards marginally hampering DOUBLEDEE, then continued to over-race in the back straight.

LOOSE MONEY (M McNab) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

SUBTLE IMAGE (C Dell) - Held up rounding the final bend and throughout the majority of the final straight, only gaining clear running passing the 50 metres.

Race 8 YOUNIQUE AT 84 1600m

SHEEZ DOMINANT (J Chung) - Slow to begin.

RISCHIO (J Doyle) - Slow to begin. Commenced to race keenly on a slow tempo and improved on to heels having to be restrained, getting its head up passing the 1000 metres.

PERFECT TEST (L Sutherland) - Began awkwardly, hampering KATTEGAT.

KATTEGAT (M McNab) - Hampered shortly after the start. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Held up rounding the final bend having to angle his mount inwards to obtain clear running when IRONWOOD lay outwards approaching the 300 metres. Raced greenly throughout the final straight.

LOSTCAUSE (J Parkes) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Raced wide without cover throughout.

BOSTON STRONG BOY (L Douglas) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

IRONWOOD (M Hudson) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout. Lay outwards under pressure throughout the final straight.

GRAND PROSPECT (J Kamaruddin) - Raced in restricted room near the 50 metres.

LOVE NESST (S Weatherley) - Raced in restricted room early in the final straight.
