RACE COMMENTS		
Race 1	CLASS CARPENTRY MAIDEN 1200m	
LATER BOY (L Allpress) - Raced in restricted room shortly after the start when there was movement from runners either side. Raced greenly in the home straight.		
AQUILIFER (J Fawcett) - Shifted out shortly after the start momentarily hampering GOOD CRAIC.		

WAITUI ROSE (M Cameron) - Held up for the majority of the home straight and went to the line without being fully tested.

MAROTIRI MOLLY (K Hercock) - Lay inwards in the home straight and had to be straightened passing the 200 metres.

LEAVE A LIGHT ON (C Dell) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

VAVOOM (C Grylls) - Raced greenly in the home straight and C Grylls confirmed the filly's reluctance to take a gap near the 200 metres.

L Kauri (MCCRAW) - Spoken to with regards to the use of the whip when leaving the birdcage.

Race 2 WANGANUI INSURANCE BROKERS MAIDEN 1360m

CHANCE (J Riddell) - Slow away (4L).

TIKEMYSON (J Parkes) - Slow away.

WORKSACHARM (L Hemi) - Jumped away awkwardly. Briefly steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 200 metres.

TURKEY (M Singh) - Raced three-wide without cover.

OUR SASSIE ANNE (M Cameron) - Hung inwards briefly approaching the 100 metres.

SIR MIKKI (C Dell) - Raced greenly in the final straight.

Race 3 LA NUOVA DRYCLEANING MAIDEN 1360m

LOCH IN ORA (M Cameron) - Crowded leaving the barriers.

GIN TRAP (K Hercock) - Jumped away awkwardly, making contact with the side of its barrier stall.

LEICA SONG (J Parkes) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

OUR DEE FORE (C Grylls) - Raced greenly when wide throughout. When questioned regarding performance C Grylls advised despite being wide throughout the mare had been very disappointing.

CHARIVARI (J Allen) - Had to steady near the 1100 metres when racing keenly. Had to be steadied when awkwardly placed near the heels of CENTRE PAIGE near the 800 metres.

SEVENAYES (J Chung) - Had to steady off the heels of TIPO near the 400 metres.

Track upgraded to Soft 5 following Race 3.

Race 4 EZI-FINANCE 3YO MAIDEN 1360m

THE ENTERTAINER (C Grylls) - Slow away after being fractious in the barriers.

WICKHAM (J Riddell) - Slow away.

HICKORY JACK (K Hercock) - Jumped away awkwardly and lay outwards in the early stages, hampering I'LL HAVA SEMILLON. Over-raced badly when being restrained passing the 1100 metres. Held up for a distance rounding the

bend from the 500 metres only obtaining clear running passing the 300 metres. Rider reported the gelding had been unable to finish the race off after racing fiercely in the middle stages.

I'LL HAVA SEMILLON (L Sutherland) - Hampered leaving the barriers.

JULIANUS (M Cameron) - Jumped away awkwardly then shifting outwards, hampering BEAVERTOWN LASS.

BEAVERTOWN LASS (M Hudson) - Hampered shortly after the start, losing ground.

CHAMPAGNE LINDA (L Allpress) - Raced three-wide without cover.

MANZOR BLUE (T Newman) - Briefly held up near the 450 metres. Lost the right hind plate during the running.

PICADILLY LILLY (J Fawcett) - Rider reported that the mare displayed an irregular breathing pattern and had recommended to connections the application of a tongue tie for its next start.

GREY INVADOR (J Chung) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised the gelding had raced greenly and was further of the opinion would be better suited over more ground.

Race 5 JOLT COFFEE HOUSE 1360m

SHARE POWER (J Chung) - Slow away. Over-raced in the early to middle stages and had to be steadied when placed in restricted room going into the bend near the 900 metres.

MAKKALDEE (K Hercock) - Slow away. Steadied just short of the finish when improving onto the heels of HAKA BOOGIE.

RUE CLER (J Parkes) - Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover after jumping from the outside barrier.

MCKHAN (L Kauri) - Contacted leaving the barriers unbalancing the rider.

DOUBTFUL SOUND (C Dell) - Raced wide without cover.

SCELTA DI ELENA (M Singh) - Over-raced when being restrained in the early stages, continuing to race keenly in the middle stages.

Race 6 G BRISTOL & SONS 1600m

CEE ARE EL (M Hudson) - Raced three-wide without cover.

MORUS (M Cameron) - When questioned regarding performance M Cameron was of the opinion that the gelding was now looking for more ground.

PADDY GIFT (J Parkes) - Over-raced when being restrained in the early stages. When questioned regarding performance rider advised the gelding had been very disappointing and may not have been suited by today's track conditions. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 7

PROPERTY BROKERS COMPLIANCE 1600m

ROCKTILYOUDROP (C Lindsay) - Slow away then after being ridden forward to recover, commenced to over-race badly in the trail from the 1400 metres, having to be heavily restrained for some distance to avoid the heels of BOSTON STRONG BOY and making contact with the running rail on a number of occasions when continuing to race fiercely throughout the middle stages. C Lindsay was shown footage of her ride in the presence of the Apprentice Mentor and was advised she is expected to show better judgment in her riding in future. TAKE ON (L Sutherland) - Slow away.

MADAME MOET (M Hudson) - Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover, after jumping from a wide barrier. Over-raced through the middle stages. Held up early in the straight and did not obtain clear running until passing the 200 metres.

PEPEHA (C Grylls) - Raced wide without cover. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that after coming into contention early in the straight the gelding had failed to quicken when asked to do so.

SCHUSKI (M Singh) - Had to be steadied away from heels passing the 200 metres.

Race 8	COMMDIVES NZ MAIDEN 2060m	
GOOD WORK MEN (J Doyle) - Slow away.		

BANKSFIELD (C Lindsay) - Slow away and remainder tailed off for the majority of the race. Ducked outwards away from the running rail near the 700 metres. Trainer A Bidlake was advised the gelding is under a warning for its lack of competitiveness.

RIVER DANCE (J Chung) - Slow away. Raced keenly in the middle stages. Lay inwards briefly crowding VERARDINO near the 700 metres. Shifted inwards abruptly after being struck with the whip near the 250 metres, having to be corrected by its rider.

LOVEHELEN (M Singh) - Had to be steadied to avoid the heels of WALKINTHEPARK near the 1800 metres.

VERARDINO (J Riddell) - Briefly crowded near the 700 metres.

OPAL SPIRIT (J Fawcett) - Was a beaten runner by the 600 metres with the rider advising the mare had not been suited by the quicker tempo of the race in the improved track conditions.

SOUND TRACK (T Newman) - Raced three-wide without cover and was a beaten runner passing the 400 metres with not being persevered with in the straight. When questioned rider advised the gelding had not been suited by the quicker tempo of the race in the improved track conditions.

LAZY (C Dell) - Briefly hampered approaching the 200 metres when EXTROVERT shifted away from RIVER DANCE.

L Douglas (MOSSRAAJ) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards when not fully clear of WALKINTHEPARK, which was dictated inwards into the line of LOVEHELEN near the 1800 metres.

Race 9 PALAMOUNTAINS ANIMAL NUTRITION 2060m

WINNIE ROSE (C Grylls) - Slow away (4L).

ONE DREAM ONE SOUL (L Sutherland) - Crowded shortly after leaving the barriers.

WENEEDASHOCK (C Dell) - Raced three-wide without cover until improving forward outside the leader near the 1200 metres. Contacted near the 250 metres when OPAWA JACK lay outwards.

MAUNA LOA (L Allpress) - Raced three-wide without cover from the 1200 metres.

JAY BEE GEE (M Hudson) - When questioned regarding performance rider was of the opinion the gelding had found it difficult to quicken under its big weight.
