RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 | **STAR GROUP 1400m**

GREAT ESCAPE (L Allpress) - Blundered at the start losing ground.

STIPULATOR (K Asano) - Slow to begin then hampered by GREAT ESCAPE. Made the bend near the 1000 metres awkwardly.

SNELLEN (L Sutherland) - Over-raced in the early stages.

REV IT UP RUSTY (K Hercock) - Got its head up when being steadied through the early stages.

PSYCLONE (J Fawcett) - Held up early in the run home. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running until approaching the 200 metres.

Race 2	MARSH INSURANCE BROKERS MAIDEN 1200m
<p>MOLASSES (M Singh) - Crowded at the start losing ground.</p> <p>CAME SAW CONQUERED (C Dell) - Bounded leaving the barriers.</p> <p>REDANA (J Doyle) - Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>OUR BRAVEHEART (M Hudson) - Crowded at the start losing some ground.</p> <p>GO BABY GO (K Asano) - Became awkward in its action as the field made the crossing near the 600 metres, immediately being pulled up by its rider. The Veterinarian and Horse Ambulance were immediately deployed. A veterinary examination revealed the filly to have suffered a fractured right-fore fetlock and as a result was humanely euthanised.</p>	
Race 3	HARRISON'S FLOORING 1200m
<p>LITTLEREDCORVETTE (J Chung) - Blundered badly leaving the barriers unbalancing the rider for a short distance and losing ground as a result.</p> <p>THATZ DAISY (L Hemi) - Over-raced in the early stages and near the 800 metres had to be shifted outwards to avoid heels and in doing so inconvenienced EXTORTIONIST.</p> <p>EXTORTIONIST (K Asano) – Inconvenienced 800 metres. Lay inwards passing the 400 metres having to be straightened by its rider.</p> <p>FASHION ICON (M Hashizume) - Held up in the run home and had to shift inwards near the 250 metres to obtain clear racing room. Bumped near the 75 metres.</p> <p>PEPEHA (J Riddell) - Lay outwards over the concluding stages and near the 75 metres shifted out under pressure making brief contact with FASHION ICON.</p> <p>MAN EXPRESS (L Allpress) - Briefly steadied near the 50 metres when in restricted room due to FASHION ICON laying outwards.</p> <p>Due to a number of horses blundering at the start area, Stewards directed the Club to take remedial action at the starting points. The Club advised that they had used the groundhog at the remaining starting points for today's races.</p>	
Race 4	WOODRIDGE HOMES 1100m
<p>PRIORESS (J Doyle) - Slow into stride.</p> <p>CHAJABA (M Cameron) - Had some difficulty obtain clear running passing the 200 metres.</p>	
Race 5	VERNON AND VAZEY TRUCK PARTS LTD 2400m
<p>IMPERIAL PARTY (K Hercock) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>SMART ATTIRE (K Asano) Taken from a wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start.</p> <p>KHAFFEEF (M Hudson) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>DANZINO (C Dell) - Slow to begin.</p>	

MUGSHOT (L Sutherland) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages on a moderate tempo. When questioned rider could offer no tangible excuse

NUN SO BAD (J Chung) - Raced wide without cover from the 2000 metres.

SWING THE TIDE (T Taiaroa) - Improved onto the heels of SUPER FLASH near the 1800 metres having to be steadied.

JACKAROO (J Riddell) - Lay outwards throughout the home straight with the rider reporting the gelding had hung when placed under pressure and was disappointing.

SUPER FLASH (L Allpress) - Eased down over the concluding stages when well beaten. L Allpress advised in her opinion the gelding may have been feeling the effects of recent racing.

Race 6 | **ASHBY PROPERTY MANAGEMENT 1400m**

MADAME MOET (M Hudson) - Slow to begin.

FABIAN HAWK (M Hashizume) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start.

SHARE POWER (M Singh) - When asked to comment on the apparent improved performance of SHARE POWER, Trainer D Parry advised she had not been disappointed with the first-up run at Whanganui, but the win today was still unexpected.

SWEET JINEEN (J Doyle) - Post race treated for a bruised left-front heel.

Race 7 | **JENNIAN HOMES 1600m**

MARY LOUISE (C Butler) - Slow to begin.

SOLDIER BOY (K Asano) - Slow to begin. Held up rounding the bend and early in the run home and when endeavouring to negotiate a marginal run made contact with KICK ON when COLORADO STAR also shifted ground at this point. Continued to be held up until passing the 300 metres.

KICK ON (L Sutherland) - Contacted and unbalanced 425 metres.

Race 8 | **GRANT PLUMBING 1400m**

BOLD IRIS (J Fawcett) - Began awkwardly, then restrained to obtain cover shortly after the start.

POPSAGOOSEY (J Riddell) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start. Held up rounding the final bend and had some difficulty obtain clear running until inside the final 200 metres.

PERFECTSISTER (L Allpress) - Over-raced in the early stages.

BARRI HYDE (L Sutherland) - Began awkwardly, shifting out making firm contact with DUNEAGLE. Raced wide without cover throughout.

DUNEAGLE (L Kauri) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

YELLOW JERSEY (K Hercock) - Raced in restricted room early in the run home.

TIMES UP (C Butler) - Lay inwards over the concluding stages briefly hampering PEPPERY, before being steadied and straightened.

PEPPERY (M Hudson) - Briefly hampered concluding stages.
