RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 WESTEND BOWLING CLUB 3YO MAIDEN 1400m

NEW MILLENNIUM (C Barnes) - Shifted outwards at the start hampering THE PATRON SAINT. Held up rounding the final bend and through the early stages of the final straight, having to shift outwards to obtain clear running near the 200 metres.

THE PATRON SAINT (R Elliot) - Hampered at the start and forced outwards crowding MISTERKIPCHOGE.

MISTERKIPCHOGE (C Butler) - Crowded at the start when THE PATRON SAINT was forced outwards and as a result lost ground. When racing keenly improved onto heels having to shift outwards and as a result made the bend awkwardly near the 800 metres. Hung inwards throughout the final straight.

OBAN (M McNab) - Blundered then shifted outwards abruptly at the start hampering DEE VEE PEE.

DEE VEE PEE (M Cameron) - Hampered at the start losing ground.

MANZAPPEAL (J Parkes) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

CHAMPAGNE LINDA (L Allpress) - Improved onto the heels of NEW MILLENNIUM approaching the 800 metres having to be steadied then going back onto EXPLOSIVE IMPACT with this runner going back onto CHARM ZAFARM.

EXPLOSIVE IMPACT (A Goindasamy) - Over raced through the early and middle stages. Improved onto heels having to be steadied approaching the 800 metres.

CHARM ZAFARM (L Sutherland) - Improved onto heels having to be steadied approaching the 800 metres.

SHE TURNS HEADS (J Allen) - Raced three wide without cover from the 900 metres.

BORN RULER (J Doyle) - Tightened shortly after entering the home straight when MISTERKIPCHOGE hung inwards simultaneously to WREN shifting out and away from NEW MILLENNIUM near the 200 metres.

The track was upgraded to Good 4 retrospective to Race 1.

Race 2 ENTAIN – NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE MAIDEN 1400m

HILARY BANKS (L Douglas) - Began awkwardly shifting inwards hampering LOVELY RITA.

LOVELY RITA (L Kauri) - Hampered at the start losing ground and was then ridden with urgency to recover. Commenced to race keenly through the early to middle stages.

MADAM PELE (J Allen) - Began awkwardly making contact with CELTIC ECHO and as a result lost ground.

CELTIC ECHO (J Doyle) - Contacted at the start losing ground. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection at the which revealed a thin abrasion to the left thigh.

THE MISTRESS (R Elliot) - Raced greenly at the crossing and shifted in abruptly having to be corrected by its rider.

TOO BIZZY (S O'Malley) - Raced ungenerously through the early and middle stages.

RITA BONITA (J Parkes) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

TARAZETTO (C Butler) - Had to be steadied for some distance in the back straight when over racing and lost ground.

Race 3 | **TARANAKI STEELFORMERS MAIDEN 1200m**

LE VOLT (B Grylls) - Slow to begin.

PERSIAN IDOL (L Douglas) - Shifted out at the start having to be straightened by its rider and losing ground as a result.

MEGATRENDZ (K Asano) - Shifted outwards shortly after the start contacting and hampering JUSTADUDE with this runner going onto TINY DIAMOND.

JUSTADUDE (R Elliot) - Contacted and hampered shortly after the start.

TINY DIAMOND (C Dell) - Contacted and hampered shortly after the start losing ground. Steadied when improving onto heels near the 500 metres. Rider reported the gelding had raced greenly throughout.

Race 4 | **WHITAKERS CIVIL CONSTRUCTION 1400m**

DREAM MACHINE (C Dell) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground and was then ridden with urgency to recover.

HASSTOBEYOU (K Asano) - Dropped its head as the start was effected and as a result began very awkwardly losing ground and was then ridden with urgency to recover.

BEAUDZ WELL (C Butler) - Slow to begin.

NOM DE PLUME (W Kennedy) - Slow to begin.

ISLINGTON LASS (M McNab) - Lay inwards through the early and middle stages of the final straight.

Race 5 | **ENERGY CITY FORD 1400m**

LA SANTANA (C Butler) - Slow to begin. Held up over the concluding stages without being fully tested by its rider.

BEAN A PLEASURE (L Allpress) - Slow to begin.

HAKA BOOGIE (L Douglas) - Slow to begin.

SNIPERS DREAM (M McNab) - On jumping shifted inwards abruptly crowding FIRRIATO.

FIRRIATO (W Kennedy) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

BELLADONNA LILY (M Cameron) - Buffeted shortly after the start losing ground when runners either side shifted ground.

REGAL REWARD (L Sutherland) - When racing keenly became awkwardly placed on heels having to be firmly restrained approaching the 800 metres.

DA OPTIMIST (J Parkes) - Lay out rounding the bend near the 800 metres.

INVINCIBEEL (B Jacobson) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Race 6

LA NUOVA 2000m

WINKLE BAY (C Barnes) - Slow to begin.

ATA RANGI (B Jacobson) - Became awkwardly placed on heels having to be steadied shortly after the start and as a result lost ground.

BATTLE SECRET (R Elliot) - Raced keenly through the early stages when being restrained to obtain cover. Passing the 600 metres improved onto the heels of the tiring COCKTAIL LAD, having to be firmly restrained.

OUR JUMALA (W Kennedy) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

HELLY BELLY (L Allpress) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

MANIFIQUE (M McNab) - Held up rounding the final bend and through the early stages of the run home and was unable to obtain clear racing room until passing the 200 metres.

FAMILY TIES (J Allen) - Held up through the early stages of the final straight.

THE UNDERBELLY (M Cameron) - When questioned regarding performance, the rider advised the gelding had hung throughout the running and was unsuited to today's firm track conditions, being better suited to more rain affected going.

Race 7

REVITAL FERTILISERS 1800m

HARDTIMES (K Asano) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up throughout the final straight and was unable to obtain clear running until approaching the 100 metres.

LOSTCAUSE (C Barnes) - Shifted outwards at the start having to be corrected by its rider.

THE WOMAN KING (J Doyle) - On jumping away shifted outwards and away from LOSTCAUSE and as a result crowded outside runners. Hung outwards rounding the final bend. Had to be steadied when laying inwards across the heels of NEEDLESS TO SAY and was further inconvenienced when ALMINETTE (J Parkes) shifted in near the 300 metres. J Parkes was advised to exercise greater care.

HANAKIN (C Dell) - Contacted at the start.

ALBUFEIRA (L Allpress) - Contacted then crowded at the start losing ground.

SONOFABUTCHER (L Douglas) - Contacted then crowded at the start losing ground.

SO THE FOX (B Grylls) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

INCUBO (M Cameron) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start. Held up early in the final straight having to be angled outwards to obtain clear running passing the 150 metres.

STASH (L Sutherland) - Had to be steadied when improving onto the heels of THE WOMAN KING approaching the 300 metres.

RUFFHOUSE ROSIE (S O'Malley) - Held up for the majority of the home straight only gaining clear running inside the final 50 metres.

Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>CALL A FRIEND (J Chung) - Contacted at the start.</p> <p>ZEBADAYA (J Doyle) - Buffeted and then crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Had to be steadied abruptly off the heels of the tiring SPANISH LAD prior to straightening.</p>
