RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 | **DOUG MORRIS 2YO 1200**

JACK CRABB (B Jacobson) - Restrained to obtain cover at the start from a wide barrier. Improved onto heels approaching the 200 metres having to be steadied then had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 100 metres.

THANKGODITSFRIDAY (J Fawcett) - Restrained to obtain cover at the start from the outside barrier. Had to shift out early in the final straight to obtain clear running.

OPPENHEIMER (T Moodley) - Crowded leaving the barriers, losing ground.

KIWI SKYHAWK (C Barnes) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

EL ARISH (J Doyle) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Lay in entering the final straight making contact with TARZANA then continued to lay in for the remainder of the straight.

REPTAK (A Lawson-Carroll) – Raced keenly through the early stages.

TARZANA (K Myers) – Contacted entering the final straight.

LUX LIBERTAS (W Kennedy) – Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room near the 600 metres when TARZANA shifted out and away from MARGALIT.

HINT (S Weatherley) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no excuse.

MASTER BRUTUS (W Kennedy) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced keenly through the early stages. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding found today's track conditions too testing.

ITZA CHARMDEEL (S Weatherley) - Slow to begin.

SWINDLE (T Moodley) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Lay inwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.

PRISCA (J Fawcett) - Slow to begin. Inconvenienced approaching the 100 metres when TIMELESS shifted outwards. J Nishizuka was advised to exercise care.

DIMITRA (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

SHE'S IDEAL (B Jacobson) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

THE MATADOR (J Doyle) – Raced keenly through the early stages. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

TIMELESS (J Nishizuka) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

ONEFORTHEGIRLS (D Cooper) - Gave ground quickly passing the 600 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 5 | **PROPERTY BROKERS & KATIE WALKER 3YO 1400**

STERLING EXPRESS (W Kennedy) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

DID THE TRICK (S Weatherley) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

I AM GROOT (A Lawson-Carroll) - Slow to begin.

WILLIT (K Myers) – Contacted leaving the barriers losing ground.

NIAGARA SKY (J Allen) - Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly having to be steadied. When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no explanation. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

FOREIGN AFFAIR (T Moodley) - Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the filly to be coughing before undergoing a laryngoscopic examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

JUWALA (B Jacobson) - Rider advised that the gelding had lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

CORNELIA (J Doyle) – When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the filly had raced too keenly with the side winkers on for the first time and he had recommended to connections that they be removed for its next start.

Race 6 | **CALLINAN FAMILY TAUMARUNUI RSA GOLD CUP 2200**

DIAMOND JAK (J Fawcett) - Slow to begin. Raced wide through the early stages.

CLEESE (T Moodley) - Contacted leaving the barriers.

THE FIRST LINK (B Rogerson) - Began awkwardly. Raced keenly through the early stages.

KING KHAN (W Kennedy) - Restrained to obtain cover at the start from a wide barrier.

PACHECO (C Barnes) – Raced keenly through the early stages. Contacted and forced wider approaching the 350 metres.

MALFY ROSA (K Myers) - Contacted and forced wider approaching the 350 metres.

HULA BEAT (A Lawson-Carroll) - Improved into a run approaching the 350 metres then lay out making contact with PACHECO which was forced outwards onto MALFY ROSA which was forced wider. A Lawson-Carroll was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

KHAN HUNTER (M Sanson) - When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding had travelled well throughout but had failed to respond when placed under pressure.

MARGARET JEAN (J Doyle) - When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no explanation. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

J Fawcett (DIAMOND JAK) - Admitted a charge in that she struck her mount eight times prior to the 100 metre mark with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a fine of \$500.
