J Parkes advised stewards on the morning of the races he was unwell and would not be attending today's races. Replacements were made as per schedule above. Mr Parkes was advised he would require a medical clearance prior to riding next.

**RACE COMMENTS****Race 1 | ILONE KELLY RACING STABLES MAIDEN 1600m**

**HE'S ALL FABULOUS** (L Douglas) - Slow to begin. Buffeted and unbalanced, losing ground, shortly after the start.

**NOTOUCHYMOTO** (L Hemi)- Crowded at the start losing ground, then tailed the field for the majority of the event, finishing a distant last. Rider advised the mare had been under pressure throughout and had been very disappointing.

**OUR LADY BROOKE** (S O'Malley) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

**BLACKROCK STAR** (K Hercock) - Began awkwardly and further hampered when crowded and checked shortly after the start. Raced greenly in the run through the middle stages and near the 1100 metres had to be steadied away from heels.

**FIVE BELLS** (J Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

**IDENTIKIT** (L Sutherland) - Buffeted and unbalanced shortly after the start and dictated inwards.

**WHATSINYOURWALLET** (C Dell) - Dictated inwards shortly after the start.

**GEORGIEWOOD** (L Allpress) - Dictated inwards shortly after the start. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the run home only gaining clear racing room passing the 200 metres.

**TITICACA** (K Chowdhoo) - Became awkwardly placed on heels of KALINYA (T Davies), having to be steadied for a distance when that runner continued to shift ground being held up as a result until near the 75 metres. T Davies was advised to exercise care.

**LADY'S SECRET** (A Mudhoo) - Shifted inwards abruptly near the 125 metres having to be straightened by its rider.

**S O'Malley** (OUR LADY BROOKE) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she allowed her mount to shift inwards dictating several runners inwards, resulting in BLACKWOOD STAR being checked shortly after the start. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of her licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Sunday, 28 July, until the conclusion of racing on Wednesday, 7 August, 4 national riding days.

**Race 2 | UZABUS HANDICAP 1600m**

**CETUS** (T Bau) - Blundered leaving the barriers. Post race was found to have abrasions to the off foreleg.

**VERRY FLASH** (R Goyaram) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**DIVINE SPIRIT** (J Chung) - Slow to begin.

**SACRED PEARL** (M Hashizume) - Dictated wider on the track passing the 300 metres when OPAWA JACK (L Sutherland) shifted outwards. L Sutherland was advised to exercise greater care.

**E Sole** (WENEDASHOCK) - Spoken to advisedly regarding her whip action in the run home.

The connections of the 2nd placed runner, SACRED PEARL, viewed a replay of the home straight footage before electing not to proceed with a protest.

**Race 3 | LEVIN TRUCK SERVICES HANDICAP 1200m**

**PRIORESS** (R Goyaram) - Slow to begin.

**TAVIS COURT** (E Sole) - Began awkwardly shifting inwards contacting OLD TOWN ROAD.

**OLD TOWN ROAD** (T Davies) - Contacted at the start.

**REIGN IT IN** (J Chung) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

**T Davies** (OLD TOWN ROAD) - Admitted a charge in that she struck her mount OLD TOWN ROAD 7 times prior to the 100 metre mark with a further 4 strikes inside the final 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of her licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Sunday, 28 July, until the conclusion of racing on Friday, 9 August, 6 national riding days.

**Race 4** | **RACING THIS TIME TV ON FACEBOOK HANDICAP 1200m**

**CLICKETY CLICK** (L Allpress) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**GURTLYN** (T Bau) - Slow to begin.

**BELLA TIMING** (R Goyaram) - Shifted inwards passing the 200 metres to avoid the heels of FARRAVALLO (J Chung), which shifted out. J Chung was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

**A Mudhoo** (LITTLEREDCORVETTE) - Was shown a replay of his ride over the concluding stages and reminded of his obligations to ensure he rides his mounts out to the line fully when circumstances permit.

**Race 5** | **PHILS ELECTRICAL & GIPSY CARAVANS – RYDER STAKES (Listed Race) 1200m**

**HONEY BADGER** (L Sutherland) - Which was fractious in its barrier prior to the start began awkwardly.

**TARVOS** (J Chung) - Got its head up when over-racing in the early stages

**KERETI** (K Chowdhoo) - Raced wide without cover throughout. Blundered passing the 1100 metres.

**VOID** (C Dell) - Crowded and checked near the 150 metres.

**L Hemi** (GROVE STREET) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she allowed her mount to shift inwards passing the 1100 metres resulting in KERETI clipping a heel and blundering. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of her licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 3 August, until the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 10 August, 5 national riding days, and in addition imposed a fine of \$350.

**S O'Malley** (BEAU LUCA) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she allowed her mount to shift inwards near the 150 metres crowding and checking VOID. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of her licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday, 7 August, until the conclusion of racing on Friday, 16 August, 6 national riding days.

**Race 6** | **INTOWIN.CO.NZ HANDICAP 1400m**

**CROSS ROADS** (T Davies) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**PUKE PARK** (L Allpress) - Briefly placed in restricted room having to steady near the 1200 metres when QUEEN OF SPADES (R Goyaram) shifted inwards. R Goyaram was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

**THE MISTRESS** (C Grylls) - When questioned regarding the disappointing performance, the rider advised the mare had been making abnormal breathing noises. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no obvious

abnormalities. Connections advised Stewards the mare will undergo a full veterinary examination on Monday including an endoscopy on Monday and Stewards will be advised of the results.

**MAKE TIME** (J Chung) - Briefly held up early in the run home having to shift inwards near the 275 metres.

**Race 7** | **THE LINTON FAMILY MEMORIAL 1600m**

**GRAND PROSPECT** (M Hashizume) - Slow to begin.

**LADY PERFORMER** (L Hemi) - Began awkwardly, shifting inwards making contact with HARMONIOUS, losing ground as a result.

**HARMONIOUS** (J Chung) - Contacted at the start. Held up rounding the final bend, only finding clear racing room inside the final 300 metres.

**AIN'T BAD** (J Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

**CARIGNAN** (L Sutherland) - Over-raced for a distance passing the 1400 metres and near the 1200 metres had to be steadied away from heels. Rider advised the gelding had got back in the field and found it difficult to make ground in today's track conditions.

**CEE ARE EL** (A Mudhoo) - Had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on heels near the 450 metres and again raced in restricted room near the 350 metres when contesting a run with LADY PERFORMER.

**CONEY ISLAND** (C Dell) - Rider was of the opinion the gelding was looking for further ground at this stage of its preparation.

**Race 8** | **RIVERSIDE CONSTRUCTION HANDICAP 2100m**

**FAY KHAN IT** (C Butler) - Began awkwardly, shifting inwards at the start, making firm contact with SAINT BERNARD, which was forced inwards on to ZEE HEIGHTS which was buffeted and unbalanced.

**ZEE HEIGHTS** (S O'Malley) - Buffeted and unbalanced at the start.

**SAINT BERNARD** (C Grylls) - Crowded and buffeted at the start losing ground.

**NUN SO BAD** (K Chowdhoo) - Over-raced through the middle stages.

**SMOKIN MO** (T Davies) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start.

**MOMENTS LIKE THESE** (L Allpress) - Rider advised the mare was not comfortable in today's holding track conditions.
