Race 1	DON MURRAY MEMORIAL MAIDEN 1200
<p>ON YOUR TOES (A Mudhoo) - Raced three wide without cover until near the 600m. Rider advised the filly was unsuited to today's track conditions.</p> <p>BLUE RATA WAREA (E Sole) - Rider dropped her whip near the 150 metres.</p> <p>OUR SASSIE ANNE (L Allpress) - Lay out over the concluding stages.</p>	
Race 2	WANGANUI INSURANCE BROKERS MAIDEN 3YO 1200
<p>WONDERBOY (J Parkes) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover.</p> <p>AUTHENTIC AMANI (C Dell) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover. Raced greenly and hung throughout placing the rider at a disadvantage and was not persevered with in the home straight. When questioned regarding the performance C Dell advised the filly had raced greenly. A post-race Veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality. Connections were advised the filly must trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.</p> <p>FLASH FALCON (A Mudhoo) - Had to be briefly steadied when in restricted room near the 400 metres. Raced greenly in the home straight.</p> <p>NOBLE LEE (J Chung) - Raced greenly in the home straight.</p> <p>WURUHI (E Sole) - Lay out under pressure in the home straight.</p>	
Race 3	WANGANUI-TARANAKI RACEHORSE OWNERS ASSOCIATION MAIDEN 1340
<p>BRUNO (C Barnes) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>TRAINWRECK (L Allpress) - Raced keenly in the early stages. Had to be steadied to avoid heels approaching the 1000 metres.</p> <p>LOVELY RITA (L Hemi) - Shifted inwards approaching the 600 metres crowding JULIANUS which had to be steadied. L Hemi was advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p>JULIANUS (S O'Malley) - Had to be steadied when crowded approaching the 600 metres.</p> <p>ARBITRATE (K Kalychurun) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p>	
Race 4	MANAWATU SOUND SERVICES MAIDEN 1600
<p>Trainer M Forbes (HOUSE OF TUDOR) - Issued with a warning after being late to declare a rider.</p> <p>LAZY LUKE (C Barnes) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>NIGELNOMATES (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin. Over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>TIMMY (T Davies) - Made the first bend awkwardly.</p> <p>LET'S GET LOOSE (K Hercock) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>HOUSE OF TUDOR (L Allpress) - Lost the off-front shoe during the running.</p>	
Race 5	CARPET MAINTENANCE & CLEANING 1600

Trainer **J Lupton** (ARCADIAN INYX) - Fined \$50 under the Minor Infringement Schedule after being late to declare a rider.

L Douglas (TUTIN CANS) - Fined \$200 under the Minor Infringement Schedule after being unable to make the contracted weight for the ride on TUTIN CANS and was replaced by S O'Malley.

The start of this race was delayed after KINGFISHER LAD was initially loaded into the wrong barrier having to be removed, the barrier blindfold reapplied then reloaded. The Starter was spoken to regarding this error. The delay was exacerbated by other runners proving reluctant to load.

KINGFISHER LAD (C Lindsay) - Slow to begin.

TUTIN CANS (S O'Malley) - Slow to begin.

MY ZOI (L Allpress) - Slow to begin. Hung outwards in the final straight placing the rider at a disadvantage and could not be ridden out. When asked to comment on the performance L Allpress advised the mare had hung out from the 600 metres proving a difficult ride. A post-race Veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality. Connections were advised a warning is placed on the racing manners of the mare.

MR TWINKLETOES (L Sutherland) - Made the first bend awkwardly.

VENENO (K Hercock) - Slow to begin.

MADAM MOET (K Kalychurun) - Slow away. K Kalychurun was of the opinion the mare may be feeling the effects of recent racing. A post-race Veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality. Trainer T Mason indicated the mare would now be given a break.

PERFECT TURN (J Parkes) - Slow to begin. Not persevered with from the 600 metres finishing a distant last. J Parkes was unable to offer any excuse for the disappointing performance. A post-race Veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality. Trainer R Bergerson advised the gelding would now be retired as a racing proposition from his stable.

PASHAMALA (A Mudhoo) - Raced three wide in the early stages.

OBRIGADO (S O'Malley) - Slow to begin.

BILLY BOY (L Sutherland) - When questioned regarding the performance L Sutherland advised in her opinion the gelding would prefer a looser track.

ST ELMO'S FIRE (C Barnes) - Stood flat footed in the barriers missing the start by several lengths. Connections were advised a warning is placed on the barrier manners of the gelding.

WHOSAID (L Sutherland) - Jumped away awkwardly contacting LADY'S SECRET.

LADY'S SECRET (J Chung) - Contacted at the start.

ACORN (A Mudhoo) - The saddle shifted forward early in the race with the mare being retired from the event.

LEPREKHAN (A Mudhoo) - Jumped away awkwardly and was then further hampered when crowded. Raced keenly in the early stages.
