RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 | **CAMBRIDGE EQUINE HOSPITAL MAIDEN 1550**

BILLY PEACH (J Fawcett) - Restrained to obtain cover after jumping from the outside barrier.

TIME TO WONDER (B Rogerson) - Slow to begin.

EVANA TRUMPALOT (K Myers) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

ISLEBEFINE (M Hashizume) – Raced wide through the early stages. Rider reported that the filly had hung inwards throughout.

RICHIE'S DREAM (A Goindasamy) – Improved onto heels having to be steadied near the 800 metres and again near the 600 metres. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 100 metres.

CLUTHA (B Jacobson) – Lay outwards rounding the final bend and continued to do so when placed under pressure in the final straight.

EL AMOR (M McNab) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no explanation.

DECRETO DE GUERRA (C Barnes) – When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding failed to respond when placed under pressure. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormalities.

HAMMER TIME (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin.

AUSSIE BETTY (S Spratt) - Slow to begin. Lost contact with the body of the field through the middle stages despite the efforts of its rider. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the filly may be feeling the effects of recent racing. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormalities.

DOUBLE TAKE (R Goyaram) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Briefly contacted near the 250 metres when PAX MUNDI shifted outwards when weakening.

VILLON (M Cameron) - Raced wide in the early stages.

PAX MUNDI (W Pinn) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no explanation. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the filly to be lame in the left foreleg. Connections were advised a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.

BRYNDERWYN (M Hashizume) - Improved onto heels having to be steadied passing the 1000 metres. Lay inwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.

STUNNING MAIRE (K Myers) - Held up for clear running rounding the final bend and early in the straight.

MARCOS (M Cameron) - Slow to begin.

WHEREZTHEBIGFELLA (C Barnes) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

DON'T TELL RACHEL (B Rogerson) - Jumped outwards at the start contacting LEMON CURD. Raced keenly through the early stages. When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no explanation.

LEMON CURD (T Moodley) - Contacted at the start.

BOXMOSS (W Kennedy) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover.

THE ARCHITECT (T Newman) – Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

SPANISH LAD (S Spratt) - Raced wide throughout.

CLAIMED GIFT (L Sutherland) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running for a majority of the final straight.

NIGHT FIRE (N Parmar) - Lay outwards rounding the final bend. Rider dropped his whip near the 250 metres.

READY EDDIE GO (B Jacobson) – Lay out rounding the final bend and continued to do so when placed under pressure in the final straight.

Race 4

D & A DIESEL 1300

GWEN'S DAUGHTER (K Myers) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

MONZA (J Allen) - Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover throughout.

SIDE EYE (W Kennedy) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

DON'T LOOK ETHEL (J Nishizuka) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Had to be steadied off heels when racing keenly approaching the 900 metres.

HASSTOBEFAST (M McNab) - Raced keenly through the early stages. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 100 metres.

SIDE EYE (W Kennedy) - Made the bend passing the 970 metres awkwardly losing ground.

DEAR OH DEAR (J Fawcett) - Lay outwards rounding the final bend and continued to do so when placed under pressure in the final straight.

Race 5

GARRY EDGE TRIBUTE 970

SHOW COURAGE (R Goyaram) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

MAHOE (T Melvin) - Raced wide without cover throughout. Raced in restricted room to the inside of SEAMSEW which was laying inwards near the 200 metres.

SEAMSEW (V Colgan) – Raced wide throughout. Lay inwards when placed under pressure near the 200 metres.

FAIRSHARE (M Hashizume) – Lay inwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.

Race 6

WAIPA EARTHWORKS 970

WAITERIMU (N Parmar) - Late scratched at 2.57 pm after refusing to load. As a result, this race ran approximately 4 minutes late. Connections were advised that the mare would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

SISTER PING (K Myers) - Reared as the start was effected, losing ground (5L). Connections were advised a warning would be placed against the filly's barrier manners.

TENNESSEE WHISKEY (L Sutherland) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Lay outwards rounding the final bend and continued to do so when placed under pressure in the final straight.

ROSIE'S DREAM (C Barnes) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Forced wider near the 250 metres when TENNESSEE WHISKEY lay outwards. When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no explanation. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormalities.

MIRABELLA (J Allen) – Hung outwards rounding the final bend.

LAUNDER (M Hashizume) - Raced greenly in the final straight.

ERASE (J Fawcett) - Lay inwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.

Race 7 | **PRYDE'S EASIFEED MAIDEN 2000**

BAGGIO (S Spratt) - Restrained to obtain cover after jumping from the outside barrier. Raced keenly through the middle stages.

PONTIFICATION (T Mitchell) - Jumped outwards at the start hampering OUR BO JAKK. Commenced to give ground near the 1000 metres. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding had made abnormal breathing noises. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormalities.

OUR BO JAKK (J Fawcett) – Hampered leaving the barriers. Briefly steadied when placed in restricted room to the outside of TE HOE WERA WERA and inside of GEE FORCE which had lay in slightly near the 450 metres.

TE HOE WERA WERA (C Barnes) – Raced wide in the early stages before being allowed to stride forward to lead near the 1500 metres.

K Asano (TEMPEST MOON) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount six times prior to the 100 metre mark, and a further 5 strikes inside the final 100 metres, with the Adjudicator imposing a fine of \$250.

Race 8 | **SADDLERY WAREHOUSE 2000**

HOARD THE BOURBON (M Hashizume) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Lay outwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.

WAIHI WARRIOR (T Mitchell) - Slow to begin.

GIN GIN (J Fawcett) - Began awkwardly.

THREE NINETY (A Lawson-Carroll) - Began awkwardly.

UNEQUIVOCAL (M McNab) - Restrained to obtain cover after jumping from the outside barrier. When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no explanation. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormalities.

HUTSON (C Barnes) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

POSTER BOY (L Sutherland) - Raced wide in the early stages before being allowed to stride forward to lead near the 1100 metres.

POW TONG (S Spratt) - Raced in restricted room having to be steadied near the 970 metres.
