KEEN ON BUBBLES (E Sole) – Trainer Mr. J Wheeler reported to Stewards, the mare has been treated for a viral infection with the appropriate medication. He added the intention is to continue with KEEN ON BUBBLES current preparation.

Otaki Maori Racing Club @ Otaki, Saturday 8 June 2024 Race 5 THE TELE OTAKI HANDICAP 1200m

BARZETTI (K Hercock) – Trainer Mr. M Eales reported to Stewards, he was satisfied with the post-race condition of the gelding, however, in his opinion BARZETTI was unsuited to the Soft 6.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 TAB ODDS SURGE EVERY RACE AT TRENTHAM 3YO 1000m

POKURU GOLD (N Parmar) - Began awkwardly, shifting inwards, hampering ARACHON. When questioned regarding the performance, rider advised that the gelding failed to handle today's Heavy track conditions.

ARACHON (L Allpress) - Hampered at the start, losing ground. Eased down over the final 200 metres when out of contention. When questioned regarding the performance, rider advised that the filly failed to handle today's Heavy track conditions.

BELLA TIMING (T Davies) - Over-raced through the early stages.

Following the race N Parmar advised Stewards he was unwell and was seen by St John personnel prior to being stood down for the remainder of the day. Replacements as above. N Parmar must provide a medical clearance prior to riding next.

Race 2 BARBER COMMERCIAL MAIDEN 1400m

BUTTON YA LIP (B Grylls) - Slow to begin.

PATRIOT (C Dell) - Slow to begin.

MOSSRAAJ (L Douglas) - Slow to begin.

LAZY LUKE (E Sole) - Slow to begin.

TAMROCK (J Chung) - Slow to begin.

STEAL MY THUNDER (L Allpress) - Restrained off heels when racing keenly near the 1000 metres.

BRUNO (K Hercock) - Steadied off heels when racing keenly near the 900 metres. Had to be steadied off heels when placed in restricted room near the 600 metres. Held up for clear running round the final bend and early in the straight.

REPROBATE (K Chowdhoory) - Improved onto heels having to be steadied approaching the 600 metres.

T Allan (PERFECT POSY) - Issued with a warning for using his whip in an action which raised the rider's arm above shoulder height.

K Chowdhoory (REPROBATE) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount REPROBATE eight times prior to the 100-metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a fine of \$500.

Race 3 WELLINGTON SEAMARKET 1400m

LADY PERFORMER (E Sole) – Began awkwardly, hampering WHO'S COMPLAININ.

WHO'S COMPLAININ (J Chung) – Hampered leaving the barriers, losing ground.

SISTER JANE (M Singh) - Began awkwardly.

KNOCK OFF (L Allpress) - Hampered at the start when runners either side shifted ground.

THE FINNSTER (T Newman) – Briefly lost its footing when racing free of interference near the 600 metres. Following the running of this race the gelding's plates were inspected and found to be in good condition.

Following the running of Race 3, T Newman (THE FINNSTER) advised Stewards that her mount had briefly lost its footing near the 600 metres. A Track Safety Review Panel consisting of Stipendiary Stewards, Club Officials, Track Manager and Jockeys was convened. Following a track inspection, it was agreed by all riders there were no safety concerns in relation to the track surface. Further, all riders expressed that they were comfortable to carry on with the race meeting.

Race 4 XPLOR TOURS 1400m

PERFECT TURN (K Chowdhoory) - Slow to begin.

RAGAMUFFIN (L Allpress) - Slow to begin.

MISS DIXIE (E Sole) - Blundered shortly after the start.

SMUG ONE (L Douglas) - Lay inwards when placed under pressure in the final straight. When questioned regarding the performance, rider advised that the gelding had failed to handle today's Heavy track conditions.

Race 5 HALLMARK & STONE PARLIAMENTARY HANDICAP 2200m

SEMPER MAGICO (T Newman) - Began awkwardly. Steadied off heels near the 2000 metres.

BLACKWOOD STAR (K Hercock) - Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages. When questioned regarding the improved performance rider advised that the mare appreciated the Heavy track conditions combined with a step-up in distance.

ALJAY (L Sutherland) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

PRIDE OF ASPEN (L Allpress) - Had to be steadied off heels passing the 1600 metres when there was an easing of the pace.

PRINCE ALBY (J Chung) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages on a slow tempo. When questioned regarding the performance, rider confirmed that the gelding raced keenly through the early and middle stages, with the effort taking its toll.

MARRONI (T Davies) - Lay outwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.

Ashvin Mudhoo (SOLDIER BOY) - Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift inwards when not fully clear of SEMPER MAGICO, which had to be steadied off heels near the 2000 metres.

Race 6 JR & N BERKETT 2100m

CHER AMI (C Dell) - Slow to begin.

DON'T ASK (K Hercock) - Slow to begin. Restrained off heels near the 1800 metres when racing keenly. When questioned regarding the performance, rider advised that the gelding lay inwards during the running and proved to be a difficult ride. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities.

MORUS (L Allpress) - Raced keenly through the middle stages.

COCKTAIL LAD (L Douglas) - Steadied off heels rounding the first bend. Had to be steadied off heels when attempting to improve to the inside of CHOLULA near the 1000 metres.

MONKEY TOWN (Ashvin Mudhoo) - Raced three-wide without cover through the early and middle stages.

JACKAROO (B Grylls) - Raced keenly through the middle stages.

MURPHY (L Sutherland) - Raced greenly and lay outwards, having to be steadied near the 600 metres.

KING KHAN (J Chung) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the straight.

L Douglas (COCKTAIL LAD) - Issued with a warning for attempting to improve to the inside of CHOLULA near the 1000 metres when there was insufficient room to do so, which resulted in his mount making contact with the running rail, having to be steadied.

Race 7 NETEFFEXTPAYROLL NORTH ISLAND CHALLENGE STAKES 1300m

MAKE TIME (L Sutherland) - Began awkwardly, losing ground.

PRIORESS (C Dell) - Slow to begin. Held up rounding the final bend.

LIFFEY (K Hercock) - Slow to begin.

CONOR O'CEIRIN (L Douglas) - Steadied off heels near the 700 metres.

ROCABABY (L Allpress) - When questioned regarding the performance rider advised the mare had failed to handle today's Heavy track conditions.

Race 8 BAXTERS CATERING 1600m

YOLO (S O'Malley) - Slow to begin (4L), then became detached from the body of the field through the early and middle stages.

JESTIN CASE (C Dell) - Slow to begin (4L). Raced keenly through the middle stages, having to be steadied off heels.

PINKERTON (L Allpress) - Slow to begin.

HACKSAW RIDGE (Ashvin Mudhoo) - Raced keenly through the middle stages, having to be steadied off heels.

THOMAS AQUINAS (T Newman) - Held up rounding the final bend.

DUKE OF PLUMPTON (K Chowdhoory) - Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room when SACRED PEARL (T Davies) shifted outwards simultaneous to JESTIN CASE (C Dell) shifting inwards passing the 200 metres. Riders T Davies and C Dell were both advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

CARPE DIEM (J Chung) - Had to be steadied near the 150 metres when HACKSAW RIDGE (A Mudhoo) shifted outwards simultaneous to GRAND PROSPECT (K Hercock) shifting inwards. Riders A Mudhoo and K Hercock were both advised to exercise greater care when in similar circumstances.

BELLADONNA LILLY (L Sutherland) - Lay outwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.
