**OUR BRAVEHEART** (T Moseley) - Shifted inwards on jumping making contact with MONTEZUMA.

**MONTEZUMA** (K Williams) – Crowded and contacted on jumping when OUR BRAVEHEART shifted inwards. Hampered 900 metres.

**MONTERO** (L Callaway) - Over raced in the early stages.

**DASH OF RED** (B May) - Raced very erratically after being steadied passing the 1200 metres getting its head up and proving difficult to control. Ducked inwards abruptly making contact with the running rail near the 900 metres blundering badly losing ground. Hampered as a result were MUZZLE CAT, LET'S GO and MONTEZUMA. Connections were advised that DASH OF RED must trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to racing next.

MUZZLE CAT (D Cooper) - Hampered near the 900 metres having to be steadied.

LET'S GO (J Fawcett) - Hampered 900 metres.

MAGGIE MCMUFFIN (K Asano) - Steadied off heels near the 800 metres.

### Race 3

# NZB NATIONAL WEANLING SALE 20 JUNE HANDICAP 1400m

**STRIKE FORCE** (M McNab) - Slow to begin. Was inclined to lay inwards once placed under pressure in the straight. When questioned regarding performance, rider advised that the gelding had not travelled particularly well on a fast pace and once placed under pressure had wanted to lay in back to the inside. M McNab further stated he would have preferred to improve wider to make his run but had not been travelling well enough approaching the final turn, adding in his opinion STRIKE FORCE may now be better suited over 1600 metres. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Taking into account the racing manners of STRIKE FORCE wanting to lay inwards under pressure, M McNab was on this occasion firmly reminded of his obligation to ride his mounts out fully to the finish whenever circumstances permit.

SORCHA (W Kennedy) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

### Race 4

# SPEIGHT'S SUMMIT ULTRA ON TAP MAIDEN 1200m

**MACKENZIE RANGER** (D Cooper) - Dismounted behind the barriers when fractious after arriving at the start then escaped riderless. After being recaptured and undergoing a veterinary inspection, MACKENZIE RANGER was returned to the start before again escaping riderless from a barrier attendant and being declared a late scratching at 2:11pm. Rider D Cooper was uninjured in this incident. Trainer R Beckett was advised that MACKENZIE RANGER is required to trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to racing next.

**HIVARI** (B Murray) - Shifted outwards on jumping crowding CHIM. Lay inwards near the 150 metres having to be straightened by its rider hampering DRAKE'S DRUM momentarily.

**CHIM** (T Jonker) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Steadied off heels near the 150 metres.

YAK SHA (M McNab)- Jumped away awkwardly.

SKYLARK (B May) - Slow away.

**ARDEE SEVEN** (T Moseley) - Crowded and dictated inwards going into the first turn passing the 1000 metres.

**DRAKE'S DRUM** (L Callaway) - Severely checked passing the 1000 metres. Briefly held up passing the 300 metres. Placed in restricted room near the 150 metres.

**PING** (K Mudhoo) - Checked when crowded passing the 1000 metres.

**N Parmar** (LEAR JET) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount LEAR JET to shift inwards dictating ARDEE SEVEN inwards crowding DRAKE'S DRUM and PING which were both checked passing the 1000 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of N Parmar's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 26 June until the conclusion of racing on Sunday 7 July, 9 national riding days.

**BERBIZIER** (W Kennedy) - Blundered on jumping dislodging its rider. W Kennedy was immediately attended to by St John personnel and stood down from his remaining ride due to a thumb injury.

DIVINE REGULUS (C Barnes) - Raced wide throughout. Rider dropped her whip near the 100 metres.

TAVERNIA (M McNab) - Jumped away awkwardly.

**ON THE WALL** (J Fawcett) - Slow away.

## Race 6 BOOK A SUITE MID-WINTER XMAS RACES 22 JUNE 1600m

BRUSSET (M McNab) - Slow to begin.

YAMAZAKI (D Cooper) - Raced wide in the early stages.

LOVLESSON (K Asano) - Over raced in the early stages getting its head up.

**HIGH PINS** (K Kwo) - Over raced in the middle stages then awkwardly placed on heels near the 600 metres having to be steadied.

**JING JING** (K Mudhoo) - Raced greenly throughout. Hung inwards when placed under pressure near the 300 metres and was unable to be fully ridden out by its rider.

### Race 7 ENTAIN – NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1600m

**STAR IN THE SKY** (M McNab) - Bounded at the start losing ground.

DARCI'S QUEEN (K Kwo) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

WAIHORA MIST (K Bakker) - Slow away. Raced wide in the early stages.

**ROYCE ROCA** (C Barnes) - Lay outwards rounding the final bend placing HEREIGOAGAIN and HAYATE in restricted room near the 400 metres.

**DARCI'S QUEEN** (K Kwo) - Had to be steadied away from heels near the 250 metres when runners either side shifted ground.

HEREIGOAGAIN (K Mudhoo) - Placed in restricted room near the 400 metres.

HAYATE (N Parmar) - Placed in restricted room near the 400 metres.

**STOLEN DECREE** (D Tait) - Lost the right front plate during the running.
