Race 7 HENRY'S PLUMBING LTD & DESIGN BUILDERS 1200m

**CALEDONIE (T Mitchell)** – Trainer Mr. R Manning reported to Stewards, he was satisfied with the post-race condition of CALEDONIE, and it is his intention to carry on with the mare's current preparation.

**RACE COMMENTS** 

Race 1 TAB ODDS SURGE EVERY RACE AT OTAKI MAIDEN 1600m

**YAKATTACK** (J Riddell) - Jumped awkwardly contacting TIMMY. Raced keenly when in front in the run down the back straight. Commenced to weaken from the 500 metres.

**TIMMY** (T Davies) - Contacted at the start. Improved onto the heels of a weakening runner near the 500 metres. Held up, having to angle wider passing the 200 metres to gain clear racing room.

**SAINT BERNARD** (C Lindsay) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly for the majority.

SHOCKIFF (L Allpress) - Slow to begin.

LADY'S SECRET (A Mudhoo) - Jumped awkwardly.

**HELLO CUPID** (K Hercock) - Improved on to heels near the 1100 metres when racing keenly, having to be steadied. Held up rounding the final bend.

FRAULEIN (L Douglas) - Raced keenly through the middle stages.

HAAST RULER (J Chung) - Improved on to heels, having to be steadied approaching the 800 metres.

**LYNX** (L Sutherland) - Trainer L Latta attributed the improved performance to the increase in distance and the addition of blinkers.

## Race 2 VETS ON RIVERBANK MAIDEN 1600m

**SIR REGAL** (L Sutherland) - Late scratching at the barriers at 12.21pm on veterinary advice, after the gelding was found to be lame in the right foreleg. Trainer D Jesen was advised SIR REGAL will require a veterinary clearance prior to racing next.

**FINAL CHAPTER** (C Dell) - Began awkwardly, blundering shortly after the start, losing ground. Contacted near the 200 metres.

**ROSEMARY FIZZ** (D-R Tait) - Lay outwards through the early stages of the home straight, contacting FINAL CHAPTER approaching the 200 metres.

**ITOJE** (J Mudhoo) - Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

**DEADLY PONY** (K Hercock) - Disappointed. When questioned, rider was of the opinion the mare would be better suited to more rain-affected footing.

#### Race 3 PORIRUA CLUB PUNTERS HANDICAP 1600m

BELLE'S ECHO (L Allpress) - Began awkwardly, contacting KICK ON. Held up early in the home straight.

KICK ON (L Sutherland) - Contacted at the start.

**SEMPER MAGICO** (K Asano) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover.

**PRINCE ALBY** (L Kauri) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

## Race 4 HARCOURTS OTAKI HANDICAP 1200m

CLASSICO (L Douglas) - Slow to begin.

KA YING LUCKY (C Dell) - Began awkwardly.

PADDY GIFT (J Chung) - Restrained to obtain cover.

**SEA THE DREAM** (L Allpress) - Jumped awkwardly contacting PEPPERY, which in turn contacted MOMOSA. Also affected was HELLUVAH RETURN which was contacted and unbalanced. Raced keenly in the early stages.

**PEPPERY** (Ayush Mudhoo) - Contacted at the start then when being angled inwards made contact with the running rail for several strides. A Mudhoo was shown footage of his ride in the presence of the Apprentice Mentor and advised to exercise greater care. Held up behind a tiring runner near the entrance to the home straight.

**MOMOSA** (K Hercock) - Contacted, then slow away at the start. Raced keenly, having to be steadied passing the 800 metres.

HELLUVA RETURN (S O'Malley) - Contacted and unbalanced at the start. Hampered 200 metres.

**STRIDES** (J Riddell) - Slow away. Lay outwards when being ridden out in the home straight, momentarily hampering HELLUVA RETURN passing the 200 metres.

**THATZ DAISY** (C Lindsay) - Commenced to give ground rapidly in the home straight after leading and finished last. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

# Race 5 THE TELE OTAKI HANDICAP 1200m

CATHERINENZ (K Kalychurun) - Began awkwardly.

**PAPA SURF** (J Chung) - Blundered shortly after the start. Failed to run on to any extent in the home straight. Rider was of the opinion the gelding would prefer more rain-affected footing.

**BARZETTI** (K Hercock) - Slow away and tailed off throughout. Rider reported there may be something amiss with the gelding. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

KANA (K Chowdhoory) - Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained to take cover.

**REIGN IT IN (J Riddell) - Raced ungenerously in blinkers.** 

**SPENCER** (L Allpress) - Shied near the winning post with L Allpress becoming unbalanced and losing the use of her right iron.

### Race 6 NEW WORLD OTAKI HANDICAP 2100m

**VENENO** (J Chung) - Began awkwardly contacting LILLY LAGUNA. Over-raced in the early stages. Improved on to heels near the 700 metres.

**LILLY LAGUNA** (A Mudhoo) - Contacted at the start.

**PRINCESS ELLY** (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin then bumped for several strides when MASSO was angled inwards. Steadied near the 800 metres. Left flat-footed when the tempo increased markedly near the 600 metres.

**MASSO** (L Hemi) - Bumped for several strides with PRINCESS ELLY shortly after the start when being angled for a run closer to the rail. L Hemi was shown footage of her ride and issued with a warning.

FAR SITE (K Asano) - Restrained to take cover.

MR FABULOUS (E Sole) - Raced three-wide in the early stages.

LINCOLN STAR (L Allpress) - Held up rounding the final bend. Lost the near hind plate during the running.

**BENEFACTOR** (C Dell) - Finished towards the rear. Rider was of the opinion the mare was unsuited to a front-running position and would be better suited to a more rain-affected footing.

**L Hemi** (MASSO) - Issued with a warning after angling her mount inwards shortly after the start bumping with PRINCESS ELLY for several strides.

## Race 7 MCMILLAN EQUINE FEEDS HANDICAP 2100m

BILLY BOY (S O'Malley) - Jumped awkwardly contacting UNSCRIPTED.

**UNSCRIPTED** (K Asano) - Contacted at the start. Held up entering the home straight.

**ESCALADE** (L Hemi) - Restrained to take cover after jumping from a wide barrier.

FAY KHAN IT (L Sutherland) - Over-raced in the early stages. Made the turn into the back straight awkwardly.

LURID (C Dell) - Raced three-wide in the early stages.

SHE'S SO RELIABLE (J Chung) - Angled outwards near the 400 metres to avoid the heels of a tiring runner.

**TRAMORE** (C Lindsay) - Held up for a short distance approaching the home turn and again near the 200 metres prior to being angled outwards to improve.

**JUSTICE** (J Riddell) - Not persevered with in the home straight when well back and out of contention. When questioned into the disappointing run, J Riddell reported the gelding never travelled throughout and when asked for an effort rounding the home turn lay outwards. J Riddell was of the opinion his mount may not have been suited to the Soft 6. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

#### Race 8 CAVALLO FARMS & CHRIS RUTTEN BLOODSTOCK HANDICAP 1600m

MANOLO (T Taiaroa) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**DONNYBROOK** (J Chung) - Restrained from a wide draw. Lay inwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

**GREY INVADOR** (L Allpress) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages and failed to finish the race off, finishing well back. When questioned L Allpress was of the opinion the gelding may be feeling the effects of recent racing. Trainer B McDermott advised GREY INVADOR would be spelled.

MISS EMERALD (A Mudhoo) - Held up rounding the final bend until near the 250 metres and when being angled outwards bumped with the weakening GREY INVADOR for some distance. A Mudhoo was shown footage of his ride and advised to take greater care.

LADY PERFORMER (L Hemi) - Held up through the early stages of the home straight.

MOONLIGHT HUSTLER (K Hercock) - Lay inwards, having to be straightened near the 300 metres.

**LOVE JANIE** (K Asano) - Lay inwards, having to be straightened near the 300 metres.

**T Taiaroa** (MANOLO) - Issued with a warning with regard to her whip use on a runner out of contention.
