Race 3 STAPHANOS AT NOVARA PARK CHAMPAGNE STAKES 2YO 1600m (Listed Race)

STAR SHADOW (W Pinn) – Te Akau Racing Manager R Trumper advised Stewards the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of the filly, however, STAR SHADOW has now been sent for a spell.

Race 2 PRYDE'S EASIFEED 1550

RANGER (N Hailey) - Trainer reported that the gelding received treatment to its bumpers following the running of this race.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 AUCKLAND CO-OP TAXIS 1200

PARADISE THUNDER (S Spratt) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Improved onto heels having to be steadied near the 800 metres.

RAREZA (N Parmar) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

POKURU GOLD (O Bosson) - Briefly steadied near the 800 metres to avoid the heels of NAXOS which had shifted inwards. Shifted outwards passing the 450 metres making contact with CITY GIRL. O Bosson was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.

CITY GIRL (J Allen) – Contacted and unbalanced passing the 450 metres.

Race 2 BARFOOT & THOMPSON MAIDEN 1600

SATIN DOLL (B Jacobson) - Slow to begin.

SWEET BUT PSYCHO (A Goindasamy) - Contacted and crowded at the start losing ground. Held up entering the final straight.

SHAKING STEVENS (O Bosson) - Knuckled at the start.

SALLY (J Fawcett) - Raced wide without cover throughout when racing keenly. Forced wider passing the 400 metres. Raced in restricted room approaching the 200 metres.

WOLF RAYET (N Hailey) – Raced keenly through the early stages. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding had hung throughout. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality. N Hailey received medical attention following the race after being hit in the face with a clod.

CASH TREASURE (T Moodley) - Improved onto heels having to be steadied near the 700 metres. Held up rounding the final bend.

MIDNIGHT ESCAPE (N Parmar) – Shifted out slightly passing the 400 metres making contact with BAGGIO which shifted out slightly forcing SALLY wider into the line of KEATING which was hampered.

BAGGIO (S Spratt) - Contacted and forced wider passing the 400 metres.

KEATING (V Colgan) - Hampered passing the 400 metres before having to shift outwards to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination including an endoscopic examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 3 TAB NZ MAIDEN 1200

REVUELTO (S Weatherley) - Slow to begin. Shifted outwards near the 500 metres inconveniencing FOREVER YOUNG and BOSUN.

BOSUN (N Parmar) - Began awkwardly. Contacted becoming briefly unbalanced near the 500 metres.

FOREVER YOUNG (B Rogerson) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from a wide barrier. Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 500 metres.

MOELLE (N Hailey) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from a wide barrier. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

MOVING MELODY (T Moodley) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from the outside barrier.

CARTER RUSSELL (W Pinn) - Blundered passing the 200 metres. Following the race W Pinn reported this incident to Stewards with Stewards then inspecting this portion of the track with no areas of concern being apparent.

S Weatherley (REVUELTO) – Issued with a warning after angling his mount outwards when not sufficiently clear of FOREVER YOUNG which was dictated outwards making contact with BOSUN which became unbalanced near the 500 metres.

Race 4 DUNSTAN HORSEFEEDS 2200

SQUIRE (N Parmar) - Slow to begin. Came together with ESPRESSO TO GO near the 200 metres.

IN A PICKLE (B Rogerson) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from a wide barrier. Raced keenly through the early stages when being restrained.

ESPRESSO TO GO (T Moodley) - Came together with SQUIRE near the 200 metres.

J Allen (RUACH) - Defended a charge in that she struck her mount eight times prior to the 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee found the charge proven and imposed a fine of \$500.

Race 5 ELSDON PARK 1400

JUST A TIPPLE (J Fawcett) - Slow to begin.

AMAZING GRACE (N Parmar) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

SWINDLE (W Pinn) - Knuckled on jumping away.

JACK IN THE BOX (J Allen) - Held up entering the final straight until passing the 400 metres.

Race 6 RICH HILL STUD 1200

SILVER JAVELIN (T Moodley) - Began awkwardly. Improved onto heels having to be steadied near the 900 metres. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that after its poor beginning the mare had found it difficult to make up ground in the straight.

THIS LITTLE LIGHT (S Fisher) - Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after losing ground. Commenced to over-race passing the 1000 metres then shifted outwards passing the 700 metres making contact with HIT THE SWITCH which was forced wider. Shifted out again when racing keenly making contact with HIT THE SWITCH passing the 600 metres.

CANNY MAN (N Hailey) - Slow to begin.

DON'T LOOK ETHEL (M Sanson) – Over-raced through the early stages.

HIT THE SWITCH (C Barnes) - Contacted and forced wider passing the 700 metres and again passing the 600 metres becoming unbalanced.

JESKO ABSOLUT (S Weatherley) - When questioned regarding performance the rider was satisfied with the gelding's performance at its first run back from an extended break advising that it would derive benefit from the race.

Race 7 SKYCITY HORIZON 1600

PATSYS LAD (J Fawcett) - Slow to begin.

THATSALLSHEWROTE (N Parmar) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from a wide barrier. Held up early in the final straight.

JAFFIRA (N Hailey) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from the outside barrier.

MALDINI (O Bosson) - Over-raced through the early and middle stages.

CHARMER (A Goindasamy) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

S Weatherley (BASSOROC) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount eight times prior to the 100 metre mark with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a fine of \$500.
