Race 1 BARFOOT & THOMPSON 1100

HIGHLIGHTER (T Moodley) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Shifted out passing the 350 metres contacting JOHNY JOHNY which was forced wider.

JOHNY JOHNY (J Allen) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Contacted and forced wider passing the 350 metres.

Race 2 AUCKLAND CO-OP TAXIS 1400

MARY SHAN (C Grylls) – Stewards granted permission for trainer A Forsman to remove the blinkers due to the track conditions. Slow to begin.

CHARMER (T Moodley) - Held up until near the 350 metres.

NAVY CHIEF (J Doyle) – Raced in restricted room to the inside of GELDOP for a distance passing the 250 metres.

Race 3 STAPHANOS AT NOVARA PARK CHAMPAGNE STAKES 2YO 1600 (Listed Race)

MAGNA MEMORY (S Spratt) - Slow to begin. Came together with INTERPLANETARY over the concluding stages when both runners shifted ground.

SOUTHERN WARRIOR (J Doyle) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

GREAT ADVENTURE (B Rogerson) – Restrained at the start to obtain cover from the outside barrier.

INTERPLANETARY (V Colgan) - Commenced to race ungenerously for a distance from near the 1200 metres. Came together with MAGNA MEMORY over the concluding stages when both runners shifted ground.

STAR SHADOW (W Pinn) - When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that in his opinion the filly was feeling the effects of recent racing. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormality.

Improved onto heels having to be steadied near the 1100 metres.</p> <p>ANNA TAIT (C Grylls) – Crowded at the start losing ground.</p> <p>MORE TO BE WRITTEN (S Spratt) - Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after losing ground.</p> <p>TOP CARD (N Parmar) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.</p> <p>MI AMIGO (N Hailey) – Lay inwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.</p>

<p>BEAU ONDAGO (M Sanson) - Stewards granted permission for trainer J Williams to remove the blinkers due to the track conditions. Contacted and unbalanced passing the 400 metres.</p> <p>RODOLFO (A Lawson-Carroll) - Crowded at the start losing ground.</p> <p>DEVOTED (T Melvin) - Crowded at the start losing ground.</p> <p>A MANDARIN (V Colgan) - Restrained at the start to obtain cover from a wide barrier.</p> <p>ASGARD (J Doyle) – Raced keenly through the early stages. Raced in restricted room entering the final straight shifting outwards making contact with the hindquarters of BEAU ONDAGO which was momentarily unbalanced. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that in his opinion the gelding would be better suited dropping back to 1600 metres.</p> <p>JUST ONE (T Moodley) - Became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 400 metres having to be steadied. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the gelding had failed to handle today’s track conditions. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormality.</p>

<p>DUBAI DIVA (T Moodley) - Crowded at the start clipping a heel and blundering.</p> <p>SINGING SUN (S Spratt) - Began awkwardly.</p> <p>HASSTOBEFAST (M McNab) – Improved onto heels having to briefly steady near the 600 metres.</p> <p>L Te Keeti (KIVA HAN) - Issued with a warning after presenting the mare to race without the notified blinkers.</p> <p>S Marsh (DUBAI DIVA) - Admitted a charge in that he failed to declare a rider for DUBAI DIVA by the required time with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a fine of \$150.</p>
